

Series Synopsis

Karin's daughter does her best to keep her mother out of her police investigations. Their relationship is constantly being tested, due to the fact that Karin murdered Julia's father.

Julia ends an affair with a Polish colleague when her own daughter, Sophie, finds out about it and confronts her. During a court case, to protect Sophie, Julia lies on the witness stand, claiming that she coerced a suspect into confessing to a murder. Julia is suspended from duty but continues working as a private detective. During one of her investigations, she falls into the clutches of a gang of Polish criminals and is murdered.

After Julia is suspended from duty, Ellen transfers to the island from Denmark to replace her. Initially, relations between Ellen and Karin are strained, in all likelihood because Karin knows something about Ellen's mother, and is struggling to let go of the past.

Ellen seems to have been drawn to the island of her birth as much by her own history as for professional reasons. The two women gradually get to know one another better, and when Ellen moves into Karin's house, the former prosecutor gets an insight into the crimes she is investigating – and her personal life. Rather than socialise with colleagues, Ellen prefers to venture out alone to bars.
