Various additional activities are woven into the school day, from the Arts Award delivered to students in Year 8 Art, to LAMDA and Instrumental lessons, to the collaborative arts and science project in partnership with the Protein Databank in Europe and our morning music and choir sessions and an array of enrichment trips, visits, workshops and talks, there is a rich variety of experiences to access.

Registering for your enrichment sessions

You will now register at your enrichment sessions by scanning a QR code using your phone and clicking on the enrichment session you are attending. You have permission to use your phone anywhere on site to register for your enrichment. If you attend a lunchtime enrichment session you also have permission, then put your phone away afterwards. QR codes will be printed and on display near all classrooms, and your teachers will also have a copy for you to scan. If you do not have a phone with you, the link to the form will also be emailed to you and your teacher so that you can register from a computer or chromebook.

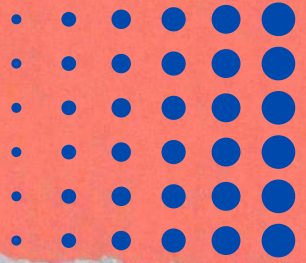
