Wondering what Congress has been up to? GovTrack.us simplifies the lawmaking process and helps you understand what your lawmakers are doing. In the hands-on workshop, we'll explore GovTrack.us and its main features: identifying your reps, seeing how they vote, and learning about bills. We'll also walk through the sigh-up process for a free account so you can set up email alerts on legislative activity you care about.
