As a parent, what do I need to do before going into "Summer Mode"?

Please register NOW to return and sign up for any fall **and** spring classes of interest to reserve your spots. We have many new families interested in joining us, so we've given our current families priority entry during the first month, now through **June 6th**, knowing you can make adjustments if needed through **August 6th** when the registration window closes to all. Although you are signing up for the full year ahead, you are committing to a semester at a time, and can make changes mid-year for the second semester as long as it's before the first semester concludes.



Why are we moving to Westview?

ECS Leadership has been praying the entire school year about the spacing needs with growing programming at Emmanuel, and considers the nearby Westview site a great solution, however temporarily, while ECS continues construction plans here.

Why are the enrollment costs changing?



Operating alongside the accredited ECS school structure helps us share resources (staff, trainings, supplies, knowledge base+) but we use our own database subscriptions instead of running our information through the State. Our *annual* registration/facility fee increased to \$300 per student (max of \$750 per family) to help cover the administrative costs involved, as well as split the expense of a new site, which benefits the long-term growth and vision of the ministry. Thankfully, we now offer payment plans throughout the school year to also help our families!
