It had been there a long time.

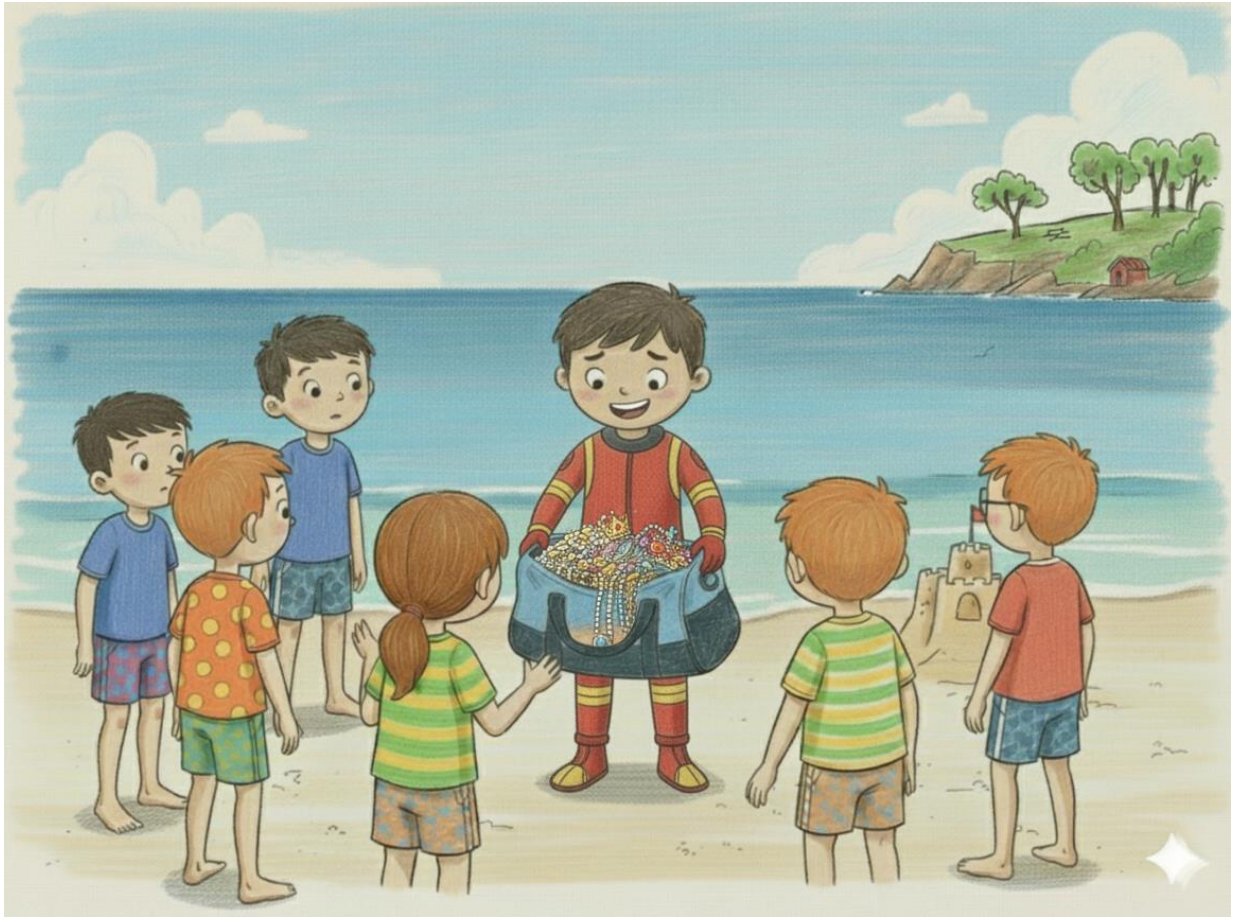


They went inside the submarine.
