When I started out, our goals were modest. I thought we could reduce food waste a bit and feed some hungry people. In our second year our growth goals were more ambitious, yet we managed to exceed them. Never in my wildest imagination could I have envisioned what this organization has become.

Here are a few highlights from our incredible year:

- We rescued enough food, that would otherwise end up in a landfill, to provide **1.5 million meals** for our neighbors in need.
- We now provide food to **50 partner agencies**.
- We currently **rescue food from 25 sources** including grocery stores, big box stores, caterers, farms and distributors.
- We now deliver food (utilizing two trucks and a van) to **20 cities** throughout the metro area.
- Most importantly, we have **impacted the lives of thousands of people** providing them with nourishment they might otherwise go without.

Of course we couldn't accomplish these amazing feats without the support of our partners and our crew. Our dedicated drivers, our small, flexible staff, food providers, board members and especially our donors whose belief in our mission steers our ship and fuels our growth.

I promise that we won't rest on our milk crates and banana boxes. We've got a lot to do in the coming year and with your help we'll **WASTE LESS & FEED MORE.**

Thats enough food for **3,000,000** meals for our neighbors in need.

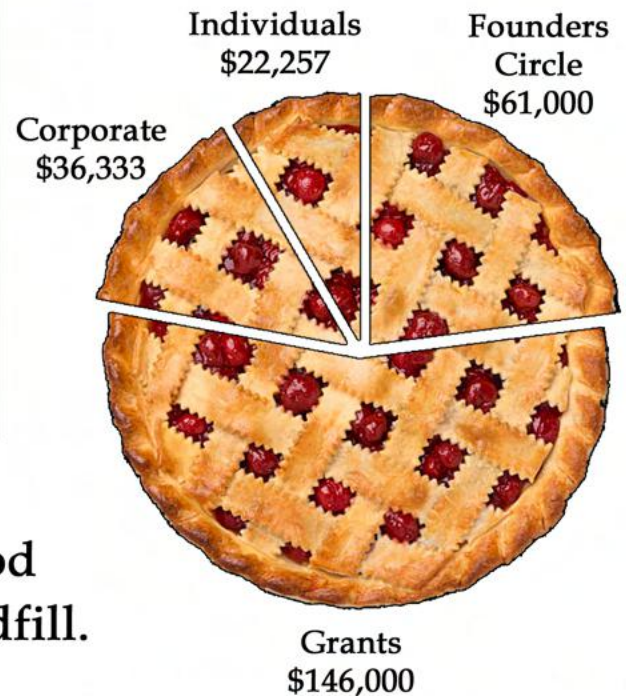
This year, we added **17** drop-off locations.
