


Iconic Cities and Cultural Landmarks

This quintessential cruise along the beautiful Danube begins with an overnight in the “Queen of the Danube” — the capital city of Budapest, which straddles the river with its hilly ‘Buda’ featuring Fisherman’s Bastion & castle district over to the flat ‘Pest’ side with its iconic Parliament building, to the “Three Rivers City” of Passau at the confluence of the Inn, Ilz and Danube rivers.



DAY 1

Budapest

Danube adventure begins



OLD TOWN & OPERA CHARM

Discover the charm of Bratislava, capital of Slovakia and one of Europe's youngest capitals. Begin with a scenic drive past St. Martin's Cathedral and the Grassalkovich Palace, then ascend to Castle Hill for panoramic views of the city and the Danube.

Continue on foot through the historic Old Town, from Michael's Gate to the Main Square, where you'll admire landmarks like the Primatial Palace, City Hall, and Maximilian Fountain. Pause at a cozy café to sample the beloved Pressburger rolls, before concluding your tour near the elegant Opera House. In the evening, return on board for a graceful waltz dance class, immersing yourself in the timeless rhythms of Viennese tradition.



DAY 4

Vienna

Vienna's Imperial Elegance

Spend the day discovering the timeless grandeur of Vienna, a city steeped in imperial history and artistic brilliance. Begin with a scenic drive along the Ringstrasse, passing architectural gems such as the Opera House, Parliament, and City Hall. Then, stroll through the historic center, from the Hofburg Imperial Palace to St. Stephen's Cathedral, with time to explore the charming pedestrian zone at your own pace.

In the evening, immerse yourself in the magic of Viennese music at the “Sound of Vienna” concert, held in a historic venue where Johann Strauss once led his orchestra. Enjoy an enchanting performance of classical waltzes, operettas, and ballet that captures the cultural soul of Austria’s capital.






DAY 5 Dürnstein

A guided tour reveals highlights like the marble hall, imperial balconies, and the impressive abbey church.



DAY 6

Linz

In the afternoon, continue with an included AMADEUS Active hike up Pöstlingberg, the iconic hill overlooking Linz. At the summit, take in sweeping views of the city and the distant Alps, visit the historic Seven Sorrows of Mary Basilica, and descend the Way of the Cross path to return to the city. 
Passau



DAY 8

Walhalla & Regensburg Highlights

Disembark in Passau and begin your Bavarian journey with a visit to Walhalla, a neoclassical monument perched high above the Danube. Modeled after a Greek temple and often referred to as the “German Pantheon,” this striking 19th-century structure honors notable German figures and offers stunning panoramic views of the river below.


Continue on to the UNESCO-listed city of Regensburg, where a 3-course lunch awaits before setting off on a guided walking tour. Discover the city’s beautifully preserved medieval charm, from the iconic Stone Bridge dating back to the 12th century to the towering twin spires of the 13th-century Gothic cathedral—a timeless masterpiece that defines the city’s skyline.



DAY 9

Baroque Beauty & Bavarian Heritage

Today, explore the picturesque region around Regensburg with a visit to Weltenburg Monastery, the oldest monastic settlement in Bavaria, founded around 600 AD. Set at the entrance of the scenic Danube Gorge, the monastery features a breathtaking Baroque church built in the early 18th century. Afterward, enjoy a traditional 3-course lunch at the world’s oldest inn, family-run since 1658 and recognized by the Guinness Book of Records. Return to Regensburg in the afternoon and enjoy free time to relax or continue exploring the charming old town.



DAY 10

Munich to Inzell Escape

After breakfast, travel from Regensburg to Munich for a city tour of its iconic sights, including Marienplatz, the Olympic Park, the peaceful English Garden, and grand Nymphenburg Palace. After free time for lunch, continue to the picturesque alpine village of Inzell in the Chiemgau region, where glacier-carved landscapes, mountain lakes, and forested hills welcome you for a relaxing three-night stay.

DAY 11

Islands of Lake Chiemsee

Set out on a serene lake cruise across Lake Chiemsee, often called the “Bavarian Sea.” Visit Herreninsel, home to King Ludwig II’s Versailles-inspired Herrenchiemsee Palace, and Fraueninsel, a peaceful island known for its Benedictine monastery and tranquil village charm. Surrounded by the Alps, these islands offer a perfect blend of history, nature, and relaxation.

DAY 12

Salzburg & the Salt Story


This morning, visit Hallein, home to the world's oldest salt mine open to visitors, where interactive exhibits bring the story of "white gold" to life. Continue to Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, and explore its charming old town before riding the funicular up to the imposing Hohen-Salzburg Fortress. From the top, take in panoramic views of the city's Baroque rooftops and the surrounding Alpine landscape.



DAY 13

Farewell Bavaria

After breakfast, check out and bid farewell to beautiful Bavaria. Transfer to Munich Airport for your return flight home, filled with unforgettable memories of castles, culture, golf, and alpine landscapes.
