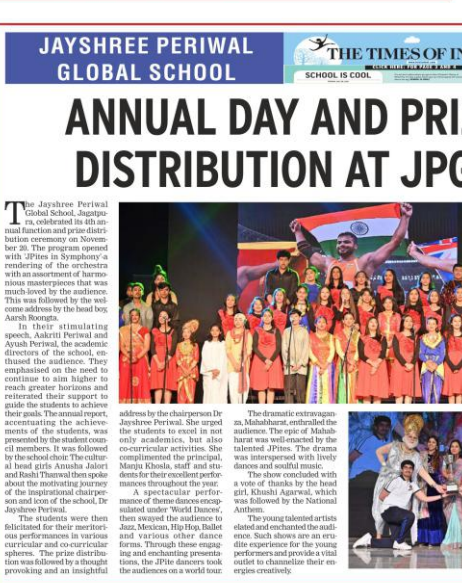
## Students at JPGS learn the POWER OF NUTRITIOUS EATING
