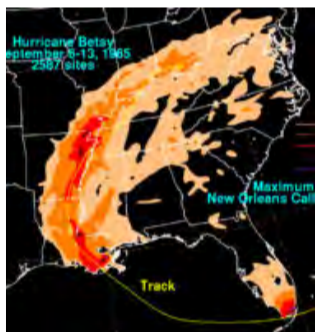

During rush hour this morning a devastating terrorist attack occurred in stations across London. To procure maximum damage and chaos, the attacker placed bombs under central underground train services and Heathrow Airport. London Fire Brigade were first to answer the cry for help, safely evacuating passengers shocked by their work journey gone wrong. The Offices of United Nations reported that explosions had detonated on the Elizabethan line in Central London. Bond street station was said to be the worst affected, however later the same day, more incendiary devices have detonated all along underground lines in London, as well as one being discovered by a member of the public to have been unexploded. Tot-

tenham Court Road, Paddington Station and Liverpool Street where the other stations affected. This device was removed by a professional and taken to a secure facility. In an unexpected twist, this attacker has gone even further, planting one underneath Heathrow Airport Terminal 3. All flights in and out have been grounded and safety checks are being carried out under all stations. The affect this has on transport services all over the UK is tremendous. With all flights grounded, no trains currently running due to this attack on top of strikes, it seems our nation has come to a standstill in shock of these actions. Emergency services were quick to be on the scene, helping shocked passengers out of the station and evacuating all workers immediately. Unfortu-



nately, many were severely injured by this event and hospitals near have been overrun with patients. Police have condemned this attack as pre-meditated and was made to cause maximum damage. No one has claimed responsibility for this tragic event yet, but the metropoli-

tan police are working with our national intelligence services to find the perpetrator. This attack is expected to come out in the next few days as a claimed attack and the authorities are actively searching for the per-

son responsible. It is unknown how and when the actions were carried out, the bomb could have been under the trains for days even weeks before it eventually detonated.

Parents will have to sign a waiver. However recently Ascot Races Children's Day has sparked public backlash with parents and from local schools expressing their concern that this will encourage un-

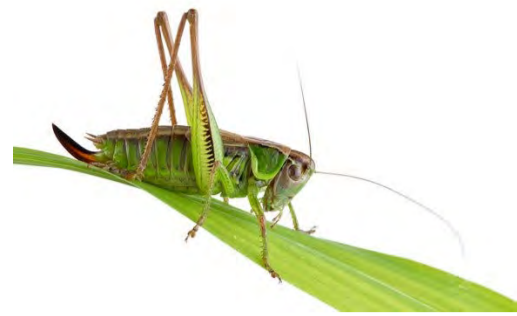

Government pushes Tiktok ban

It has been confirmed by Downing Street that the MPs have decided to ban Tiktok by August 2022 from the UK. Followed by an investigation performed by the ICO. Young people have started gathering in front of Parliament square to protest this law that will limit their freedom online by participating in banned Tiktok dances. Nadine Dorries, the secretary of State for Media announced: "The UK is going further to combat this damaging app and protect the lives and minds of young people. We are leading the charge and banning the app that spreads disinformation and we are protecting the data of our citizens". In Response Tiktok have replied in an official media statement: "We are committed to continuously enhancing our safety features as a testament to our ongoing commitment to our users in the UK. "We will work with the UK government to filter and moderate content." The reasoning behind this controversial plan is that Tiktok, the popular, Chinese social media platform previously known as Musical.ly has been suspected to have collected data and information on young, vulnerable children, under the ages of 13. It was also exposed that 1 in every 10 young people using Tiktok have been victims to inappropriate messages sent by adult sexual predators online, which have consequently led to men-

tal health issues amongst Tiktok users. However, the UK is not the first country to ban Tiktok, other countries have too, like India, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, Indonesia as well as many other countries which have clearly identified the serious issues in this platform that while may seem small to young people is endemic and if not rectified will continue to not only make young people victims to Sexual predators online causing problems with body image, anxiety as well as depression according to the NHS. The UK government plan to control and limit negative impact on young social media viewers on other social media platforms by having the ability to control the activity. The Benefits of the Government implementing this policy is that it will allow young people to invest their time in more productive outlets as supposed to scrolling on Tiktok for hours on end. Will this law protect or limit freedom for people



Say goodbye to time with your kids

Sally Graham talked about extending school days to 5pm and people are "angry" teachers and students threatened to go on strike against this new law and teachers' unions have come out condemning the shift in school days despite being told they will get double pay for these longer hours. Sally Graham, the head of the department of education, said that more time at school would reduce knife crime rates because students would

have "less time to do what they want". This law applies for every child between 5-18 years old meaning that children will have less time with their parents, and more time stressed about school. After school clubs will also be moved back so that they end at 7pm. However, as Daniel Hudwn – a Y8 student said" I would be over stressed", another Y8 student said" It would make me feel tired all the time". Do we seriously believe that extending the school day will increase our children's work ethic? Don't you think that this will cause more children to slack off? This New law would go into progress on the 1st of September. From the 1st of September teachers are also expected to get double the pay due to longer working hours late into the evening, however teachers have expressed their disappointment by saying this like" I have to do their work at some point", being at school so late would mean that they don't have as much time to do marking or other tasks that come along with being a teacher. Levin Sheri, who was voted into power, in the

Department of education, in September 2021, is who to blame for this new law. The School Day Bill Amendment 14 has been voted in favour for 488 to 162. It will be mandatory for all schools including private schools and grammar schools. The reasoning behind this is to help children catch up after the global outbreak of COVID-19. There are some good points though with parents getting to work longer house and not needing to pay for childcare after school, but this could lead to a decrease and loss of jobs in childcare and it is yet to be announced how the department of education will tackle this. The changes to the school curriculum will cost around £70 million which Sally Graham said is a "reasonable price" and she recons that by Christmas schools will be in profit from this big change, this does however lead us to believe that the reason behind changing school days could be due to a want for more money.

Terror in London



-pertrators and tensions are high in the London area. The last major railway terrorist attack in London was the 15 September 2017 and was called the Parsons Green tube station. The blast, at Parsons Green station on a District Line train from Wimbledon, was treated as terrorism. The So-called Islamic State said it carried out the attack, which Prime Minister Theresa May condemned as "cowardly". A hunt was under way for the person who placed the device and the area around the station had been evacuated. Specialist officers there secured the remains of the improvised device and ensured it is stable. One witness said, "In my mind I was praying, I probably thought for a second, 'That's it, my life is over.' Another said "There was a fireball above my head" The bomb at Parsons Green was an improvised explosive device (IED) and, like those on 21 July, it didn't work as planned. The device's initiator appears to have worked - but the main charge did not detonate. This could be because the bomb-maker had got the recipe wrong. In the case of the 21 July attacks, the attackers tried to create TATP, an explosive compound made from hydrogen peroxide, commonly sold as hair bleach, and other chemicals. - By Oliver Goodall

Disruption was reported, travellers have reported that they have seen smoke coming from the bond street station exit and people have been seen fleeing the scene. Now it is reported that Metropolitan police and the London fire brigade are at attendance on the scene. Further reports have shown that an explosion may have occurred, and it is also reported that several people have been severely injured in the explosion and have been carried from the scene, their state now is unknown. Police are now in league armed forces and bomb disposal units are now found at bond street, Paddingt

on and Tottenham court road underground station. This is after reports of suspicions devices being spotted at these locations, the blast radius area has been evacuated to safety, and local police forces have been put on high alert, and now looks like a terrorist attack is likely An example of a similar attack includes the Sept. 15 terrorist bombing in a crowded London subway station – which injured at least 30 passengers but caused no deaths. No terrorist group has yet been identified as the per

Celebration Caribbean Cruises faced a massive crisis after they lost contact their ultra-modern cruise ship, the Eternity of the Sea. Where and when the Hurricane was formed is not known, but experts state that after moving through the Caribbean, it will make landfall in South America. Eventually, contact was re-established with the passengers, who managed to contact friends and family. Although the cruise company are working on fixing the radars, the extent of the damage is not currently known. However, no loss of life has been reported. -By Gethin Kirkham

Eye-witnesses have reported smoke coming from the bond street exit to the station, people were seen running away from the scene. The smoke is believed to be caused by a mechanical failure.

Crews evacuated 59 people from the tube train via the tunnel. 4 people were treated at the scene due to shortness of breath by London ambulance service crews. The fire brigade was called at 0554 and the incident was over at 07:18. 4 fire engines and around 25 firefighters from Soho Paddington and Kensington fire stations attended the scene. BOMB AT BOND STREET!



From early hours this morning, there have been reports of disruptions at Bond Street Underground station; this has resulted in many delays across the Elizabeth Line.

Transport for London has advised travellers to seek an alternative route, and later it was confirmed by them and London Underground that an incident has occurred on the Elizabeth Line platform at Bond Street station and are urging people to avoid the area.

Media was warned and asked to not send reporters and act with caution.

A few hours after the warning was released, eyewitnesses have re-

ported large clouds of smoke coming from the Bond Street exit to the station, with people running away from the scene. At eleven AM, a swarm of The London Fire Brigades' services and Metropolitan Police arrived at Bond Street Station. Many reports have been received from the public stating a massive explosion has taken place and dozens of injured civilians have been seen carried from the scene. As of now, the surrounding streets have been closed by The Police.

Armed response units and bomb disposal teams are confirmed to be present at Bond Street, Paddington and Tottenham Court Road Underground stations following reports of

devices at these locations. The immediate area has been evacuated. 4 Major terror attacks have happened across London's transport network, with bombs exploding at Bond Street, Paddington, Tottenham Court Road, and Liverpool Street. A 5th bomb was found by the public at Heathrow Terminal 3 underground station. All flights from Heathrow airport are grounded and the entirety of central London is closed off cutting access through the city. Immense loss of life has occurred across the Elizabeth line leaving families distraught. No one has stepped forward to gain responsibility but the whole country is working tirelessly to find the culprit of this vicious attack. From what we understand from so far the device at Bond Street was the first one to explode with paramedics and fire department there within minutes! - Francesca



Chaos in the Caribbean!

The Celebration cruises ship the eternity of the seas was recently caught up in a potentially fatal hurricane in the Caribbean ocean. Hurricane Betsy first began on Wednesday as a mere tropical depression, posing only a slight risk to container ships in the area.

However, Betsy then grew at a rapid pace in less than 24 hours to a vast category 1 hurricane on a course for US Islands in the area, capable of unleashing 75MPH winds and causing major damage and destruction. Celebration Cruises first saw no risk when we spoke to them regarding

the Hurricane, stating that tropical storms such as Betsy were natural occurrences, and they could not be held liable for any deaths that may happen as a result.

The ship, currently carrying 5492 passengers and 1500 crew, has since diverted course to the southern coast to avoid any damage. But after we first spoke to them a dinghy, believed to be from the Eternity, was recently spotted off the coast of the tropical island of St. Lucia. It is currently unknown if there were any passengers on board. The CDEMA (Caribbean Disaster Emergency Management Agency) has

also announced that debris, most likely from the luxury liner, has been sighted in large quantities around the ships course. Celebration cruises have not yet confirmed that the dinghy is theirs, or if it has any passengers on board but there is a high likelihood that this event has resulted in loss of life. All contact from the ship has been lost since the storm hit, leaving families of the passengers distraught and fearing for their lives.

Celebration have also not confirmed whether the ship is still sailing after the impact. The question of how the storm formed in the first



place has also been raised, with many, including Celebration, still uncertain. Some are saying that it may be an example of extreme weather caused by increased carbon emissions and that we may see many events like this in the future. The ship originally cost over \$1 billion to construct for Celebration and caters to high net worth individuals. It is estimated that Celebration have already suffered an immense financial loss, and their statement of zero liability may be brought into question in the future.

School Extension?



MPS have just voted to fully ratify a new bill but forward by the education secretary Nadim Zarhri that plans to extend the length of school days for all children in the UK. The act applies to all schools, including private and grammar and passed through the house of commons with a 488 to 162 majority. The bill, aimed at helping pupils recover from the closure of schools during the COVID-19 pandemic, will extend the length of the school day to 5pm, with extracurricular clubs continuing until 7. It is meant to somehow have a positive effect on students' mental health as it provides them with more structure for learning. This

new bill is also expected to raise productivity for GCSE and A Level exams. Many students have already voiced their concern for the new law, saying that the current workload is already far too stressful and that children's mental health will take a massive fall. The £70,000,000 funding for this new act was obtained via slashing funding for the NHS, Police, and Fire Departments. struggling to cope with an

British formula 1 driver Lewis Hamilton has announced his retirement via social media this morning. The Mercedes driver (who was awarded a knighthood from then queen last year) released a statement saying “Thankyou everyone for your unbelievable support over the years. It is

time for me to bow out of the sport”. Lewis Hamilton will be retiring at the end of the season meaning Abu Dhabi will be his last race. In a statement by a representative from his media team “Lewis has not recovered mentally from last season” and “has had too many issues with the car this season”. Once he has retired, he will be moving to Brazil with his

family.

Throughout his 15-year formula 1 career Hamilton won a joint record 7 championship titles. In his 297 races, he also holds the record for the most race wins (103) and finished on the podium 184 times.

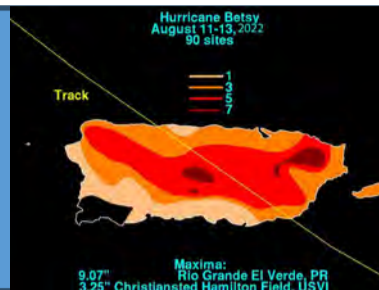

Bomb On Bond Street



What was a minor caution on the new Elizabeth line, has now resulted in several fatally wounded civilians after a train carriage outside of Bond Street station had exploded. Officials reported armed response units and bomb disposal confirmed to be present at Bond Street, Paddington and Tottenham Court Road. The police then made it their top priority to close the surrounding streets. A 5th device was found in Heathrow Terminal 3. Thankfully bomb disposal captured it before it could be detonated.

They are alerting family and friends that if they get in contact with any of the passengers then they should alert the Celebration Caribbean cruises immediately in any way they can.

Just recently, a dinghy was sighted along with floating debris by the CDEMA (The Caribbean Disaster Emergency Management Agency)

off the coast of the Caribbean island 'St Lucia', They don't know if the passengers are onboard.

If there are any survivors, they have minimal food left. There is no communication with the cruise ship and the Celebration Caribbean Cruises team don't know when communications will be back on. 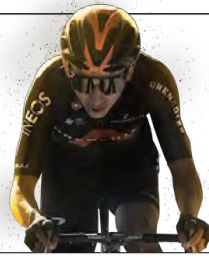

There are reports of disruptions at Bond Street Underground station causing delays to travel. Travellers are being advised to find an alternative route. TfL & London Underground have confirmed that an incident has occurred on the Elizabeth Line platform at Bond Street station and are urging people to avoid the area. Media are asked to not send reporters and act with caution. Eyewitnesses have reported smoke coming from the Bond Street exit to the station and people running away from the scene. The Elizabeth line goes through places such as, London Pad-



dington Rail Station, Slough Rail Station, Maidenhead Rail Station, Brentwood Rail Station, London Liverpool Street Rail Station. There have been reported access issues at Seven Kings Rail Station, Manor Park Rail Station, Forest Gate Rail Station, Maryland Rail Station, Farringdon. As of launch, it is shuttling up to 1,500 passengers into Central London every 5 minutes. That is up to 18,000 people per hour, both ways. You can expect 12 trains per hour at stations along the line. This works out to one every five minutes. Recent reports show, the London Fire Brigade and Metropolitan Police attend Bond Street station. Further reports have been received from members of public who state that an explosion has taken place and several severely injured people have been seen being carried from the scene. The Police have closed the surrounding streets. Armed response units and bomb disposal teams are confirmed to be present at Bond Street, Paddington and Tottenham Court Road Underground stations following reports of devices at these locations. The immediate area has been evacuated. An official statement has been released from the UK mission to the UN. It was expected that the attack was premeditated and intended to cause maximum damage and many disruptions. This occurred at Heathrow terminal 3 underground and many areas around central London have been closed including Paddington, Liverpool street, Tottenham court road and Bond street. No one has claimed responsibility and all flights have been grounded to and from Heathrow. It is suspected that this could be potential terrorism.

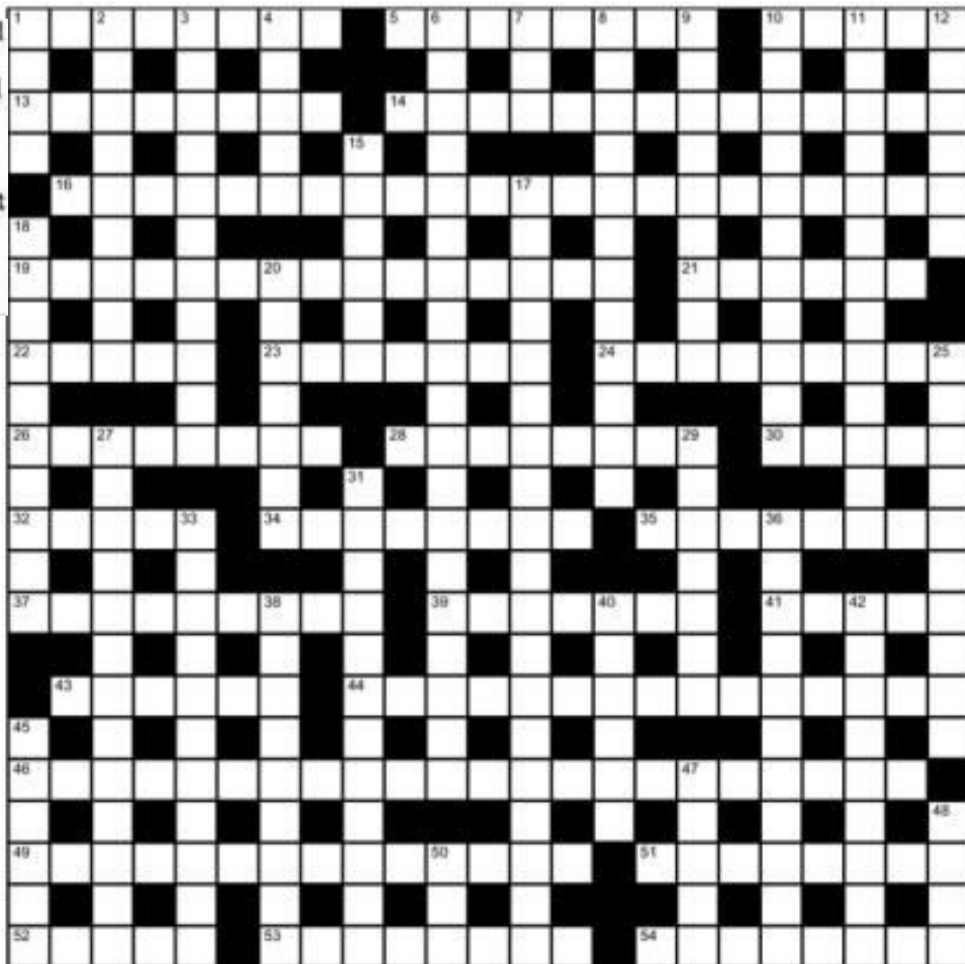

London under attack



Reports are coming through of disruptions at Bond Street Underground station causing delays to travel. Travellers are being instructed to find an alternative route into London. TFL & London Underground have released to the press that an incident has occurred on the Elizabeth Line platform at Bond Street station and now people are being pushed people to avoid

the area. They have asked Media not to send reporters and treat the incident with concern. There have been Reports of Eye-witness sighting smoke from the bond street exit and people fleeing from the sight.

We have received further reports from the public stating an explosion has taken place causing several in-

juries with people being carried from the scene. The police have closed the surrounding streets and the London Fire Brigade and Metropolitan Police have been sighted.

It has been confirmed that armed response units and bomb disposal teams are present at Bond Street, Pad-

dington and Tottenham court Road Underground following reports of bombs at these locations where everyone has been evacuated.

It has been made clear by the United Nations that the explosion breakout was the result of a fire which was set alight in Bond Street. Further explosions were then reported at three other stations. A fifth device was discovered by a member of the public in Heathrow, Terminal 3 at the underground station which was removed before it could detonate. Central London is now closed and all flights have been cancelled. A spokes person from the home office reported that the attacks

were premeditated and designed to cause massive destruction and loss of lives in the heart of London. No one has confessed to this but the police are working alongside the security services to ensure the criminals are put to justice.

Hurricane Betsy

Academic Anarchy

All schools in England will be extended if new government plans go ahead. Ministers have decided the school day will now last until 5pm from Monday to Friday. This is believed to benefit students as they will now have extra time to study and catch up from the pandemic. It should also benefit the wider community, as adults can work longer and emergency services will be needed less, resulting in a

better economy. The extended school days should empower students' mental health and allow for teachers to be able to support them more. Teachers will also be paid double their current salaries, but holidays will remain the same and GCSE students may have an option to take an extra GCSE. After school enforced clubs will be run from 5pm until 7pm. Members in House of

Commons voted by a 488 to 162 majority in favour of the proposal for the School Day Bill Amendment 14. This will officially extend the School Day until 5pm and be mandatory for all schools including private schools, grammar schools and academies with no exceptions. As the news spreads, many are expressing their concerns for how this will affect young people, working families, transport etc.

"Safety will be the first Priority"

A hurricane caught one of the most expensive cruise ships off guard in the early hours of Thursday morning. Today Trudi Begg was speaking on behalf of the luxury cruise company Celebration Cruises, and she highlighted the overwhelming amount of damage done to the ship. The ship is off all radars, and authorities have issued search and rescue to attempt to find the missing cruise ship. According to Begg, the hurricane was "unexpected" and how it is "impossible to monitor such a storm." 5,498 passengers and 1,500 crew members were on the cruise at the time, and about 7,000 are now missing, which is causing mas-

sive concern for all the family and friends of the missing people. From now on, Celebration Cruises are making "Safety the first priority," as they make weather scans a top priority. But to give the family some hope there has been a dingy sighted of the coast of 'St Lucia' but it is not known if anyone is onboard. There is no radar, and debris has been found. Until recently, there wasn't a sound from anyone on the ship, but now passengers have contacted family members through WhatsApp and Facetime. There are still no radar signals, but there is hope for the lives of these innocent people
