EARLY CHILDHOOD FAMILY EDUCATION (ECFE) CLASSES INCLUDE

Parent and Child Time

Parents and children participate in activities together in our early childhood classroom. The activities support the development of language, fine motor, social-emotional, cognitive and physical skills.

Children's Discovery Time

While parents are in their own session, children play and learn with other children and our early childhood teaching team. This time supports interacting with others and developing friendship skills.

Parent Time

During Children's Discovery Time, parents join a supportive group led by a parent educator. In this session, parents will:

- Celebrate accomplishments and discuss challenges.
- Explore intentional parenting and set family goals.
- Connect with other families within your community.

INFANT CLASSES

Registration is based on age of the infant at the start of the class.



Come interact with your baby in a space designed especially for infants and connect with other families in the community. Learn fun play ideas, songs and gain parenting support.

Discussions cover topics such as bonding, brain development, milestones, routines, feeding, sleep and more. Infant classes are non-separating; families stay together for the entire class time.

The Fourth Trimester (Birth to 12 weeks)

The first 12 weeks postpartum, often called the fourth trimester, are crucial for mom and baby. Our classes cover the realities of this period, offering essential resources and building awareness that challenges are normal. You'll weigh and measure your newborn, track their growth and get advice on sleep, attachment, development, and mental health. Join us to build a supportive community of families, sharing experiences, learning and growing together.

Infant Classes (Birth to 12 months)

Interact with your baby in a space designed for infants and meet other families. Learn fun play ideas, songs and get parenting support. Topics include bonding, family life, brain development, milestones, routines, feeding and sleep.

Infant Massage (Birth to 9 months)

Understand and respond to your baby's cues through the relaxing practice of massage. Learn techniques for better sleep, digestion, brain development and deepening attachment. One-time classes offer a general overview, while two-time classes provide in-depth learning and practice opportunities.

PRESCHOOL AND PRE-K

For children three or four years old on or before September 1, 2024.

Our preschool and pre-k classes support young children with their first school experience.

- **Qualified Staff:** Teachers are licensed in Early Childhood and/or Parent Education.

Before the lottery:

Once you check out, your selections will be "waiting for lottery."

Registrations completed by 10 a.m. on August 7 will enter the random lottery drawing.

After the lottery:

Registrations will be accepted first-come, first-served until classes are full. Space is limited.

Class registration is limited:

To serve as many families as possible, registration is limited to one ECFE class per child.

Cancellation:

Classes may be canceled due to low enrollment. We will help you select another class or provide a full refund if your class is canceled.

Class Fees:

Fees are processed on August 7. After the lottery, fees are charged at the time of registration.

Refunds:

Full refunds are available if you cancel before class starts. After classes begin, refunds are prorated. To cancel, contact the ECFE office at 763-391-8777.

Immunization Record (required)

Provide your child's immunization record. Medical exemptions (signed by a health care provider) or notarized conscientious objection forms are accepted. Adults do not need to provide their immunization records.

Health Forms (required, if applicable)

If your child has a health need requiring medication or special attention at school, parents/guardians must complete health forms. For asthma, seizure, or severe allergy action plans, your clinic can fax a copy directly to the program nurse at 763-391-8762. Health forms are available online - bit.ly/ECFE-Health-History.
