8,300 Zoom licenses Zoom license renewals went online

this year. Member response was so swift, we were able to reach a deeper discount tier, saving an additional \$2.99 per license for greater sectorwide savings of \$24,817. At just \$23.97 per license, BC's K-12 sector enjoys a significant savings from the initial rate of \$109 per license.

Procurement Services

By negotiating licensing and supplier agreements on behalf of BC's K-12 sector, Focused ED's procurement team is able to ensure every district and member school has the same access to preferential rates, regardless of location or size.

Regional Discussions Guide Planning

Focused ED held a series of regional discussions in the fall to share information on key activities and seek input from members on their priorities. In spring, we hosted an Info Hour series to provide updates on our progress.

Mitigating Supply Disruptions

COVID 19 and extreme weather in BC impacted some supply chains. Our procurement team worked with suppliers to provide members with updates around potential delays and other developments, so members could plan to meet their needs while mitigating or avoiding disruptions.

Education Services

Focused ED trained a cohort of 94 new and returning BCTF-appointed evaluators who began a three-year term this year. We focused on growing the number of diverse voices in the K-12 Evaluated Resource Collection, including Indigenous-authored and French-language resources.

New Digital Resources

New French Immersion Resources for K-7

Two new suites of K-7 French Immersion resources were made available at no cost to all members through 2025 thanks to funding by the Ministry of Education and Child Care and support from the Government of Canada. The bilingual Live It Earth suite focuses on place-based, hybrid learning experiences, informed by Indigenous perspectives and supplemented by extensive instructional supports. IDÉLLO features more than 15,000 French educational resources: videos, games, websites, applications, and teaching tools.

Anti-Racism Learning Resources for K-12

This year, an inventory of more than 200 anti-racism resources that align with BC's K-12 curriculum was made available to all members. Funded by the Ministry of Education and Child Care and curated with the guidance of a multi-stakeholder advisory committee, these learning resources span topics including anti-racism, human rights, diverse cultural experiences, history, and contributions of IBPOC people in Canada.

RESOURCES THAT EMPOWER



We have 5 Ukrainian families coming to our district. Our ELL lead was asking how to use Google Translate to translate web pages for two of the Grade 7 students, so they can study the same thing as their peers.

Instead, I showed her World Book and how to translate the article to Ukrainian — she was blown away and super excited to show it to the two students and their new classroom teacher.

I lived above the Arctic Circle teaching in a remote K-12 school for four years. The polar bear and narwhal were the *coolest* neighbours I've ever had.




ShareEdBC

To help educators benefit from the resources available through BC Digital Classroom and the K-12 Evaluated Resource Collection, this year Focused ED facilitated writing teams that contributed 10 comprehensive units about resources we have evaluated to this collaborative space for teachers.

Webinars & Videos

To enhance accessibility of webinar-style content, Focused ED posted videos to Vimeo that highlight Twig and Tig Tag's science resources, a BC Digital Classroom overview and a spotlight on World Book Discover.





On-Demand Pro-D Sessions

Focused ED introduced on-demand sessions, delivered by the Professional Learning Team, to provide members with the learning they want, when and how they want it. These virtual sessions were first created for the province-wide professional day in October, with more sessions created upon request for district professional development days.

Information Privacy

Due Diligence Workshop

Focused ED's annual Due Diligence Workshop in January featured a keynote address by BC's Information and Privacy Commissioner, Michael McEvoy. The day's sessions spanned privacy governance, cloud architecture and privacy, and privacy breach management and reporting. Participants included 137 attendees from 47 districts and 25 attendees from independent schools.

Privacy Breach Management and Breach Reporting and Privacy in Education: From Principles to Practice were the workshop's most popular sessions at 109 and 104 participants respectively.

PIA Templates

Changes to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act required most PIA templates to be updated this year.

I recently hiked 55 kilometers to Ciudad Perdida in the Sierra Nevada Mountains of Colombia.






