

Mr. Babione holds a bachelor's degree in Aerospace and Ocean Engineering from Virginia Tech, a master's degree in Aerospace Engineering from the University of Washington, and a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Tennessee. He and his wife Mary live in Fort Worth, Texas. They have three daughters, Sarah, Bethie and Emily.

Edwards Air Force Base

Edwards Air Force Base occupies territory once explored by Spanish colonists and settled by pioneer homesteaders. The military base began as a stark and remote bombing range in 1933 and went on to become a major bomber training base in World War II. Edwards Air Force Base originated during the darkest days of the war and has since achieved more major milestones in flight than anywhere else in the world. Aircraft ranging from the Bell XP-59 Airacomet, to the Bell X-1, to the NASA Space Shuttle, to the B-2 Bomber, were first developed, tested, and finalized for production at Edwards. This proud history continues with the testing of the Joint Strike Fighter X-35A, Airborne Laser Weapons, and the Predator Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Programs.

Col Randel "Laz" Gordon is the Vice Commander, 412th Test Wing, Edwards Air Force Base (AFB), California. He leads a wing of 9,500 personnel in the developmental test and evaluation of KC-46, KC-135, KC-10, C-17, C-5, F-35, F-22, F-16, B-1, B-2, B-52, T-7A, RQ-4 and emerging technologies.

Col Gordon was born in Poughkeepsie, New York and received his commission in 1998 from the United States Air Force Academy. Prior to this assignment, he was the initial cadre director for the Secretary of the Air Force's Artificial Intelligence Accelerator with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). He also served as initial cadre for the Secretary of the Air Force's AFWERX technology innovation team with private sector business and academia. Col Gordon is a Presidential Fellow, Harvard Business School Alumnus, Defense Advanced Projects Research Agency (DARPA) Fellow, MIT Fellow, and holds a doctorate from the US Air Force's School of Advanced Air and Space Studies. He served the F-22 Combined Test Force as its commander and has additional flight test pilot experience in the F-15C/E, A-10A/C, Bombardier BD-700 Global Express business jet, and 70 other military and civilian aircraft.

The strength in Edwards Air Force Base's leadership is evident in the strength of all of its members. Edwards Air Force Base is more than just a Base, but a community of skilled, hardworking, generous people. 

His more recent appearances include the feature films "Aint Them Bodies Saints" opposite Casey Afleck and Rooney Mara, "Cowboys And Aliens" opposite Daniel Craig and Harrison Ford, and Director Terence Davies' "A Quiet Passion" opposite Cynthia Nixon and Jennifer Ehle.

He is also known for HBO's "Deadwood" as Wild Bill Hickock, Showtime's "Dexter" as Special Agent Frank Lundy, "Fargo" as Lou Solverson opposite Billy Bob Thornton and Martin Freeman, and most recently as President Conrad Dalton on CBS' "Madam Secretary" opposite Tea Leoni. He also just finished production in Jane Campion's new film "The Power Of The Dog" with Benedict Cumberbatch, Kirsten Dunst and Jesse Plemons.


On stage, he began his career in the original Broadway production of "Hair". He then returned to B'way in "Foxfire" with Jessica Tandy and Hume Cronyn, created the role of Will Rogers in the original Broadway production of "The Will Rogers Follies" for which he received a Tony nomination, and was again nominated for the Tony Award for his portrayal of J.D. Drew in the broadway production of "Hands On A Hardbody". He is married to actress Hayley DuMond with whom he has a son, Sean David Carradine.






