PreK Transportation

Registration lottery is Feb. 28, 2025. Registrations and documents received by 11:59 p.m. on Feb. 24, 2025 will be included in the lottery. All required documents must be received to be included in the lottery.

The following documents are required to complete registration.

- Proof of Birth: A copy of birth certificate, I-94 or passport.
- Immunization Record: Provide the most up-to-date record. You may file a medical exemption signed by a health care provider or provide a notarized, signed conscientious objection form.
- Proof of Income: Provide proof of household annual adjusted gross income for 2024. Two current pay stubs, 2024 W-2 form or 2024 Federal Tax form. Scholarship applications may require a different proof of income. Proof of income is not required if your family is fee level G.

Documents can be emailed to ecfe@district279.org, faxed to 763-391-8762, or can be dropped off at either of the above addresses. If the required documents are not received within two weeks of registration, enrollment will be canceled.



Preschool and PreK students are placed through a random lottery giving everyone an equal chance at their first choice.

- Lottery: Students are randomly placed into their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd class choice. If all choices are full, parent/guardian is contacted by phone. Selecting three choices increases your chances of placement.
- Payment: A form of payment is required when registering. No charges are made until the registration is confirmed and the lottery is complete. The first payment includes a non-refundable \$25 registration fee along with first month's tuition. Remaining tuition payments are made in eight equal monthly payments. If tuition is paid annually, a 5% discount is given at the time of registration.
- Class Confirmation: After the lottery is complete, confirmation and payment receipt are sent by email. Registrations after the initial lottery will be confirmed upon receipt of required documents.





Details

Calendar

Classes follow a schedule from September 2025 to June 2026.

Cancellation Policy

A \$25 non-refundable registration fee is included with the first month tuition payment. Tuition refunds are prorated based on student's last day.

If class is canceled due to low enrollment, registration fee and tuition will be refunded in full.

Health Forms - if needed

If your child needs medication or special care at school, parents must complete health forms. Clinics can fax asthma, seizure, or allergy action plans to the program nurse at 763-391-8762. Forms are online: bit.ly/ECFE-Health-History.

Ongoing Registration

After the initial lottery date, registrations continue until all classes are full up to April 2026.

Discounts

Annual Tuition Discount: a 5% discount is given if full tuition is paid at the time of registration.

Sibling Discount: a 15% tuition discount is given for a sibling enrolled during the same year.

Photo Agreement

Families eligible for a scholarship must complete an application and pay the \$25 registration fee plus the first month's tuition. If your child receives a scholarship, the registration fee and tuition will be refunded. If a scholarship is not awarded, you will need to make monthly tuition payments as scheduled. Should additional scholarships become available, we will contact you.
