OUR CLINIC

Therapy Matters has a 30-year history of providing private speech pathology services to families on the Gold Coast and Northern NSW. Our 13 speech pathologists have over 130 years of collective wisdom and have been with us from 1 to 18 years. Many of our staff have returned to our practice after periods of maternity leave. We also have a history of employing staff who have successfully combined casual or part-time work at Therapy Matters with other employment in the public sector. Our therapists provide services on the Gold Coast and Tweed, at our Burleigh clinic and our rural Murwillumbah clinic as well as full and half day services to over 6 schools. Therapy Matters is a registered provider with the NDIS.

Therapy Matters together with Kids and Community Occupational Therapy and Dr Karen Plant Psychology are founding members of Therapy Connect Alliance which provides an allied health team for vulnerable families in Murwillumbah NSW under a Communities for Children government grant.

Our accredited key word sign presenters run regular workshops in the KWSA training pathway. We also run workshops on other topics for child care centres, schools and communication partners.

OUR CLIENTS

We are a predominantly paediatric private practice (0-18 years of age) but we do provide continuing, transition services to young adults with disabilities. Our caseload covers a broad generalist caseload of speech, language, fluency, feeding and literacy difficulties. We are proud to have dedicated our clinic through its history to the support of children with disabilities. Therapists will have their client caseload tailored to their interests, experience, skills and professional development in our extensive Matching Matters process which carefully matches clients to therapists for impactful outcomes.







OUR ROOMS

Our clinics are bright, friendly and welcoming with playful waiting rooms and large treating spaces.

Our Burleigh clinic has a large reception space with an art gallery showcasing artists with disabilities. It also has 8 treating rooms, a group room, a staff room, a plant-filled balcony, multiple storage rooms and a collaborative work space. All rooms have windows for natural light except three rooms which have skylights to the outside world and wall-mounted plant frames. Each room in Burleigh is named after a famous person with a disability.

Our Murwillumbah clinic has a cosy reception space with aboriginal artworks, 3 treating rooms, a family meeting room. a group room, a staff room and multiple storage areas. All rooms have windows for natural light.



OUR SURROUNDS

Therapy Matters has two clinics both nestled in environments that are valued by our team, delicious café precincts and nurturing physical surrounds with nearby parks. Our West Burleigh clinic sits alongside the scenic Tallebudgera Creek and our Murwillumbah clinic is alongside the Tweed River with views to Mt Warning.
