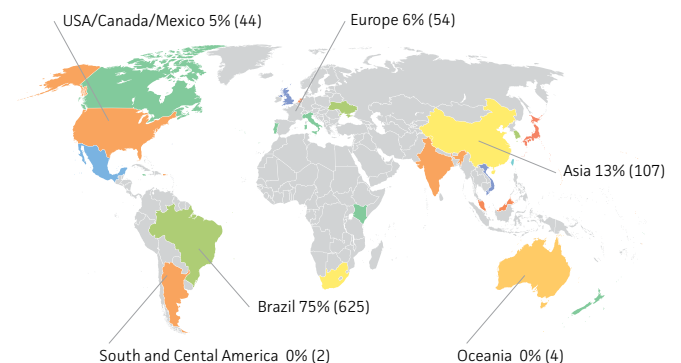
Escola Americana de Campinas (EAC)

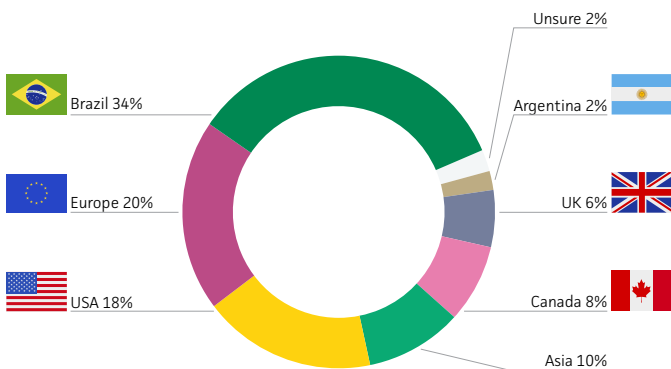

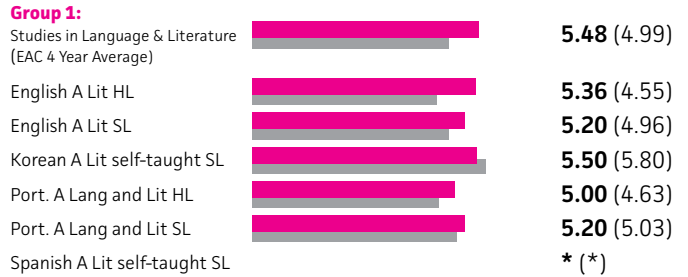

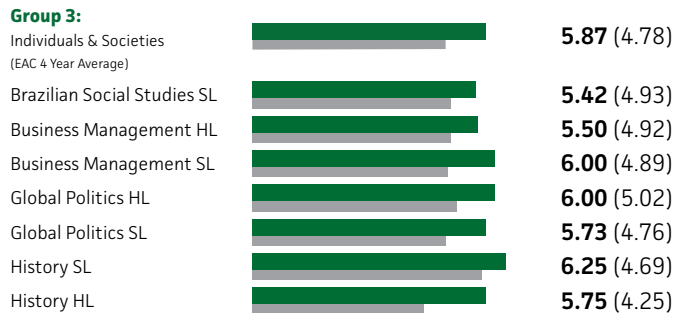
