DETAILS OF CLUB ACTIVITY

Transition leaders help with marketing our school and assist with the smooth transition for pupils in Y6 to Y7 and Y11 to Y12.

Your role will include:

- Assisting with the planning and delivery of the Y6 open evening.
- Assisting with the planning and delivery of the Y12 open evening.
- Attending Y12 open days at other venues where we market our school.
- Showing prospective students and their parents around our school.
- Mentoring Y10 Students to work with them on Post 16 Pathways.
- Attending all parents information and open evenings to promote our school and its sixth form. (This will be on a rotation depending on how many students opt for this leadership role).
- Presenting information about sixth form to lower years.
- Promoting the Sixth Form across school at lunchtime.

DETAILS OF CLUB ACTIVITY

This club would probably happen after school and would involve approximately 40 minutes of exercise and running.

The club would be suitable for anyone who has an interest in any type of running as activities would be mixed up each session, but with the general aim of improving running strength, conditioning and speed.

A typical session may be around 5 to 10 minutes of warm up, 10 minutes of running strength training, 15 minutes of sprint intervals or HIIT running training, 5 minutes active recovery and cool down.

This kind of training is usually associated with runners looking to improve their 5K and 10K times. However, any runner of any ability should make progress from undertaking this type of training.
