

A destination to feel, enjoy, share, taste and amuse





- Exploration of Roman heritage or sites that highlight the antiquity of this practice.





- Join the olive harvest and oil pressing process in autumn, tracing the journey from grove to bottle.

- Visit a gin or medronho distillery, learn the art of craft spirits, and savour a perfectly prepared serve.

- Step into prehistory with a visit to the Alentejo cromlechs, megalithic stone circles that whisper secrets of ancient civilizations.
- At night, look up: the Alentejo sky becomes a canvas. The region is home to the world's first "Dark Sky" reserve, offering unforgettable stargazing in complete serenity.






