

## Follow the Blackburn Cathedral Trail

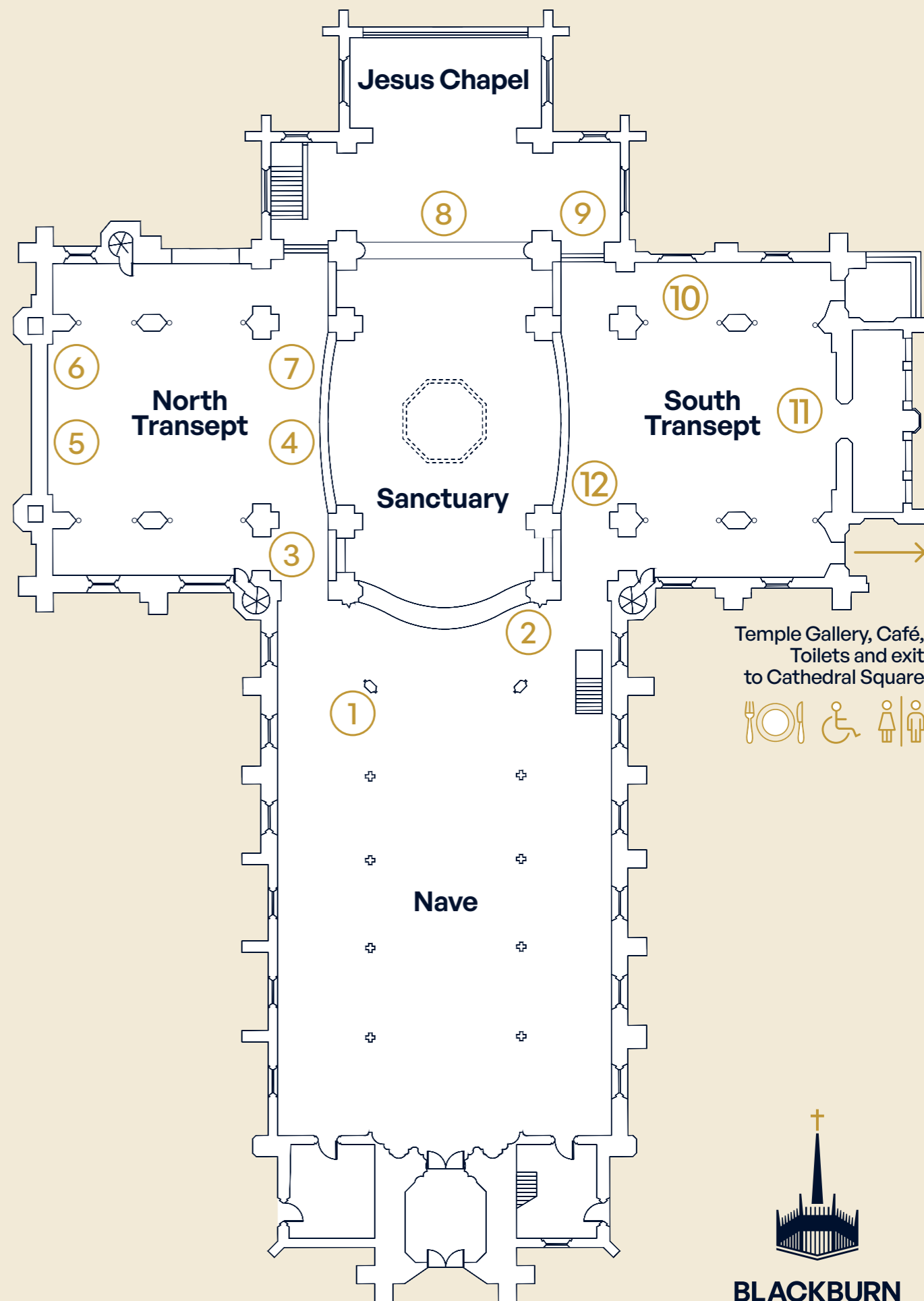


As you move around the building - you will see signage with a number ① on it that provides an introduction to each point of interest.

Highlights of the Cathedral Trail to look out for include:

- ① **Christ the Worker**  
John Hayward's sculpture depicting the risen Christ.
- ② **The Pulpit**  
Completed in 1940 in tribute to a former borough Mayor.
- ③ **The Virgin and Child**  
Josefina de Vasconcellos' 1974 terrassa sculpture.
- ④ **Sanctuary**  
The high altar with John Hayward's stunning Corona above.
- ⑤ **Cathedra**  
Designed by Advent Hunstone and installed in 1953.
- ⑥ **Misericords**  
From the 15th Century, believed to be from Whalley Abbey.
- ⑦ **The Organ**  
One of the most iconic Cathedral organs in the country.
- ⑧ **The Jesus Chapel**  
Featuring the icon depicting Jesus at his resurrection.
- ⑨ **St. Martin's Chapel**  
Chapel dedicated to the Duke of Lancaster's Regiment.
- ⑩ **Mediaeval Pax**  
Reproduction of the Cathedral's most treasured relic.
- ⑪ **The Font**  
In the shape of an egg to symbolise new life.
- ⑫ **The Lantern Tower**  
The Linda Walton glass delivers a kaleidoscope of colour.
