

These rooms are available to all regardless of the student-athlete's physical abilities or socioeconomic status.

8 to 80 Zones

8 to 80 Zones are a collaboration between Steve Young (#8) and Jerry Rice (#80), which provide youth living in underserved communities the skills to pursue careers in technology, esports, gaming, and mass media.

2022 took our 8 to 80 Zones to a new elevated level. We partnered with META and opened our first 8 to 80 META Creators Zone. These spaces not only allow for artistic expression but also afford our students the opportunity to gain training from developers on industry-leading equipment and software in the areas of VR, coding, television, broadcasting, voice recording, graphic design, and game development.

Forever Young Zones

Thousands of children continue to be impacted each year in Forever Young Zones throughout the United States and Ghana, Africa. These rooms are individually designed for specific community needs, every Zone carries the theme "Be Your Own Hero". Children need role models to pattern their lives after, but ultimately we want to equip and empower them with the ability and desire to go out and become their own heroes. Forever Young Zones are created to inspire young minds and motivate active lifestyles, whether they be playrooms in children's hospitals, athletic facilities, or technology spaces in youth community centers.




Sophie's Place

Sophie's Place was established in loving memory of singer, songwriter, and friend, Sophie Barton. These dedicated spaces are music therapy rooms built in children's hospitals that treat young people suffering from pain, chronic illness, and serious injury. They provide an integrative medical approach to prescriptive medicine—assisting physical therapy through body movement, alleviating pain, and supporting cognitive health by rewiring the brain synapses. While most people know music has an extraordinary power to bring comfort and peace to the soul, clinical studies have proven that music therapy offers an evidence-based, integrative medical approach in treating young hospital patients. Forever Young Foundation is proud to announce the ribbon cutting on our newest Sophie's Place at C.S. Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor Michigan. Music Changes Everything!

Engage Now Africa

Wellness

Forever Young Foundation has an abiding belief that children and young adults deserve access to programs and resources that help them achieve physical, social, and emotional wellness. Our Wellness initiative is designed to bring together, amplify, and improve the accessibility of these specialized resources for young people and their families.

Nonprofit Institute

Forever Young Foundation partners with the Arbinger Institute, a leader in management training and team building, to provide a year-long training for nonprofit professionals. With a mission to inspire excellence in leaders and to help build sustainable, efficient nonprofit organizations, this forum instructs participants in how to develop, implement, and update a one-year operating plan and a three-year long-range strategic business plan. Participants discover how to hold themselves accountable to their contributors while keeping board members, staff, and volunteers focused on achieving results. Through underwriting from Forever Young Foundation, private donors, and corporations, this training is offered at minimal cost to leaders seeking to ensure the sustainability of their organizations for generations to come.

Since its inception in 2010, over a thousand nonprofit leaders have participated in the Institute. In 2022, we trained 24 organizations and over 50 executives and board members. We also held a two-day Forever Young Family of Charities conference in Park City, Utah, which brought FYF associated organizations together in a setting where we could share best practices, resources, and challenges.
