Instrumental Strides: 2023 a Pivotal Year for Equishox Advancements

Two years after commencing the design and prototyping stage of EQUISHOX, we received our first production prototypes in mid-October 2023.

Following this milestone, we initiated efforts to share the EQUISHOX story globally. Presentations on EQUISHOX took us to visit some of the largest bloodstock enterprises, prominent owners, distinguished trainers, and top farriers.

We obtained approval from the BHA, IRHB and the NSA (Nation Steeplechase Association) and are currently in discussions for approval with authorities in France, Australia, and the USA.

As of today, (30) owners, trainers, pre-trainers, and farriers have the EQUISHOX shoes on test. The feedback received thus far regarding horse welfare, injury rehabilitation, injury prevention, wear rate, and performance improvement has been truly remarkable.
