CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE



The Score is Always 0-0: Building the Club Where the World Comes to Play

When I first moved to the Netherlands, I went searching for a football club where I could play, contribute, and be part of a community. I visited several clubs around Amsterdam but all the doors were closed.

Only one club said: "Come on in. Be part of our community. Join a team, become a trainer, help us run the place." They didn't care where I was from or how long I was planning to stay. They only cared that I loved the game and wanted to help build something great. That club was **NFC**.

Now, thanks to the incredible support of our community, the dedication of our Board, and the tireless efforts of our coaches, trainers, and volunteers, I can confidently report that NFC is in fantastic shape.

Look at what we have achieved together just this season:

- **Growth: We have grown to nearly 700 active members.**
- **On-Pitch Success:** Dozens of our teams have made massive developmental strides, with several climbing the ranks to compete at the prestigious **Hoofdklasse** and **Divisie levels**.
- **Youth Pathway:** We have cultivated a brilliant core group of youth assistant trainers who are not only coaching our youngest players but forging vital generational bonds across age groups.
- **Community Spirit:** Our calendar has been packed with vibrant club events, tournaments, Girls' Days, cultural feasts, and social gatherings.
- **Facilities:** We are actively collaborating with the **Gemeente Amstelveen** to secure a second artificial pitch and completely revitalize our street football court.

Of course, we cannot afford to dwell on yesterday's victories. As I remind our players and coaches: **the score is always 0-0**. We must always anticipate what's next, innovate, and have the courage to break the mold. In short, **doe niet normaal!**

Because of our wonderfully diverse international population, every single season at NFC is a brand-new puzzle. Sometimes 10-20% of our members leave the country each year, while a massive wave of new families arrives every autumn. Many of our parents work demanding, high-intensity jobs and often have very little prior experience with the unique culture of Dutch football clubs.

Managing this level of constant transition is an extraordinary challenge. That is why it is absolutely critical that we build a crystal-clear club culture supported by a resilient organization. No matter who arrives or who departs, the club's values and core operations must stand firm. It is our "style of play"—a foundational set of principles and tactics that guide the team through any storm.



So, what is NFC's club culture?

It begins with our identity. We are an open, inclusive **home for all nationalities**, boys and girls, youth and seniors, **beginners and seasoned** players alike. We are a community of action—we don't complain; we take matters into our own hands. We believe that with clear vision and effort, great things happen. We have the courage to experiment, to fail fast, to learn, and to adapt. And most importantly, we live by a "**Club-First**" mentality in every decision we make.

To keep this beautiful machine humming along, we need to evolve. There are only so many hours in a day, and the operational demands on our volunteer leaders are immense. To scale, we have two choices: we can either stop doing the things that make our club special (the easy choice, but not the one that fulfills our mission), or we can learn to do things better, smarter, and faster.

We choose to do things better. And to do that, we need you.

A Call to Action: Your Turn to Step Up

First, we need your **hands on the pitch**. We are asking every parent and member to consider volunteering. Raise your hand to coach, to referee, to assist at events, or to manage a team. You do not need to be an expert—we have the materials, the structured curriculum, and the experienced mentors ready to support you. For those who want to help steer the ship at a strategic level, please reach out to me directly about our open Board seats. Let's discuss how your professional skills can shape our future.

Second, we are embracing the future. NFC is actively moving away from exhausting manual work by leveraging modern systems, automation, and AI tools. Over the summer, we will be overhauling our website, registration pipelines, and backend systems to dramatically simplify, streamline, and speed up our operations.

Finally, we will continue to move at speed. In leadership, we view decisions through two lenses: "one-way doors" and "two-way doors." If a decision is crucial and difficult to undo, we will take our time. But 90% of our choices are two-way doors—they can easily be fixed later if they don't work out. We will not let the fear of making a mistake paralyze our progress. Those quick failures are often our greatest teachers.

There is no time to waste. We have a clear mission, an incredible community, and the momentum of a century of history behind us. So let's keep building the club **where the world comes to play**.

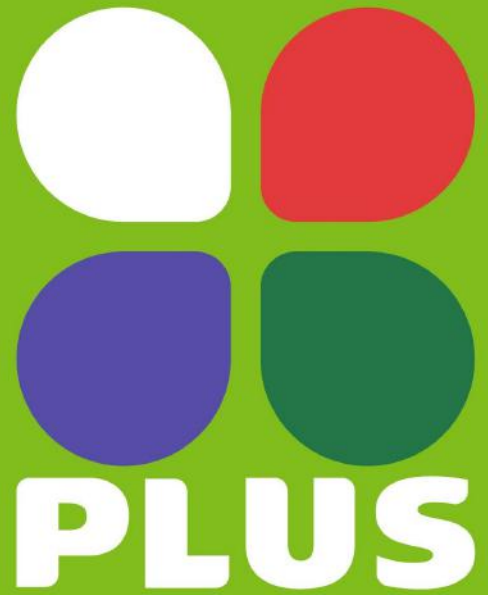

RISE OF GIRLS FOOTBALL AT NFC



Three years ago, a critical debate took place in the NFC Boardroom: Should we launch a dedicated girls' football program, and if so, how do we make it sustainable? After much deliberation, we decided to look forward, take action, and never look back. Thanks to the vision of our former treasurer, **Dean Rock**, who helped establish our first girls' team in years, NFC made a definitive, long-term commitment to championing female football.

From that single, fateful decision, our program has blossomed. Today, we proudly field competitive and enthusiastic squads across multiple age groups, including our **MO15, MO10, MO9**, and even our youngest stars in the **MO8!** And we are just getting started.



The Blueprint for Growth: NFC Girls Get It Done Tournament and NFC Girls' Day

NFC has been working hard behind the scenes to recruit more girls into our program. We have **built a dedicated group of assistant female trainers** to guide and inspire our youngest players. The girls have gone to camps, played in school, and tested themselves in various matches against other girls and also boy teams. It was time to put our girls to the test against other clubs.

So on March 8th, NFC hosted its first ever "Girls Get It Done" Tournament. We had **18 teams from 12 clubs** come to NFC to play in **MO9, 10, 11, and 12** age groups. The teams battled it out 6v6 on quarter pitches so there were plenty of amazing plays, assists, and goals!



And we had **a special guest from Ajax - the O16 trainer Britt van de Wiel** - who came to share her inspirational story and experiences with the girls and cheer them on as they competed!

The tournament put NFC on the map for girls football. A newly formed MO9 team, led by **Trine Fabre and Akash Maharaj**, won their first match against a strong opponent. And our MO10 team took **2nd place** in the MO10 division - and even could have taken 1st if not for an unlucky goal - thanks to the great coaching of **Luisa Pinto and Fernao Silveira**. We even had Ajax O16 trainer Britt van de Wiel join us to observe the girls and share her experiences!



After the tournament, many teams came to our coaches and asked for friendlies and wanted to know when we could play again. They realized for the first time that **NFC was not just an 'international club' but a place for girls who wanted to learn and love the beautiful game.** And a club that was willing to invest and push their players - boys or girls - to develop and compete!

NFC GIRLS DAYS



In addition to the tournament, NFC hosted our signature "**NFC Girls' Day**" on **May 2nd**—an event designed for young players to sharpen their technical skills, play highly competitive mini-matches, and experience our unique club culture firsthand.

We welcomed **30 eager participants** from all around Amstelveen and Amsterdam. Over 40% of the attendees joined us from neighboring clubs such as RAP, Buitenveldert, and AFC, turning the day into a fantastic celebration of local community football.

The event was powered by a dedicated team of volunteers, including three of our fantastic youth assistant trainers (**Heely, Elise Sprague, and Alex Jr. Jr.**) alongside three senior coaches (**Alex, Luisa, and Fernao**).

The players were divided into three specific developmental groups:

- The MO8/9 and MO9/10 Groups: Focused intensely on the foundational pillars of our club: **Ball Mastery**, applying technical skills in real match scenarios (such as 1v1 duels and rondos), and diving into positional play and team formations.
- The MO11/12 Group: Stepped up the intensity with a heavy focus on **advanced tactics, collective passing combinations, and rapid, high-pressure decision-making**.

It was an intensive three-hour session, and every single player pushed her physical and mental boundaries. Of course, no great match day is complete without a proper post-game celebration. Afterward, the girls **headed into the canteen to enjoy a well-deserved reward** of pizza, lemonade, and ice cream!

WHERE WOMEN COME TO PLAY

Interview with the women's football team leader at NFC Losan Song.

We sat down with Losan Song, the driving force behind NFC's growing women's football initiative, to talk about how the team started, the



rapid growth of the group, and why more women are discovering the joy of football at NFC. What began as a small idea with just six women at a single training session in May 2025 has quickly developed into one of the **club's most exciting new projects**.



Led by Losan, originally from China, the women's football group was created to give women of **all ages** and experience levels the opportunity to play football in a welcoming and supportive environment. With the support of **NFC's senior board**, the group has already grown to more than 15 members and continues to attract new players every month. What makes the team unique is that most members are complete beginners, many of whom had **never stepped onto a football pitch before** joining. The atmosphere within the group has become one of the team's greatest strengths. Training sessions are filled with positivity,

encouragement, and laughter, helping players feel comfortable while learning the basics of the game. Every week brings visible progress, with players gaining confidence, improving their skills, and building friendships both on and off the pitch.



The group includes women ranging from their 20s to 40s and remains **open to anyone** interested in trying football for the first time. Rather than focusing only on competition, the initiative aims to introduce more women to the sport and create a place where everyone feels **welcome**, regardless of experience or ability. As Losan says: **"You do not need experience. You just need the courage to start."**

Women's football at NFC is growing step by step, creating a strong foundation for the future and inspiring more girls and women to become part of the club's football community.

Of course, football also means saying **goodbye** sometimes. Over the past period, some familiar faces and long-standing members have left the Netherlands or moved abroad, closing important chapters within the club. We are grateful for their contribution to NFC and wish them all the best in their new journeys.

Daniel Gaulard:

When I was a young boy, I joined NFC at **just eight years old**. Back then, NFC was the club to play for. The impressive dark-blue shirt, the enormous complex, the Saturday buzz, the energy, the laughter – it was addictive. I spent entire Saturdays at the club, **never wanting to go home**.

I moved through the youth teams – the E, D and C squads – before taking a break for a few years. When I returned, I was given the chance to try out for the **selection teams**. The first team was a step too far, and the second team was tough, not quite the place where I felt at home. But at 22, I made one of the best decisions of my life: **joining NFC 3**.

That's where I met a young player named **Arnaud de Flart**. We clicked instantly. To this day, we're still teammates and close friends, now playing together in 45+.

After a year with NFC 3, I was given the **captain's armband** – and I wore it proudly until last year, when an injury finally forced me to take it off. Over these **22 years**, the entire team changed. I went from being the youngest player to one of the oldest. Night-time hamstring cramps, slower recovery, and being outrun by younger opponents became part of the deal. But so did maturity, experience, and guiding the younger guys. I joined the board, became chairman, and built friendships that will last a lifetime.

Today, I'm still **deeply involved** with NFC 4 – a team I'm **incredibly proud** of a group of friends, teammates, and family. We're one group with one shared goal: to win, to play well, and to enjoy the third half just as much. Weekends in Texel, Grattum, Barcelona... this team has become my family, my inner circle, the people I'm proud to stand beside.

My story continues, because NFC is — and always will be — my second home.

OUR ROAD TO 2030

Actions Speak Louder Than Words

Members, parents, and friends of NFC— some of you may know this phrase. It's more than just a saying. It's a way of life. It's a promise. It's a blueprint for how we succeed as a club.

Yes, NFC has come a long way. But to get us to our next evolution, to move from surviving to thriving, we must not stand still. So over the next 5 years, **I want us to focus on 4 key things:**

1. Growing Our Membership

Our goal is **800+ members**. Scale is the engine that drives everything in our club. More members means every player can find the right team for them, be it Selection, Development, or Recreation. Whether you're here to compete at the highest level or play for the pure joy of the game, **NFC is here for you**. Scale will also help us generate sufficient resources to invest in good facilities, infrastructure, and staff to ensure you have a great experience.

2. Elevating Our Training Quality

We owe our players more than just a shirt and a whistle. We are pushing for the infrastructure we deserve: two new artificial fields and a dedicated training court. More importantly, we will create unified Youth and Senior policies and training curriculum. Every age group should have a dedicated adult trainer, supported by training assistants, ensuring every player—from our youth to our seniors—receives a high-quality football education. And we will look to launch a **First Team within the seniors** to bring NFC in line with other Dutch clubs and provide a pathway for our Youth.

3. Professionalizing Our Operations

A club is only as strong as its leadership. We are filling key board positions to share the load. Where we cannot find volunteers for vital roles like the canteen, we will hire professional staff to ensure a good experience. By investing in automation for our back-office, we will ensure our volunteers spend less time on spreadsheets and more time on the pitch.

4. Strengthening Our Partnerships

We are deepening our ties with the Gemeente and Amstelveen Sport. We want to solve real "member pain points"—like providing an NFC Shuttle to help busy families. We will also reconnect with our 2,700 alumni worldwide to rebuild a community that provides the mentorship and support we need to thrive.

The Path Ahead

We have already started delivering on our campaign promises. We are in talks with the Gemeente for a new artificial pitch. We have launched our selection process for next season. And we're working on finalizing our Board. Over the summer we will also push to recruit more trainers, deploy more automations in our operations, and prepare for the season kick-off in August.

A strong NFC benefits everyone. The question isn't if we can get there, but how fast we can move together. **So let's start building - together.**
