Why do families continue to choose Westfield Friends School? A recent parent email provides a good answer. "Dear Teacher Margaret. . . As a parent, it feels great to witness [my daughter] burst out of school with ideas and excitement about what transpired during her school day. . . I commend you and your teachers for keeping the schedule packed with interesting events, trips, and topics. I also appreciate that her experience seems free of screens, lots of time outside, and lots of time for reading."

At Westfield, we choose to focus on joy, learning in a nurturing community, collaboration, creating freely and fearlessly, and sending children out to lead lives of conscience and consequence. If you are an alum, you know how this Friends school shaped who you are. With your invaluable support, we choose to serve as a beacon of resilience, Light, and belonging in this time of unease and discord. All of you help us to foster the Quaker belief in "Continuing Revelation" – a communal discernment process uniting our past and present with our faith in the future. ¹

Our Annual Report celebrates a number of milestones and successes. With your incredible generosity and support, we joyfully exceeded our Annual Fund goal of \$200,000 by \$182,065. Westfield Meeting provided important leadership by increasing its annual gift to the school by 25%. We welcomed 96 new donors, and 90 of our sustaining donors increased their contributions. We worked with a consultant this past year who was astonished to learn how many parents and grandparents of alumni continue to support Westfield, long after their children have graduated. I am not surprised; parents know what this school did to shape the wonderful adults their children have become.

This year, we have ambitious goals that will significantly advance our mission: raise an additional \$200,000 for the Fund for Westfield, successfully meet the \$250,000 Strategic Fund Matching Challenge, and grow the William Probsting Scholarship Fund by \$50,000. The best gift you can give us is to recommend Westfield to a family. Our challenging enrollment goal for the 2026-2027 school year is to have 170 students fill our halls.

The best part of my day is greeting and listening to children. The second best part of the day is talking with you about what this school means to you and your family. Thank you so much for sharing your stories with us.






