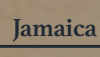

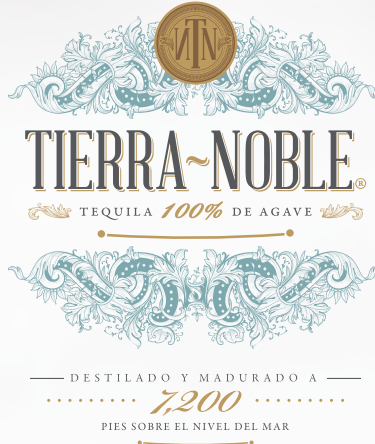

Casa Manglar, which means “Mangrove house” in Spanish, is a tribute to the indigenous people living in the Sierra de Oaxaca area. They believe that the “creator” endowed all things, animate and inanimate with a spirit.

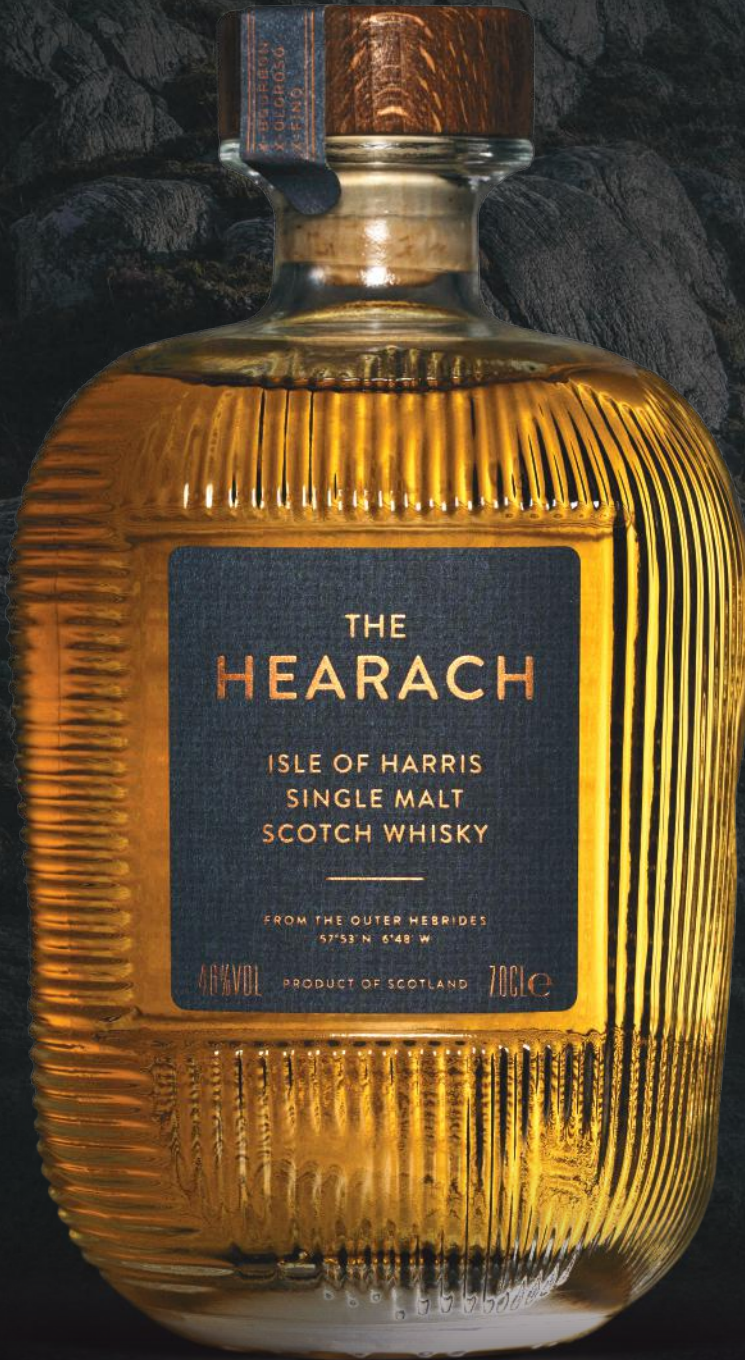
The local tradition explains the relations between men, animals, plants and earth, while ceremonies and rituals serve to strengthen the link between the world they inhabit and the world of spirits. Casa Manglar represents that transition between earth to mezcal.

The word mezcal comes from Nahuatl *mexcalli metl* and *ixcalli* which means “oven-cooked agave”. Mezcal is the best kept secret of Mexico and the most ancient distilled spirit in America. Unlike its sibling tequila, mezcal can derive from over 30 varieties of agave, most of them grown in the different regions.

BALLYKEEFE IS THE FIRST Irish Single Estate Family Farm Distillery in over 200 years, where all barley is sown, grown, harvested and distilled on the Ging family farm.

The Ging Family trace their unbroken farming lineage back to the golden age when family farm distilleries were dotted across the Irish countryside. Located in the lush green countryside close to Ireland’s medieval capital Kilkenny city, Ballykeefe has the distinction of being the area from which the first written account of distilling in Ireland is recorded in 1324 in the Red Book of Ossory.



SINGLE MALT IRISH WHISKEY

NOSE: A Gentle nose with notes of Toasted Oak, Citrus and Coconut, resolving to Apple Sponge Cake.

TASTE: At first, Malt and Fruit dominate with Mango and a hint of ripe Banana. Then Toffee Apple fading to Crème Brûlée.

FINISH: Long finish with notes of Apple Custard and a hint of Cloves.

Super Premium is the quality standard at Ballykeefe Distillery. It is a hearts only distiller’s cut, which means all heads and tails are discarded, with the emphasis on quality and not quantity. They produce their spirits in small batches in bespoke, handcrafted Italian copper stills built by the renowned Barison Family.



SINGLE POT STILL IRISH WHISKEY

NOSE: Warm inviting nose with Caramel Toffee notes, Soft Oak Vanilla, Malt Cereal and a hint of Coconut.

TASTE: A surge of rich Earthy Malt with sweet and spicy notes of Licorice, Cloves, Dried Fruit and Green Cardamom.

FINISH: Long Malty finish yields to Cloved Oranges and Aniseed.





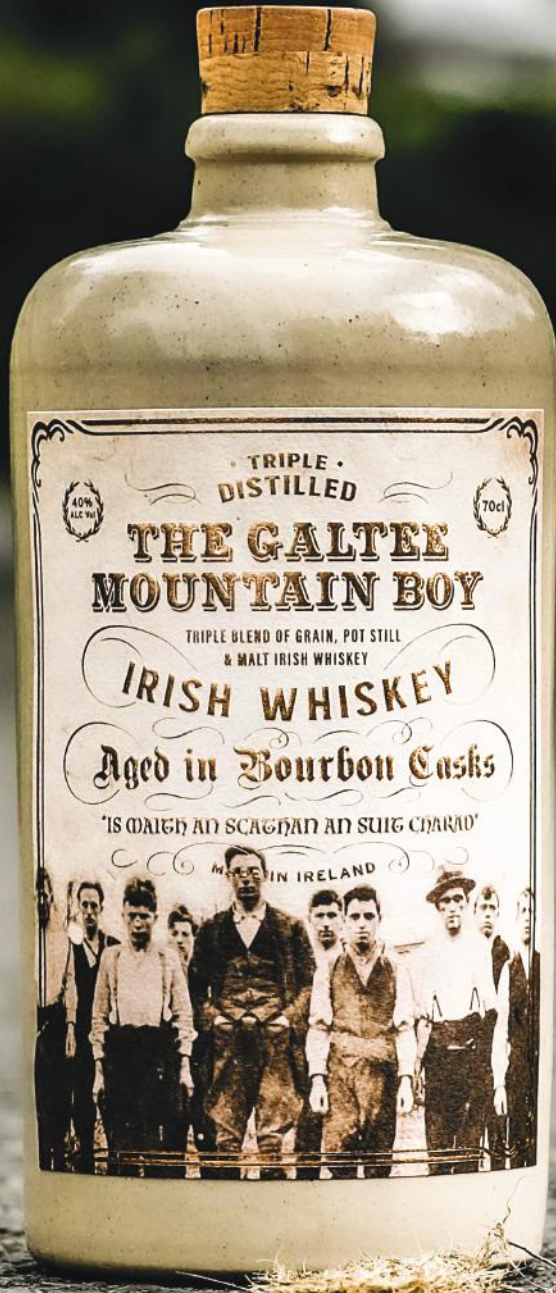

This unique finish results in smooth and relaxing whiskey with notes of dried fruit and sweetness on the nose, complimented by vanilla, nutmeg and toffee on the palate with caramel undertones, followed by a citrus finish.

TIFFON COGNAC Jarnac, France

In 1875, Médéric Tiffon created the Tiffon Cognac distillery. His business was prosperous and soon began exporting to many countries. Centuries later, the family-run business continues to operate from the majestic Château de Triac, just outside the town of Jarnac. The family maintains 40 hectares of Grande Champagne and Fins Bois vines, overseen by cellar master Richard Braastad.



VS COGNAC

After double distillation, the Eau-de-Vie is put into Limousin oak casks to age and mellow for a minimum of 2 years. This blend includes cognac that has been matured for 12 years in Limousin oak casks.

TASTING NOTES: Dried fruit aromas combined with a pleasant fresh oak character. Nutty vanilla notes on the finish.



VSOP COGNAC

AGE: Minimum 4 years

TASTING NOTES: An elegant nose with soft floral character. The palate is mellow and fruity, rounded out by hints of spice and vanilla. Very smooth, with good length finish.



SUPREME COGNAC

This cognac has a high average maturing age, lending it an opulent, harmonious flavor.

AGE: A blend of cognacs from 4 to 10 years old

TASTING NOTES: Aromatic toffee and dried fruit, enhanced by notes of sandalwood, clove and pepper, all overlaid with soft oak. Palate shows wonderful balance, despite the impressive complexity.



XO COGNAC

With a minimum of 10 years in the blend, this noble XO is a perfect marriage of some of the best and oldest cognacs.

TASTING NOTES: Distinctive with a touch of dry fruits, followed by aromatic complexity with a prevailing scent of vanilla. Rose and fruit flavors are perfectly balanced. Smooth and rich with tangerine and marmalade finishing notes.



EXTRA COGNAC

The pride of the Tiffon family, a collection of their most exquisite vintage cognacs up to 100 years old. Tiffon EXTRA embodies the expertise of the Cellar Master and 5 generations.

TASTING NOTES: Pronounced notes of rancio, along with aromas of leather, soy sauce and antique furniture. Notes of burnt sugar, black pepper and roasted nuts with underlying notes of plum and apricot.

Since 1895, Gascony history has preserved the traditional ways of making Armagnac that is utilized by Pierre Dussaux Armagnac to this day. Natural fermentation of grape juice is followed by an early distillation to preserve the expressive, bountiful fruity flavors. Their fine old copper still has been used for generations to create the Blanche d'Armagnac, which is then aged in oak barrels in their 120-year-old cellar. Today, the past inspires them to push the standards and level of quality that they strive to achieve while creating Pierre Dussaux Armagnacs.

HISTORY

According to local legend, Navy Island changed hands in the 1940s during a rum-fueled poker game involving a Hollywood celebrity. Even today, the island remains one of the most beautiful spots in the Caribbean. The rich and vibrant history of Navy Island inspired this traditional Jamaican rum brand.

THE AWARD-WINNING Isle of Harris Gin is distilled in the small harbor village of Tarbert in a small copper gin still, known as 'The Dotach'.

The gin uses nine botanicals including Sugar Kelp seaweed, which imparts a subtle coastal freshness to the spirit. Sugar Kelp is harvested by a local diver from the seas around the Outer Hebrides.

The distillers discard, instead of recycling, the 'heads' and 'tails' of the spirit run, leaving only the best of the distillate's 'heart' helping to create an exceptional smoothness.

DISTILLERIE DU ST. LAURENT began with some "tests" in a basement in Rimouski, Quebec, where two pigheaded friends disregarded conventions and were inspired by their own terroir to create whimsical and distinctive spirits.

Distilled in small batches in Rimouski, St. Laurent Gin is a breath of salt-sea air, of powerful herbaceous and floral notes interspersed by a pine aroma reminiscent of the Quebec boreal forest. It's a complex gin born of an unlikely union of spices hailing from the four corners of the globe and laminaria seaweed of the St. Lawrence River, hand-harvested in the Bas-Saint-Laurent region.

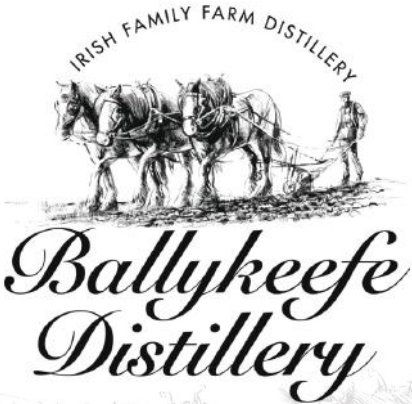

Arak Brun has been in production since the inception of the winery in 1868. It is made from the alcohol of estate grown Obeidi and Cinsault grapes, harvested at optimum ripeness, and blended with fresh anise. Domaine des Tourelles grows its own anise in Deir el Ahmar, a village in the district of Baalbek.

This arak is produced inside a hundred year old cellar, processed traditionally using a three-stage distillation in traditional alem-bics, and aged in clay jars.

TASTING NOTES

Arak Brun is a smooth and wonderful spirit that will perfectly match any Mediterranean dish and much more. Pour it neat and then to add ice-cold water to taste.

Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest, largest, and most visited winery. It was here, in 1857, that Jesuit brothers produced Lebanon's first non-sweet red wine.

DISTILLATION & MATURATION

The first distillation releases the alcohol from the wine in a column still, eliminating the methanol and heavy oils that spoil the taste.

The liquid is distilled with aniseed a second time in a specially designed alembic to extract the "heart" cut, the highest quality portion of the distillate. Finally, the spirit is refined a third time to achieve the purest and healthiest arak.

The arak is then aged for 28 months in traditional hand-made clay jars from the Lebanese mountain village of Beit Chebab.



SERVING & PAIRING

Best served in a glass with one third arak, two thirds water, add the ice last.

Arak is the traditional partner with the mezze dishes and fried or grilled seafood that grace the Lebanese table, the aniseed cleansing the palate between each dish. It is increasingly consumed as an aperitif.

TAMBO was born from a century-old recipe from the DELLEPIANE family and arises from the idea of expanding to the world an Argentinian flavor as it is the Dulce de Leche. TASTING NOTES: Sweetness and smoothness in the mouth are at the forefront. Gradually, the presence of vanilla, toffee, and the Dulce de Leche notes unfold, and finally, a round creaminess completes the flavor.

Tambo can be enjoyed alone, with ice, or incorporated into desserts.

This crème de mûre is made by macerating blackberries in alcohol. It is distinguished by its dark robe and intense flavor.

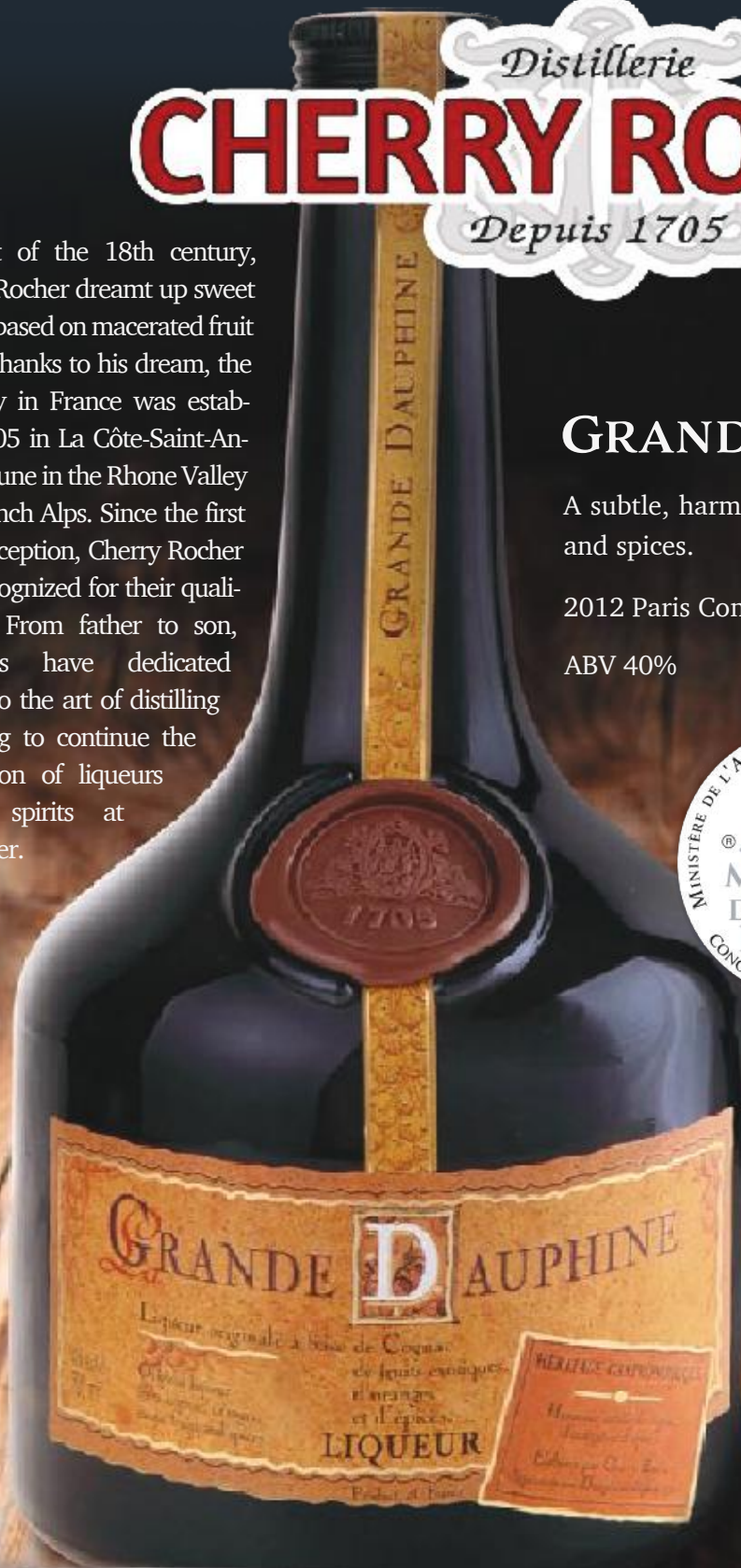

The famous Burgundy Blackcurrant is the most aromatic in the world and features as the main ingredient in Sathenay's Crème de Cassis.

The elaboration process respects the fruit and takes into account its fragility: the maceration of the blackcurrant berries in alcohol takes place in rotating stainless steel tanks, protected from air and light. After a passage in the press, the infusions are sweetened exclusively with French dry sugar: they contain no additives.

Color: Bright garnet
