## Valentine's Day Craft **MACRAME HEART**

Celebrate Valentine's Day by crafting a beautiful macramé heart with your little ones! A fun, hands-on project to create a heartfelt decoration or gift together.

#### YOU WILL NEED:

- · Heart shape frame (metal or wood, available from Hobbycraft)
- · Macrame string, single twist type that unravels - in any colour & thickness
- · Measuring tape
- Sharp scissors
- · Comb or pet brush



- it on top of the frame
- 2. Fold the loop behind the frame, then pull the two strands through the loop.
- 3. Pull. You have made the Lark's Head Knot.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 with as many strings as you need to cover the frame

- 5. Brush the strings
- 1. Cut a piece of string 20 cm 6. Trim the fringe (adults only!) long, fold it in half and place To make it easier, use a piece of card 3-4cm high.
  - 7. Brush and trim again if necessary.
  - 8. Take a long piece of string and tie a Lark's Head Knot in the middle of the heart. Tie a simple knot to create a loop to hang the heart.

**NOTE:** the fringe might flop down with time, especially if it's longer than 3 or 4cm. You can simply brush it to tidy up or you can use spray starch to stiffen it.

You'll be able to pick up the finished item a week later from the studio once it's been to the kiln. ## EMPOWERED BIRTH AFTER A CHALLENGING JOURNEY

#### Anna and Dalmain's Story

by Nicole, Doula at Your Birth Story



Bringing a baby into the world is always a profound journey, and for Anna and Dalmain, that journey was extraordinary. After fertility challenges, IVF, and a high-risk pregnancy with identical triplets (with odds that vary from one in 60,000 to one in 200 million pregnancies) complicated by Twin-to-Twin Transfusion Syndrome (TTTS), they welcomed their babies via planned cesarean. I had the privilege of supporting them as their Doula, a truly once in a lifetime opportunity for any doula and their story shows the power of informed choice and compassionate care.

Nicole: What made you decide to have a doula?

Anna: Honestly, I hadn't even heard of doulas until I was researching ways to make our birth experience more positive. After everything we went through—IVF, the complications of TTTS, and the uncertainty of a high-risk pregnancy with triplets—I just felt like so much had been out of my control. I wanted to change that for the birth.

#### Nicole: How did you choose your Doula?

Anna: Our journey was so medical so I wanted to approach birth with a more personal feeling. So we were looking for someone who could focus on what we wanted to feel whilst also understanding the science and help us understand our choices so that was the main thing we looked for when searching Dalmain: You explained things in a way that made sense without being overwhelming. It wasn't about telling us what to do; it was about empowering us to decide for ourselves.

## Nicole: How did having a doula impact your planned cesarean?

Anna: It transformed the experience. It helped us

personalise the process—asking for skin-to-skin contact, delayed cord clamping, and even creating a calm atmosphere in the operating room. It made it feel like our birth, not just a medical procedure. **Dalmain**: We felt supported and prepared, not like we were just going through the motions.

## Nicole: What about postpartum, especially with three babies in the NICU?

Anna: It was invaluable. I remember sitting in the NICU, listening to other parents who felt lost or overwhelmed. I felt like I had this secret superpower because I knew the right questions to ask, whether it was about feeding, care plans, or bonding with the babies. That confidence came from our work together during pregnancy.

**Dalmain**: You also helped build a good relationship with the nurses and midwives, which made us feel like we were getting exceptional care.

#### Nicole: What advice would you give to parents considering a doula for a planned cesarean or who have experienced IVF?

Anna: Do it. Even if you think, "I'm having a cesarean; I don't need a doula," there's so much a doula can do to support you. It's about making the experience yours and feeling confident in your choices.

Dalmain: It's not just about the birth—it's about the whole experience. Having someone who's seen it all before is invaluable.

Anna and Dalmain's story shows that even after a challenging fertility and pregnancy journey or a planned cesarean, you can have an empowering and deeply personal birth. As a doula, I can help you feel confident, informed, and supported through every step of your birth story.

One of the joys of parenting is watching your little one grow and progress through different developmental stages. Among these milestones, introducing solid foods is a particularly exciting time for the whole family. It marks the beginning of your child joining the tradition of shared family meals. For many parents, it's a thrill to imagine their little one enjoying the same meals as they grow and the weaning process progresses.

As exciting as this stage can be, it's natural for parents to have questions or feel daunted, especially when introducing foods known to trigger reactions. These reactions fall under the umbrella term "food hypersensitivity." In this article, I will explore food hypersensitivity, its types, common triggers, symptoms, diagnosis, and common mistakes parents make. I'll also share tips for parents navigating this journey.

#### WHAT IS FOOD HYPERSENSITIVITY?

Food hypersensitivity refers to an abnormal reaction to food and can be classified into two main types:

- Food Allergy
- Food Intolerance

While the terms "food allergy" and "food intolerance" are often used interchangeably, they are distinct. A food allergy involves the immune system reacting to a particular food. These reactions can range from mild to severe. Food intolerance, on the other hand, occurs when the body struggles to digest certain foods and does not involve the immune system.

#### COMMON FOOD ALLERGIES

The most common food allergies include:

• Milk (cow's milk protein allergy)



Fish





Tree nuts

Wheat

Soya beans

Sesame

Emerging allergens, such as peas, are also becoming more common.

#### **COMMON FOOD INTOLERANCES**

- Lactose intolerance: Where the body cannot digest lactose sugar found in milk and dairy. This is the most prevalent form of food intolerance.
- Gluten: Found in wheat, rye, and barley
- Salicylates: Present in certain fruits, vegetables, herbs, and spices
- Monosodium Glutamate (MSG): Found in ripened fruits and cured meats
- Histamine: Found in cheese

Processed foods may also trigger intolerances, including additives like caffeine and sulphites, commonly found in drinks and preserved dried fruits.











#### IDENTIFYING FOOD HYPERSENSITIVITY

Recognising food hypersensitivity can be challenging as symptoms often overlap between allergies and intolerances. Here's a breakdown of common symptoms:

- Food Allergy Symptoms: Itchy skin, hives, tummy pain, diarrhoea, nausea or vomiting, dizziness, swelling of the lips, eyes, or face, wheezing, breathlessness, and sneezing.
- Food Intolerance Symptoms: Bloating, tummy pain, diarrhoea, and excessive gas.

A trained healthcare professional can distinguish between allergies and intolerances, ensuring your child receives the appropriate care.

#### DIAGNOSING FOOD HYPERSENSITIVITY

Diagnosis begins with a detailed history and physical examination by a healthcare professional. Depending on the findings, further tests may include:

- For Food Allergies: Skin-prick tests, blood tests, or a special elimination diet.
- For Food Intolerances: Breath tests (for lactose intolerance), blood tests, or an elimination diet.

Post-diagnosis, a multidisciplinary medical team may be required. This could include a paediatric dietitian, allergist, specialist nurse, or other experts to provide tailored support.

#### **AVOIDING COMMON PITFALLS**

Parents often make two key mistakes when dealing with suspected food hypersensitivity:

- Self-Diagnosis: It's natural to remove a food item you suspect is causing a reaction, but this may not always be in the child's best interest. A holistic, patient-centred approach is essential for accurate diagnosis and effective management.
- Relying on Home Test Kits: Allergy test kits can produce false positives or negatives, and interpreting results without professional guidance may harm the child. Trained professionals consider test results alongside medical history and observations for accurate conclusions.

Removing a suspected food allergen without proper diagnosis can deprive a child of essential nutrients. For example, misdiagnosing lactose intolerance as a milk allergy might lead to unnecessary dietary restrictions. In collaboration with a healthcare professional, parents can ensure their child receives all the nutrients needed for growth and development.

#### TREATMENT & MANAGEMENT

Treatment options depend on the type and severity of the hypersensitivity. For instance:

- Allergies: Cow's milk protein or egg allergies may require temporary elimination followed by reintroduction. Peanut allergies may benefit from oral immunotherapy, which can help desensitise children if they are eligible for this treatment.
- Intolerances: Lactose intolerance can be managed with lactose-free alternatives.

It's important to remember that treatment plans vary for each child and should be guided by a healthcare professional.

#### **SUPPORTING DIAGNOSIS & MANAGEMENT**

As a parent, you play a vital role in facilitating your child's diagnosis and management. Your observations and insights can greatly assist healthcare professionals in identifying triggers and crafting effective treatment plans.

To help parents navigate this journey, I've developed the C.L.E.A.R Framework:

- COMMUNICATION: Open, clear communication with healthcare professionals is critical for accurate diagnosis and effective management. As parents spend the most time with their children, their observations are invaluable.
- LOGICAL APPROACH: Be systematic in documenting and reporting your child's symptoms and reactions.
- **3. EVIDENCE:** Keep a detailed record of your child's symptoms, triggers, and dietary changes.
- ACCOUNTABILITY: Follow through on medical advice and ensure consistency in your approach.
- RESOLUTION: Work collaboratively with healthcare providers to find solutions that support your child's well-being.





## Meltdowns **Tantrums**

**HOW TO RECOGNISE AND HANDLE** YOUR CHILD'S MELTDOWNS

by Laura Dumbleton-Jones



Parenting is a rollercoaster ride filled with joy, frustration, and everything in between. One common challenge is dealing with meltdowns. This guide will help you understand the difference between tantrums and meltdowns with tips for calming both you and your child.

#### UNDERSTANDING MELTDOWNS vs TANTRUMS:

**Tantrums:** Tantrums are deliberate attempts by a child to get something they want or to avoid something they don't. They often involve crying or throwing themselves on the floor.

Meltdowns: Meltdowns are overwhelming sensory or emotional experiences that young children can't control. They might cry, scream, or lash out due to hunger, tiredness, frustration, or feeling unsafe.

The Key Difference: Meltdowns are involuntary reactions, while tantrums are attempts to control a situation. Recognising this can help you manage your expectations and choose the most helpful response.

#### **SPOTTING THE SIGNS:**

Meltdowns may seem sudden, and we often hear parents say, "It just came out of nowhere," but there are often warning signs. These can include:

Physical: Increased hunger, thirst, fatigue

Behavioural: Clinginess, withdrawal, irritability



By recognising these signs, you can help prevent meltdowns. Offer healthy snacks, establish routines, and create a calming environment.

#### **CALMING A MELTDOWN:**

When a meltdown happens there are lots of things you can do to help a child resolve them:

Show Calm: Children feed off the emotions of those around them, so not joining them in their emotional state can be really impactful. Take deep breaths which will help you to be the calm anchor that they need, and will also show your child how they can access calm.

Reassurance: Let your child know you are there for them and that they are safe. A hug or simply being present can help.

Create a Safe Space: If possible, remove distractions and find a guiet place for your child to access calm.

#### **AFTER THE MELTDOWN:**

Talk it Out: Once your child is calm, have a gentle conversation about what happened. Help them identify their triggers and highlight what helped them to access calm

#### REMEMBER:

Be Kind to Yourself: Parenting can be challenging at times. If you lose your cool, forgive yourself, be ok with saying sorry. Reflect on the situation so you can take a different approach next time.

Seek Help: If meltdowns are frequent or severe, there may be other reasons. For example a child might be neurodivergent e.g. autistic. You can call your GP for support as a first step.
