

The Women's College & Student Club Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Women's College & Student Club Scholarship was offered for the first time in 2023 with the intention of funding a scholarship for a resident of The Women's College.

The Scholarship is an initiative between The Women's College and the Student Club Executive for the UQ Giving Day.

The Terms of the Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. The name of the Scholarship shall be The Women's College & Student Club Scholarship and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College and the Student Club Executive.
- 2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a current resident of The Women's College in their third year of residence during the tenure of the Scholarship and who is enrolled at a Brisbane university.
- 3. This Scholarship is awarded to a current resident who is an inspirational student who has raised her profile and standing within the College community, demonstrating outstanding community service and/or continuous and significant contributions in a leadership role. The recipient is a well-rounded student who has excellent participation or supported activities across all aspects of College life. These qualities balanced with academic excellence (Minimum GPA of 5) will be considered. A student who is responsible for paying her own residential fees may also be considered.
- 4. The recipient of the Scholarship will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.
- 5. The Scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year. The Scholarship shall lapse upon the student ceasing to be in residence at the College.
- 6. The value and frequency of the Scholarship shall be determined by agreement with the Head of College. In its first year, the Scholarship will equate to \$4,000 per annum.
- 7. The Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:
 - a) is no longer enrolled in a full-time university course
 - b) not maintaining satisfactory academic progress
 - c) not maintaining a presence within the College community, cultural and sports program;
 - d) is no longer a resident of The Women's College
