Significance of the Diwali days



Dhanteras falls two days before Diwali. On this day, people renovate and decorate homes and business. Devotees perform Lakshmi Puja in the evening, and light clay diyas to dispel negative energy. Traditionally, people perform Dhan (Silver Coin) Puja on this day.

Kali means darkness or evil, and Chaudas means 14th. Thus, celebrated on 14th day of Ashwin, Kali Chaudas is the day allotted to the worship of Maha-Kali or Shakti. On this day, we also offer puja to Hanumanji as our Kuladevta to protect us from evil

The third day of the festival of Diwali is the most important day of **Maha Lakshmi-Puja**. Traditionally in many parts of India, Chopda (Finance Books) Puja is performed on this day.

The day after Diwali marks the beginning of the New Year. People put on their finest clothing and head to the mandir early in the morning to participate in the first Aarti of the New Year. People greet each other by saying "Nutan Varsha Abhinandan".

Bhai Dooj is a Hindu festival that celebrates the love and affection between a brother and a sister. 'Bhai' means brother and 'Dooj' means two days after new moon. Every year the festival comes two days after Diwali in Kartik month. Brothers and sisters celebrate the festival to honor their bond of love.

Annakoot is celebrated in observance of the episode in Sri Krishna's childhood, in which He gave protection to the cowherd of Vrindavan from the wrath of Indra. "After lifting the huge Sri Govardhan Parvat (Mountain) for continuous seven days prior to Diwali, the Lord put it back on earth & asked the citizens to worship the mountain and offer food to Him.

Gyan Panchami is celebrated on 5th day after Diwali. Gyan Panchami is also known as Pandav Panchami or Laabh Panchami.

Pandav Panchami is believed as the day when Pandavas completed the thirteen years of vanvasam (exile). Laabh Panchami is considered as an auspicious day to start a business.

Skanda Shashti commemorates the destruction of evil by the Kartikeya also called Murugan, Subramanya, son of Shiva, and is celebrated with the enactment of Sura Samharam.

Puja of "Surya Dev", known as Chhath Parv or Surya Shashti. Chhath Parv is a festival celebrated in reverence to the Sun God. The word Chhath is a compound of two words; Chhath means six stages and Hath refers to the science of Hath Yoga (austerity). The word Chhath refers to the process of consciously obtaining the solar energy through 6 stages involving the methods similar to Hath Yoga.

The Significance of Diwali in Jainism

BTI Jains

Diwali, commonly celebrated as the "Festival of Lights," holds profound spiritual importance in Jainism. For Jains, Diwali is not merely a festival of lights and festivity—it marks one of the most sacred events in their religious history: the attainment of moksha (liberation) by Lord Mahavira, the 24th and last Tirthankara.

Lord Mahavira's Nirvana

According to Jain tradition, on the new moon night of the Kartik month (October–November) in 527 BCE, Lord Mahavira attained nirvana at Pavapuri, in present-day Bihar. His liberation is considered a momentous event, symbolizing the soul's ultimate triumph over karma and the cycle of birth and death.

On that night, it is believed that the heavens lit up with countless divine lamps to commemorate this spiritually momentous occasion. Since then, Jains light diyas and lamps on Diwali to honor the spiritual radiance of Lord Mahavira's teachings, which continue to guide souls toward liberation.

Spiritual Practices During Diwali

For Jains, Diwali is a time of introspection, spiritual renewal, and devotion. The festival emphasizes inner light over external celebration.

Key observances include:

Fasting and Prayer: Many Jains observe fasts for two days, offer prayers, and engage in meditation to purify the soul and reflect on Mahavira's path.

Lighting of Lamps: Diyas symbolize the eternal light of knowledge, dispelling the darkness of ignorance and honoring Mahavira's enlightenment.

Scripture Recitation: Diwali also marks the day when Gautam Swami, Mahavira's chief disciple, attained keval gyan (omniscience). Jains read sacred texts such as the Kalpasutra and Uttaradhyayan Sutra, which contain Mahavira's final teachings.

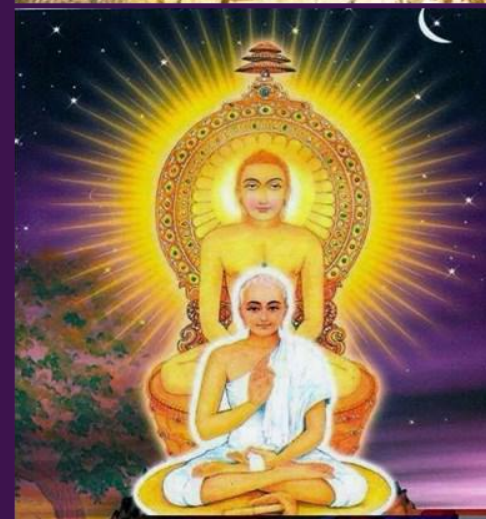
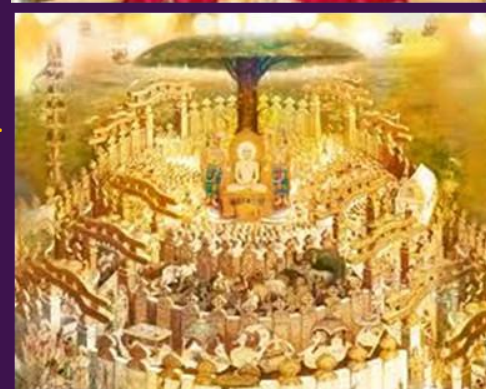
Charity and Forgiveness: Acts of generosity, compassion, and forgiveness are emphasized, reflecting Jain values like ahimsa (non-violence), self-restraint, and detachment from material desires.

The Deeper Meaning

In Jainism, Diwali is not about external festivities—it is a solemn yet uplifting observance dedicated to inner transformation. Lighting lamps symbolizes igniting the inner flame of wisdom. The festival serves as a powerful reminder that the true goal of life is liberation (moksha)—freedom from the cycles of birth and death, achieved through right faith, right knowledge, and right conduct, known as the Three Jewels of Jainism.

Conclusion

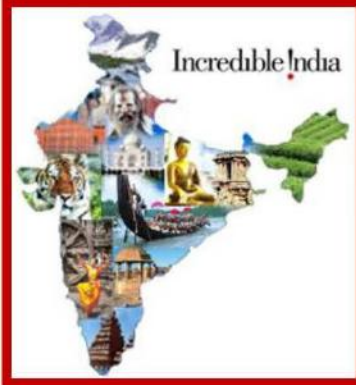

A New Chapter Begins

The 2025–26 academic session began on August 24, 2025, marking the 21st year of Bharatiya Vidyalaya's journey. With 210 students currently enrolled, the Vidyalaya continues to thrive as a center for cultural and spiritual education.

A Typical Sunday at Bharatiya Vidyalaya

Sundays begin at 9:30 AM with yoga, followed by prayers and Bhagavad Geeta chanting. Parents are encouraged to participate. Occasionally, students present on topics related to religion, culture, or language.

- 10:00 AM – Religion classes (Hindu or Jain)
- 11:00 AM – Language classes: Hindi, Sanskrit, Gujarati, Marathi, Tamil, Telugu, or Kannada (*New language classes may begin if six or more students enroll*) Occasionally, culture classes replace religion and language sessions.

12:00 PM – Aarati, followed by music or Geeta chanting classes

Parents may also join:

- A Bhagavad Geeta discussion group (approximately 20 participants)

A yoga and meditation session (approximately 15 participants on select Sundays)

This shared experience fosters spiritual growth and strengthens family bonds.

Volunteers: The Heart of Our Program

More than 50 teaching and 10 non-teaching volunteers support the Vidyalaya, all in compliance with Pennsylvania's child volunteering laws. New volunteers are paired with experienced mentors for their first two years to ensure smooth orientation and guidance.

Senior Student Program

Students in 9th grade and above are invited to become Senior Students, learning to teach alongside adult volunteers. For 2025–26, 14 students are participating—each teaches one subject and attends two others as learners.

Celebrating 20 Years of Service

In May 2025, Bharatiya Vidyalaya proudly celebrated 20 years of dedicated service to the community, reaffirming its commitment to cultural education and spiritual values.





Holistic Learning

Students explore:

- Values and teachings from Hindu and Jain traditions

For the past two years, an eight-session online Sanskrit course (90 minutes each) has welcomed both adults and children. This year, 8 adults and 3 children joined the program.
