Exodus 20:7 (NIV)* ⁷ "You shall not misuse the name of 3434 your God, for 3434 will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

2 Timothy 2:19 (NASB)

19 Nevertheless, the firm foundation of God stands, having this seal, "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Everyone who names the name of the Lord is to abstain from wickedness."

James 3:9-10 (NIV)

⁹ With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God's likeness. 10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be.

Jeremiah 23:26-27 (NASB)

²⁶ "How long? Is there *anything* in the hearts of the prophets who prophesy falsehood, even these prophets of the deception of their own heart, ²⁷ who intend to make My people forget My name by their dreams which they relate to one another, just as their fathers forgot My name because of Baal?

Exodus 3:14-15 (NIV)*

¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you." 15 God also said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites, '3434', the God of your fathers--the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob-has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation.

Matthew 6:9 (TEV)

⁹ This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven: May your holy name be honored;

Joel 2:31-32 (NKJV)

The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of 3434. 32 And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of 3434 Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As 3431/ has said, Among the remnant whom 3434 calls.

Psalm 9:1-2 (NASB)*

¹ I will give thanks to **3√3** with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonders. ² I will be glad and exult in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.

Ruth 2:4 (NIV)*

4 Just then **Boaz** arrived from Bethlehem and **greeted** the harvesters, "4744 be with you!" " 4744 bless you!" they called back.

Malachi 3:16 (NKJV)

16 Then those who feared 3434 spoke to one another, And 3434 listened and heard them: So a book of remembrance was written before Him For those who fear 3434 And who meditate on His name

Judges 6:24 (NLT2)

And Gideon built an altar to 3434/
there and named it Yahuah-Shalom
(which means "3434/ is peace"). The
altar remains in Ophrah in the land of
the clan of Abiezer to this day.

Exodus 17:11-13, 15 (NLT2)

11 As long as Moses held up the staff in his hand, the Israelites had the advantage. But whenever he dropped his hand, the Amalekites gained the advantage. ¹² Moses' arms soon became so tired he could no longer hold them up. So Aaron and Hur found a stone for him to sit on. Then they stood on each side of Moses, holding up his hands. So his hands held steady until sunset. 13 As a result, Joshua overwhelmed the army of **Amalek in battle.** 15 Moses built an altar there and named it Yahuah-Nissi (which means "3734" is my banner").

Exodus 15:26 (NASB)*

²⁶ And He said, "If you will give earnest **heed to** the voice of 3434 your God, and do what is right in His sight, and give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians; for I, 3434, am your healer (Ropheka)."

Genesis 22:12-14 (TEV)

- "Now I know that you honor and obey God, because you have not kept back your only son from him."

 13 Abraham looked ground and gay a ram caught in a
- Abraham looked around and saw a ram caught in a bush by its horns. He went and got it and offered it as a burnt offering instead of his son. ¹⁴ Abraham named that place "\$\frac{4}{3}\lambda Provides (Yireh)." And even today people say, "On \$\frac{4}{3}\lambda 's mountain he provides."

YAHUAH-Roi—God our shepherd—Psalm 80:1.

YAHUAH-Yireh—God our provider—Genesis 22:14.

YAHUAH-Shalom—God our peace—<u>Judges 6:24.</u>

YAHUAH-Nissi—God is my banner—<u>Exodus 17:15.</u>

YAHUAH-Ropheka—God our healer—<u>Exodus 15:26</u>.

YAHUAH-Zidkenu—God our righteousness—Jeremiah 23:6.

YAHUAH-Shammah—God is present—<u>Ezekiel 48:35.</u>

YAHUAH-Mekaddishkem—God who sanctifies—<u>Exodus 31:13.</u>

Philippians 2:9-11 (NIV)*

⁹ Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of owtaw every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that owyay Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

1 John 4:9-11 (NLT2)

⁹ God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. ¹⁰ This is **real** love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. 11 Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other.
