WHO ARE WE?

Founded in 2011, the school has grown steadily while preserving its close-knit community spirit and strong emphasis on outdoor education.

At VIS, the mountain itself becomes one of our greatest teachers. Here, students gain lessons no classroom alone can provide – resilience, curiosity, and personal growth. Learning takes place not only within the walls of a classroom, but also in the mountains, the fresh alpine air, and the space our students are given to explore, make mistakes, reflect, and thrive.





VERBIER

Nestled on a sunny plateau in the Swiss Alps, Verbier has carefully maintained its charm as an alpine village. It is a gateway to the 4 Vallées ski area – with nearly 100 lifts and more than 400 km of ski runs for all levels of expertise. Mont Fort, the highest point of the ski area at 3'330 m, offers a panorama over the Matterhorn, the Grand Combin and the Mont Blanc massif.

Made up of quaint Alpine villages, the Val de Bagnes stretches for more than 25 kilometres, from Le Châble to the impressive Mauvoisin Dam. From pastures to glaciers – the region is home to one of Switzerland's greatest natural reserves.

The language of the region is French, but many residents speak English. German is also widely spoken. The views of the surrounding mountains, forests and valleys are spectacular, and most properties in Verbier are built in a traditional style, incorporating locally-sourced wood and stone.







Verbier's old village is steeped in culture, with winding lanes, traditional wooden houses, called *Mazots*, a historic communal oven, and even a neighbouring fromagerie and dry-stone chapel. Supermarkets are just a 10-minute walk away, and Verbier's vibrant centre is only 15 minutes on foot.







HOTEL SKI

Our Hôtel Ski boarding house is located in the heart of Verbier's charming old village. The building is privately owned by Verbier International School and is exclusively reserved for our boarding students and camp participants. It was purposely built in the 3-peaks style, which is mirrored in our newly built school campus. Hôtel Ski combines a cosy alpine atmosphere with modern comforts.

BOTH HOUSES offer:

- Comfortable en-suite rooms with modern bathrooms
- 2-3 single beds per room
- Ample storage space for students' belongings
- A dedicated area on the lower floor for ski equipment and outdoor shoes
- A welcoming communal area, complete with a pool table and lounge for movie nights
- A dining room and kitchen where breakfast and evening meals are served in-house







CHALET FLORE

Nestled in the centre of Verbier, just 210 metres from the main ski lift, Chalet Flore offers the perfect blend of comfort, convenience, and Alpine charm. Once a renowned 4-star ski hotel, this beautifully modern Swiss chalet-style accommodation has been thoughtfully transformed into a boarding house exclusively for VIS students and campers.

Ideally located for mountain sports enthusiasts, Chalet Flore provides effortless access to Verbier's world-class slopes, scenic hiking trails, and the vibrant array of restaurants and boutiques that make this resort town so special.

Each room features a private balcony with breathtaking mountain views and a modern ensuite bathroom, ensuring a comfortable stay surrounded by the stunning Swiss Alps.


