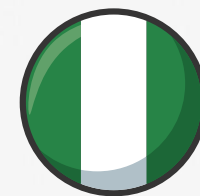

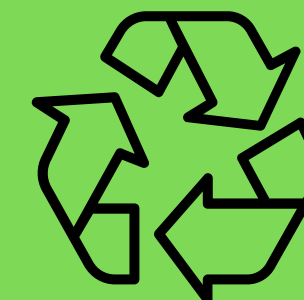

Our goal is to reduce rural-to-urban migration as well as unemployment.

RURAL OUTREACH, SOCIAL WORK, AND VOLUNTEER SERVICES

Our social work activities focus on a schoolhouse lunch program for children while also providing a safety net for Nahuce village to develop self-sufficiency. As part of these efforts, we organized a Back-to-School Program, where our social workers provided free uniforms and school supplies for over 127 children in Nahuce village. Our goal is to inspire them and continue helping them thrive in an enabling environment with access to food, clothing, and shelter. We are committed to bringing social equality to rural areas, as there are significant disparities regarding social justice for rural communities.

SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION AND HOUSING REPAIRS

With assistance and guidance from many kindred souls, we embarked on building a three-classroom structure in Nahuce village. The foundation for this project was laid on June 30, 2024, and it has since progressed to the lintel level. Our goal is to repair village schools and provide an enabling learning environment for children to receive proper education with guidance and support. We are expanding our efforts to build more classrooms and provide necessary furnishings and supplies. Additionally, our vision for providing access to clean water and electricity remains a work in progress, and we hope to achieve these goals through collective efforts and guidance from those passionate about humanity.

DEVELOPMENT OF A LIBERATION MODEL CURRICULUM FREE FROM COLONIAL INFLUENCE

As Africans, we value our history and culture, so we choose to document our history in advance. We emphasize learning activities that involve parents as primary instructors. The Global Village Initiative (GVI) has been committed to developing a Liberation Model Curriculum, alongside a radio adaptation of each book curriculum to be showcased in our library and media house as a series. GARDENING PROGRAM

This program within GVI includes empowering rural women in gardening, growing food and vegetables that are used in the schoolhouse lunch program. This initiative provides a safety net for the community, helping people thrive. Our vision is to sustain the schoolhouse lunch program and also produce food for the local market and community. Growing our own food is essential. This program includes irrigation farming practices, made possible through the support of RSA, V2G Multimedia, and other supporters.

ELDERS' MEMORY TOUR PROGRAM

This initiative focuses on ethnological surveys, allowing us to document and preserve the rich history of our elders. Through recorded video interviews accompanied by transcript translations, we capture invaluable historical facts and memories, ensuring our African heritage is well-documented. This initiative serves as a legacy project, allowing the world to see and appreciate the diverse cultures and traditions of our people.

POULTRY FARMING INITIATIVE

GVI is committed to raising a small poultry farm to provide the village with access to eggs and poultry, such as roosters and broilers. The initiative includes proper daily management activities, allowing youth to gain practical knowledge in poultry farming. This training promotes self-reliance and economic sustainability within the community.
