LEADERSHIP CAMPS

COUNSELLOR-IN-TRAINING

AGES 14-15 FOUR WEEKS

This four-week intensive Counsellor-in-Training (CIT) program develops aspiring leaders through hands-on camp experience. After a week of training, CITs complete three week-long placements, shadowing counsellors, assisting with programs and engaging with campers. Participants earn volunteer hours and may be eligible for future Harbourfront Centre camp roles, gaining leadership, confidence and practical experience.

Harbourfront Centre's Instructor-in-Training (IIT) Program develops emerging leaders for Canoe and Kayak camps. IITs gain hands-on experience, learning paddling skills, safety practices and camper management alongside experienced instructors. Mandatory training provides essential foundations. Participants earn volunteer hours, build leadership and teamwork skills, and may be eligible for future Junior Instructor positions, contributing meaningfully to the camp community.

SAILING CAMP

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH TORONTO HARBOUR NAUTICAL CENTRE

Set sail and discover the excitement of the open water! Campers learn essential sailing skills, including boat handling, navigation and water safety, under the guidance of experienced instructors in Toronto's Inner Harbour surrounded by the beautiful Toronto Islands. With a focus on teamwork, confidence and fun, campers enjoy hands-on learning both on and off the water, making for an adventurous and memorable summer experience.

Sailing campers are under the guidance of experienced and well-trained instructors from our partner, Toronto Harbour Nautical Centre.

Weather plan

Most activities happen outdoors and on the water (weather permitting) with fun indoor programming provided on rainy days.

Grouping

Campers are divided into Junior and Senior groups on the first day to ensure age-appropriate learning and coaching.

Safety is our top priority - all campers in our marine programs are provided with a Personal Floatation Device (PFD), and proper use of the PFD is strictly enforced. Campers are welcome to use their own Transport Canada approved PFDs if they prefer. All WETFEET (ICANSail), and CANSail 1 participants are also provided with helmets for on-water use. Helmets may be required for other participants at the discretion of our Sailing Camp Instructors.

TRAVEL METHODS

At the time of registration, families will need to select their preferred Travel Method for camp. This information is important to ensure proper planning and coordination for each camper's arrival and departure. Fees may apply if Add-on Service travel method is selected.

CAMPER DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

This is the standard travel method option. Morning drop-off opens at 8:30am and will remain open until 9:15am. Afternoon pick-up opens at 4:00pm and will remain open until 4:30pm. If you are later than 4:30pm to pick up your camper, they will be moved into our Extended Care Program, and a \$20 late pick-up fee may be charged to your account.

INDEPENDENT TRAVEL

Campers signed up for this travel method will independently sign in and sign out daily from camp. This option is available for the following campers:

- Campers age 10 and older
- Campers under 10, only if they are accompanied by a sibling 12 or older

Morning independent travel opens at 8:30am and remains open until 9:15am. Afternoon independent travel releases at 4:00pm.



ADD-ON SERVICE - EXTENDED CARE PROGRAM

A well-supervised extended care program is available for your camper for an additional fee per week. Morning extended care opens at 8am and will remain open until 9:15am. Afternoon extended care will remain open until 5:30pm. Campers will have the option to participate in a variety of arts and crafts activities or quiet active games during this time.

ADD-ON SERVICE - BUSING
