The Beethoven Experience

Beethoven's *Grosse Fuge* is almost terrifyingly powerful, music full of anguish and violence. Initially the final movement of his String Quartet No.13, it became the standalone piece we know today after musicians refused to perform it, such is its difficulty.

It's performed here alongside two of Beethoven's greatest quartets by the trailblazing Chiaosuro Quartet, who visit us here in Machynlleth for the first time.

For those travelling by car, parking is available at Heol Maengwyn car park.

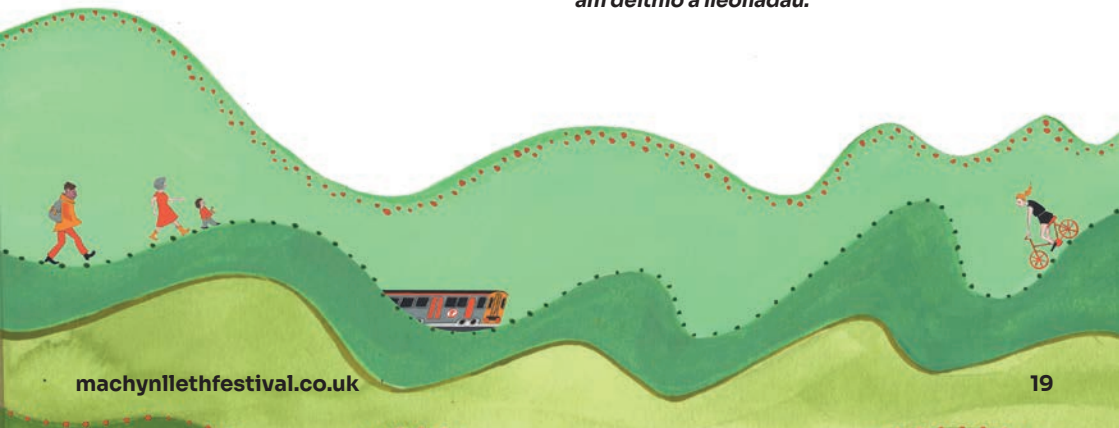
