Ang Thong Marine Park

This is certainly one of the most popular excursions, as the place is truly magical. Starting from Koh Samui. Located 40 km off the coast of the island and covering a total area of 102 km², this archipelago, which includes 42 small islands and only 18 km² of land, is a combination of superlatives and postcard clichés: dense vegetation, cliffs, lagoons, a vegetation, cliffs, lagoons, caves and white sandy beaches. sandy beaches. No inhabitants live here, the fauna and flora are the kings.

Landscapes unusual and a crystal clear water

The Park holds some of the most unusual and spectacular scenery in all of Thailand.

Its steep limestone cliffs, some as high as 400 metres, have been shaped into unusual and beautiful forms by centuries of erosion. This "Golden Basin" (Thai for "Ang Thong") has four distinct forest types, which are teeming with wildlife. Indeed, many species of mammals (otters, bats...), birds (hornbills, kites...), reptiles (monitor lizards, snakes...) and incredible and multicoloured aquatic fauna (including sea turtles) have taken up residence in this magical and particularly exotic place.

Obviously, this place is ideal for scuba diving and snorkeling enthusiasts.

With 42 islands to explore, a full visit to Ang Thong Marine Park would take weeks.

Only Thai Government approved tour boats can enter Ang Thong National Park. Tours are usually one day long and can be booked from Koh Samui, Koh Phangan or Koh Tao. Most tours stop at only a few places in the archipelago (other islands and islets are off limits to tourists).

Koh Tao: Turtle Island

Koh Tao is located on the eastern side of the Surat Thani coast, with two neighbouring islands, Koh Phangan and Koh Samui.

Its name means "**turtle island**", as the island is inhabited by **sea turtles**. Although they are no longer as abundant as they once were, green turtles can still be found in certain areas such as Thian Og Bay. The shape of the island resembles that of a turtle when viewed from Koh Phangan.

The natural beauty of the island, both above and below the water, with its stunning coral reefs and abundant marine life in clear, warm water, attracts thousands of visitors each year, making it an unforgettable destination for divers, adventurers and

and travellers. This appeal, combined with the relaxed atmosphere and lifestyle, has long attracted people here and is now a warm second home for many.



Koh Tao has developed in many ways and, with its thriving dive industry, is now one of the world's leading dive teaching centres.



Koh Phangan, the island of Full Moon, but not only...

Although **Koh Phangan** is world famous for the Full Moon party (we'll talk about it in the next chapters), Koh Phangan is a beautiful island to discover.



To do this, when you arrive at **Tongsala pier**, you just have to walk a bit and arrive at the town.

You will find many scooter rental shops that will allow you to visit the island freely.

With a circumference of about 40 km, this rather small island has about 30 beaches of different lengths and characteristics.

In this case, you can hire a longtail boat for the day.


