Home Extension of East Peoria Home & Community Education




We have a gem of a group meeting right here and you are all invited to join in! Meet new people, learn, and help others at Home and Community Education.

- 5. Be Patient and Enjoy the Hunt



There's nothing quite like the sunny weather to motivate us to get organized this spring, and to help you get started, here's our top spring cleaning safety tips for seniors:

TAKE YOUR TIME

Set plenty of time aside to do some spring cleaning. The key is finding a balance: don't let tasks drag on, but don't feel like you have to get everything done in one weekend, either.





CHECK THE FRIDGE AND MEDICINE CABINET

Although they are easy to overlook, both the refrigerator and medicine cabinets can be hotspots for expired products. Be sure to throw away all expired food items and medications, especially those that are no longer prescribed to you.

DOUBLE-CHECK SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are easy to ignore until there's an emergency. Make sure that there are fresh batteries in all of your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.







It's a good idea to go over what to do in case of an emergency, such as a power outage or a house fire, every spring to help keep the plan fresh in your mind.

Emergency kits should be assessed often and restocked in the spring and winter. General contents may include: a flashlight and spare batteries, thermometer, Band-Aids, scissors, tape, triple antibiotic ointment, wound care dressings, allergy and digestive medications, protein bars, a current medication list and names and phone number of family or friends to contact list in an emergency.

CLEAN UP CLUTTER

Trips and falls are likely to happen when you accumulate too much "stuff". Reduce the risk by removing unnecessary and obstructive items from your regular walking paths and place them in storage. Make maintaining a clear walkway in every room of the house or apartment a top priority.
