

Use this guide to ensure safe viewing in areas outside designated spectator points

#### MOTORSPORT IS DANGEROUS

Motorsport Australia and its Associated Entitles including West Australian Car Club (Inc) exclude all liability for your attendance/participation at the event except to the extent prohibited by law.

For full disclaimer wording refer to motorsport.org.au/disclaimers

#### NEVER

Never stand in prohibited areas (study the spectator viewing diagrams)

Never stand or sit close to the edge of the road

Never stand below the level of the road (or in gutters or culverts)

Never stand in run-off (escape) routes for the competing cars

Never sit down at a location on the same level as the cars. You need to be standing so that you are able to move away quickly if necessary

Never stand in front of arrows or signs relevant to the running of the event

Never be distracted - always face the competing cars

Never stand on or cross the road while it is officially closed

Never play games with your safety, or with that of the competitors

Never light fires, BBQs, or drop cigarette butts. They can cause fires with serious consequences

Never stand in front of fences or objects preventing you from moving quickly

Never remove rally signs or arrows

Never be distracted

#### **ALWAYS**

Stay ALERT and expect the unexpected

Stand in a safe location

Consider your own safety and that of others at all times

Stand where you can see the competing cars coming and going

Listen for approaching cars

Leave yourself room to move away quickly

Keep children under constand and close supervision

Leave pets at home, please don't bring them to a spectator area

Obey Rally Officials - they are there to ensure the event runs within the safety guidelines prescribed by Motorsport Australia

Take your rubbish with you and keep our frests clean Help the officials to run a safe stage







#### **DIRECTIONS**

At BP Nannup, turn towards Bridgetown for 6kms, then follow the signs to the spectator point

#### TIMING

Competitors on stage (am) **9:00am** Competitors on stage (pm) **1:05pm** 

#### **VIEWING**

The cars come around a sweeping right hand corner then flick the cars left and head off down the hill.

#### **PARKING**

Narrow road to park on.

Allow time to turn your car around for easier exit.

Access may be difficult for visitors with mobility needs or wheelchairs due to uneven ground and limited facilities.



## **DIRECTIONS**

From Nannup, head towards Busselton and turn right onto Cundinup South Road and then onto Cundinup-Kirup Road. The Point is 33kms from Nannup.

#### TIMING

Competitors on stage (am) **10:40am** Competitors on stage (pm) **3:45pm** 

#### **VIEWING**

A well-known Forest Rally Spectator Point. Easy to get to on the edge of the main road. The cars do a sweeping left into a very hard right with a gutter on the inside. Don't stand on the outside of the corner.

#### **PARKING**

Park on fire break on edge on bitumen, stage is very close.

Access may be difficult for visitors with mobility needs or wheelchairs due to uneven ground and limited facilities.


#### VIEWING
