Menominee Park Zoo in Oshkosh hosts a safe trick-or-treating event at the zoo. Community volunteers and local businesses line the area with treat stations and games. Live at the Leach is a free concert series that happens once a month on Tuesdays from June through September with an attendance of 4,000 people per season. 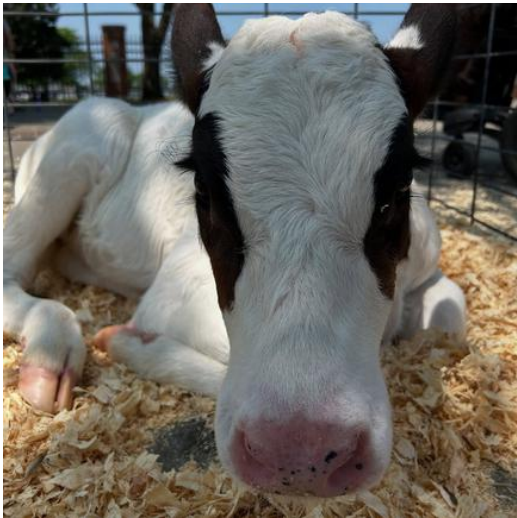
