

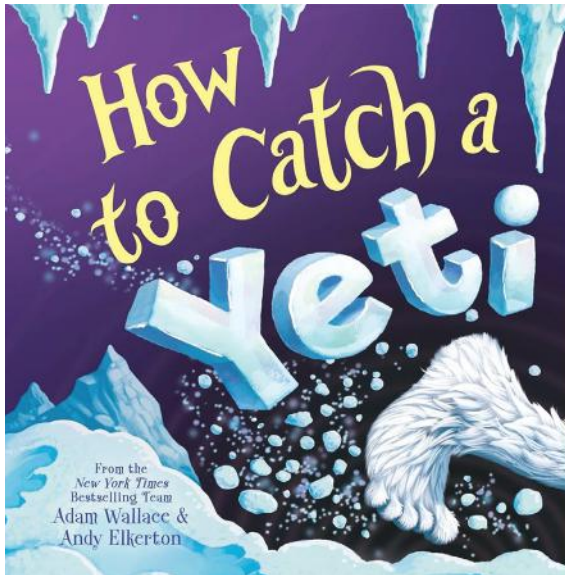

You can enjoy the story on your own anytime between January and February!




LEGO CHALLENGE

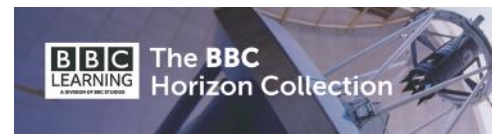

New Year, New Books!

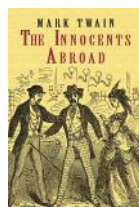
