Journey 1 Introduction

The world is in trouble. God's people are in trouble. They have been waiting a long time for the promised Messiah, the Saviour, to come and rescue them. After being slaves in another country, they are back in their homeland, but now they are living under the crushing rule of the Romans. They are still allowed to go to the temple, but the religious leaders have made the laws of God so hard they are impossible to obey. And now they must follow Roman laws, too, including paying their hefty taxes.

It is like a dark cloud is hanging over them. Over 400 years ago the prophet Isaiah told God's people that a child would be born, and he would be the Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. Isaiah said that he would reign on David's throne and over his kingdom and would uphold justice and righteousness forever.

Will the people of God ever hear from God again? Will he ever fulfil his promise?

• Day 7: Talk to others about what you learned.

• Finish the trip by putting a stamp in your passport.

And there are lots of extras each week like Lev's Extra Explorations and Bo's Did You Know?

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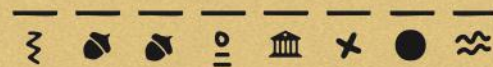
TIP #4

DAY 1 We made it!

It looks like we landed in Jerusalem. Can you see the temple? I wonder if we can find Zechariah there? Let's find out what happened.

Read Luke 1:5–25 Now complete DAY 1 of the Landers Log.



DAY 2

Read Luke 1:5–10

It was an ordinary day for the priest Zechariah but that is about to change.

DAY 3 Read Luke 1:11–15

Zechariah's unexpected visitor had a surprising message. Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth are going to have a baby—a very special baby.



I was just doing my job as I was waiting for God to answer my prayer. I can't tell you how terrified I was when an angel spoke to me!

DAY 4 Read Luke 1:16–18

The angel told Zechariah his child would also have a very special purpose. He would go before the Lord in the spirit and power of the prophet Elijah and turn people back to God. (If you want to know more about Elijah read 1 Kings chapter 17. It will take a while to read it, but Elijah did amazing things.)

DAY 5 Read Luke 1:19–25

Zechariah asked the angel for a sign that what he said would really happen. The angel told him that he would be unable to speak until the baby was born. That would be over nine months! That's a long time.

It is time to go back home and think about what we discovered.

We are back on Terra Firma!
(that means firm land)

DAYS 6 & 7

This isn't the last time we will see Zechariah or the angel Gabriel. Now it is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Lander's Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

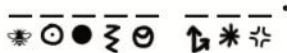
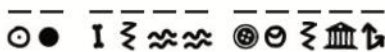

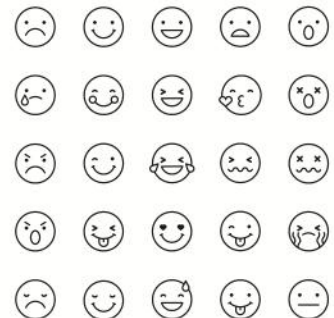


DID YOU KNOW?

Ready for another adventure? Let's pray before we go. **PRAY**—Ask God to help you understand this special message and what this special news means for us and the whole world.

Is everyone ready for Trip 2? Hold on tight as we land in the next page of the Ancient Sketchbook!

Wait—we are going to someone's house! I think I see a young woman!

And we're off again;
this time to Nazareth!
Here we go!

DAY 1 We made it to Nazareth.

Did you think that we were finished with angels? Guess what—Gabriel is back! Let's find out what happened. **Read Luke 1:26–38**

DAY 2 Read Luke 1:26–29

Mary was troubled when the angel appeared. And what did “highly favoured” mean?

DAY 3

Read Luke 1:30–31

When the angel told her she was going to have a baby, Mary was stunned and confused. And the baby's name was already decided!

I was worried when the angel appeared. Then I was totally surprised by his message. Me giving birth to a son could only be a miracle of God.

DAY 5

Read Luke 1:34–38

Mary asked the angel how any of this could happen. Gabriel explained everything to her and assured her that, if this could happen to Elizabeth, it could happen to her! With God all things are possible.

DAY 4 Read Luke 1:32–33

The angel told Mary her child would have a very special purpose. He was to be a king, and his kingdom would never end! (If you want to know more about this baby, read Isaiah 9:6–7. These words were said hundreds of years before the angel appeared to Mary.)

DAYS 6 & 7

Mary will soon go to visit her relative, Elizabeth. Where have we heard that name before? But now it is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

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TRIP 3: A LEAP OF FAITH_

We are off on another trip. Hyla will open the Ancient Sketchbook for us.

i The angel Gabriel delivered two very important messages—one to Elizabeth's husband Zechariah, and one to Mary. Both Elizabeth and Mary were going to have very special babies. Now the two women, who were relatives, wanted to share their news with each other. Mary went to Elizabeth's home for a long visit and, when they met, something quite unexpected happened—something that confirmed just how special these babies were! **PRAY**—talk to God about the things you will be doing this week.

Wow! I see Mary and Elizabeth. They are in Elizabeth's home in the hill country of Judea, and they look very excited!

Get your hiking boots on.
Here we go!

I was so excited to see Mary again. But I wasn't expecting my baby to be excited about Mary's baby. This must be a true miracle of God!

DAY 1 Mary and Elizabeth were both expecting babies.

Mary was young and had not expected or planned to have a baby. Elizabeth was older and did not think she could have a baby.

Read Luke 1:39–56

DAY 2

Read Luke 1:39–41

Mary couldn't wait to tell Elizabeth everything. When they met, not only were the two women excited to see each other, but Elizabeth's baby was too!

DAY 3

Read Luke 1:42–45

Zechariah and Elizabeth had been told that their son would “make ready a people prepared for the Lord” and that he would “be filled with the Holy Spirit even before he is born”. Now it was happening—God was fulfilling his promise.

DAY 4 Read Luke 1:46–50

Mary responded to Elizabeth with a song of praise. She knew what great thing God had done, not just for her, but for generations! (If you want to read another song of praise by another young mother, read 1 Samuel 2:1–10. You may find some similarities.)

DAY 5

Read Luke 1:51–56

Mary's song ends with the declaration that God will be merciful to his people—a promise made many centuries ago. Mary knew for sure that she was the bearer of that promise.

DAYS 6 & 7

What is going to happen now that Mary has returned home? What will Joseph think? Now it is time to **think** about this trip. **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

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BLESSED—what does it mean? Blessed means to be favoured by God like Mary and the child she would bear. It can also mean that a person is happy and content because of what God has done for them.

TRIP 4: A MESSAGE IN A DREAM_



Elizabeth and Mary were both expecting babies. Now there was another person who urgently needed a special message—this time it would be delivered in a dream!

PRAY—Think about the week ahead and talk to God about any concerns you have.

We are off on another trip. This time we are headed back to Nazareth.

It looks like a carpenter who has just woken up from a deep sleep. Get ready—and look out for angels!

Off we go!



DAY 3 Read Matthew 1:20–21

An angel appeared to Joseph, and he discovered he was part of God's much bigger plan, a plan that existed long before Joseph was born. The child's name would be Jesus which means "the Lord saves".

DAY 5 Read Matthew 1:24–25

Joseph's response was to accept God's plan and to obey. He could see that being part of God's bigger plan was something amazing—and it was far better than his own plans.

Hey, Immanuel is the word that opened the Time Capsule!

What an incredible trip. And now we are on our way home.

We are back on Terra Firma!

DAYS 6 & 7 On our next trip, we will visit the hill country of Judea again and I think I hear a baby crying! Now it is time to **think** about this trip, **write** in your Landers Log, and **talk** to your Travel Guide.

DAY 1

We are back in Nazareth.

Today we are in the home of Joseph, the man to whom Mary is engaged.

Read Matthew 1:18–25

DAY 4 Read Matthew 1:22–23

This baby was no ordinary baby. The people had been waiting for someone God had promised to send to save them, and this special baby, Jesus, was going to be that person. He is Immanuel—God with us. (If you want to see the original words of the prophecy, read Isaiah 7:14.)

DAY 2

Read Matthew 1:18–19

Joseph was engaged to Mary and planned to marry her. Then he discovered Mary was pregnant. Joseph decided to quietly break off the engagement so he wouldn't embarrass her.

I was sweating and having a hard time sleeping. I was worried about my plan to break the engagement. Then an angel appeared and changed everything.

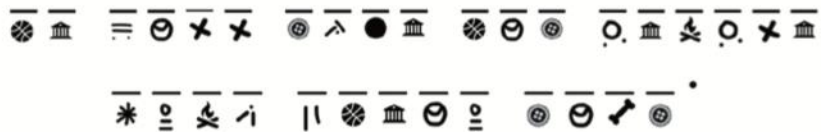

Read Luke 1:57–58

News travelled fast and there was a huge celebration at the home of Zechariah and Elizabeth. The promise of a child had been fulfilled!

DAY 3

Read Luke 1:59–63

The guests didn't quite understand what was going on and they insisted that the baby should be named after his father. That was the way things were done. But Zechariah knew the right thing to do and did it.

DAY 4

Read Luke 1:64–66

As soon as Zechariah could speak again, he "spoke well" of God. The people in the house were in shock and wondered who this child could possibly be.

A prophet was a person who proclaimed God's message to his people. They also told them what the future would be like. There were many prophets in the Old Testament, including Elijah and Isaiah. John's father, Zechariah, said that John would be a "prophet of the Most High."



TRIP 6: THE ROMANS AND THE ROAD TRIP_

Are you ready for our next trip? This time we are off to Nazareth... oops...I mean Bethlehem.

Joseph and Mary just arrived in Bethlehem and there are so many people there. Shall we join them?

At this time in history, the Romans were in control of most the Mediterranean world. Caesar Augustus decided he wanted a census taken so that he would have a record of all the people who lived there. Mary and Joseph had to travel almost 100 miles to Bethlehem, and Mary was going to have her baby very soon. They would have to walk and travel by donkey and find somewhere to stay amid all the crowds. They might have thought this trip was an impossible burden to bear. But we will soon find out that it was all part of God's plan.

PRAY—Thank God that he keeps his word.

DAY 1 Here we are in Bethlehem.

Mary and Joseph just arrived, and it looks like they are having a hard time finding a place to stay. It also looks like they might have to find room for one more!

Read Luke 2:1-7

DAY 2

Read Luke 2:1-2

The census would not only count the number of people in the Roman Empire, but it was also a way to find out who would have to pay taxes!



DAY 3

Read Luke 2:3-4

Joseph may have been from the line of King David, but he certainly didn't live in a palace. He was a carpenter by trade and lived in Nazareth.

It had been a long journey and Mary was so tired. We had to find a place to stay for the night. The baby was coming soon!

DAY 4 Read Luke 2:5-6

The special baby that God had given Mary would soon be born. Babies were normally born at home. This one would be born in Bethlehem and in a surprising place. (A prophet called Micah wrote hundreds of years earlier that the Saviour would be born in Bethlehem. Read Micah 5:2 to find out more.)

Time to go home. But we will see the baby again on our next trip.

DAY 5

Read Luke 2:7

There was no guest room and no bed available for the birth of the baby. Mary wrapped him in cloths and his crib was an animal's feeding tray. Was this the child through whom God's promise was to be fulfilled?

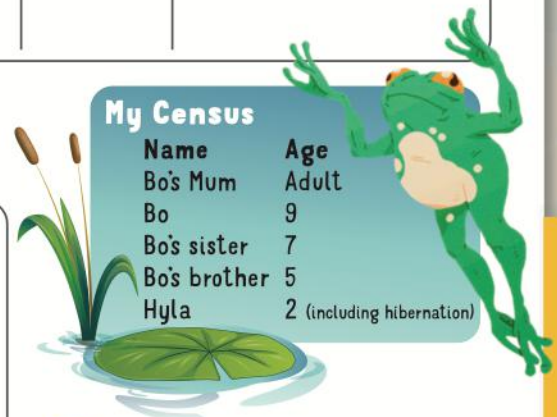

DID YOU KNOW?

CENSUS—What is it?

A census is used to gather information about the people of a particular country. It is often carried out every so many years to track changes in the population. The Babylonians were the first to take a census in 3800 BC to record the number of people and livestock and the stores of food and wool.

Read Luke 2:8–9

The shepherds lived in the fields looking after their sheep. When the angel appeared, and they were surrounded by light, they were terrified.

When the angel appeared, we were so scared. But when we heard the angel's message, our fear turned to excitement. Could it be true? We had to go to Bethlehem to see for ourselves.

DAY 3 Read Luke 2:25–32

Simeon's wait had finally come to an end. As he took Jesus in his arms, he burst into praise. At last, he had seen the one who was not just God's salvation for his people, but for the whole world.

DAY 5 Read Luke 2:36–40

Anna was a prophet. She was at least 84 years old and most of that time she had been a widow! Like Simeon, she knew that Jesus was the one God had promised. Mary and Joseph headed home to watch their child grow.

King Herod had a plan that involved the Magi, but he wasn't totally truthful. He thought he would involve them in getting rid of any competition.

Time to go back home. I wonder if we will travel through the stars?

Today we discover why and we see why Herod really wanted to find Jesus. Some parts of this story might be upsetting. You may want to read it with an older friend, parent, or your Travel Guide.

Read Matthew 2:13–18

DAY 3 Read Matthew 2:14–15

Trusting God for their future, Joseph packed up the family and headed for Egypt. It would be around 90 miles to the border where they would be safe. They were not certain when they would be able to return home, but they knew it was part of God's plan.



Herod

The Magi did not do what I told them to do and left without coming back to Jerusalem. There is no way I am going to let another king take my place!

DAY 4 Read Matthew 2:16

Herod was furious and his decision made clear what was in his heart. He was only concerned about his kingship, not for the people he ruled.

DAY 5 Read Matthew 2:17–18

Something similar had happened in the time of Jeremiah, the prophet. Many of God's people who were descendants of Jacob and Rachel were captured by Babylon and killed in Ramah a city of Benjamin. Herod carried out his terrible order fully knowing who it was he was trying to kill—the Messiah, King of the Jews.

I think it is time to go home.

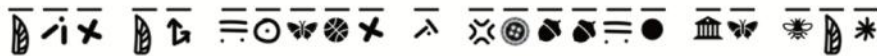

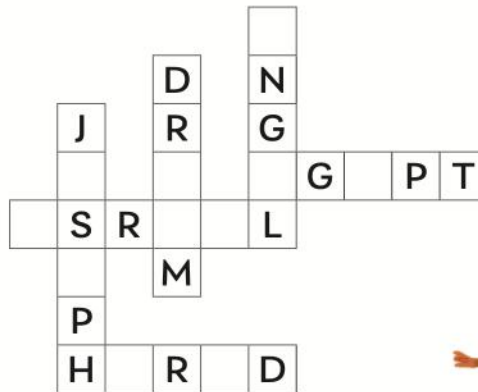

DAY 4 Read Luke 2:47–50

Everyone was amazed; not because the lost was found, but because of what he was saying to the teachers! And he had an unusual response to his mother's question. What could he have meant by "my Father's house"?

It's time to go. I wish we could stay longer.

DAY 5 Read Luke 2:51–52

Confused but relieved, Mary and Joseph returned home with Jesus, who was always obedient to them. Mary kept thinking about what happened. God had given her an amazing child. As Jesus grew up, this became more and more clear to her and others.

DAYS 6 & 7

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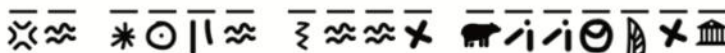

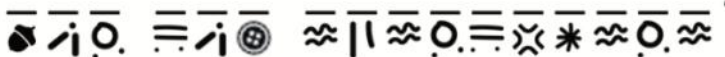
