

The Highway 36A Coalition is an organization comprising local governments, elected officials, private businesses, and individuals working together to responsibly develop a regional transportation infrastructure from the Brazosport area to Hempstead and beyond.

This initiative aims to improve evacuation routes, facilitate domestic and international trade, enhance economic opportunities, and provide more efficient mobility.

For almost 15 years, we have been working on an alternative route for Hwy 36 that will go around Rosenberg, tie into I-10, and then on to Hwy 290 to Hwy 6. The project is on TXDOT's plans, and the Environmental impact study is happening now.




settling in, we are excited to open our doors to lunch visitors throughout the month of September.


