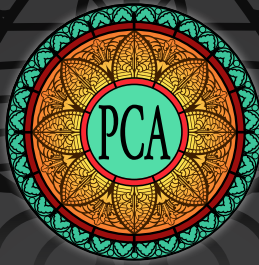

NOTE *from the* DIRECTOR

On March 11, 2020, four actors ran through their final rehearsal before opening night. During the course of that rehearsal, my phone was blowing up with notifications, and when the rehearsal ended, I shared with the cast all that had happened while they ran their lines.

1. The NBA suspended play
2. March Madness had been canceled.
3. Sarah Palin was revealed to be the Masked Singer.
4. Tom Hanks and his wife had the coronavirus.

God of Carnage was the play the actors were rehearsing. It ran four days before the theater (and the world) went black. We had no idea what lay ahead.

We are so grateful that Suze's PCA decided to revive *God of Carnage* for another 8 performances. Having been denied the chance to step on stage and tell stories to our community and friends for a year and a half, the cast has embraced this opportunity with dedication and delight.

Deep thanks not only to a once-in-a-lifetime cast, but also to Ed Gates (Assistant Director), Sandy Vernon (Lights and Sound), and Klay Brackney Wandeleaer (Set and Light Design and all things Tech).

Thank YOU for attending. We will strive to deliver a performance worthy of your patronage. So please, hold on tight, be ready to laugh, let go of the world, and bear witness to adults behaving ridiculously bad. Enjoy!

IMPORTANT THOUGHTS *on the* PLAY

I don't want to give too much away about the play. Audiences need to think for themselves. But given the long overdue changes that we are starting to see in this country, we need to take a moment and talk about some of the language you will hear in this play. Among the thousands of words that compose this play there are a couple words that are repulsive. The words are not meant to be startling. The words are not meant to be "push the boundaries". The words are meant to be repulsive and revealing. One of the reoccurring themes of French playwright's Yasmina Reza's work is that beneath some people's well-polished façade lingers an ugliness, ignorance and a meanness; characteristics they only reveal when they think no one is listening or watching. Only then do we get to see the dark beliefs that truly inform their action. It is hard to portray acts of racism, bigotry, and homophobia without using the language of racists, bigots and homophobes. After much discussion and debate, we have left the words in the play, and once you've seen the performance, we trust you'll understand why.

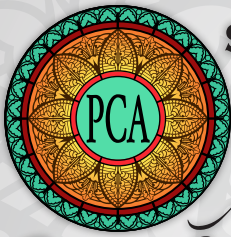

NEW BUILDING FLOOR PLANS



50 years ago Norma Hazeltine purchased and donated the original landmark Sacred Heart Catholic Church to Prescott Fine Arts for use as a community theater and gallery.

Since 1970 PCA has presented complete seasons of high quality theatrical performances and visual arts exhibits featuring local performers and artists.

Under the leadership of Executive Director Robyn Allen and the Board of Directors, PCA is launching our capital campaign, "Setting the Stage," which will raise \$3.2 million for construction of a Multi-Purpose facility and renovation of our current buildings. The new building will encompass a 99 seat Studio Theater replacing Stage Too. It will also include the box office, a small lobby art gallery, rehearsal space, costume storage space, and multi-purpose rooms. Additionally, this will free up space in the existing buildings for improved dressing rooms and multipurpose space.

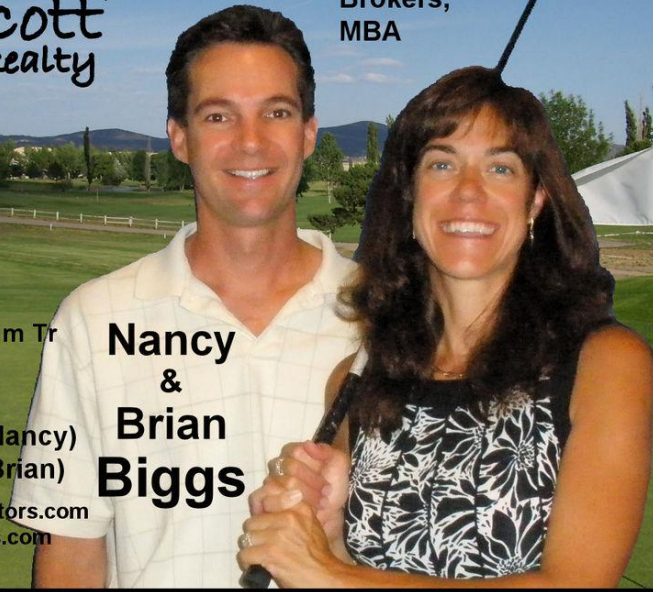

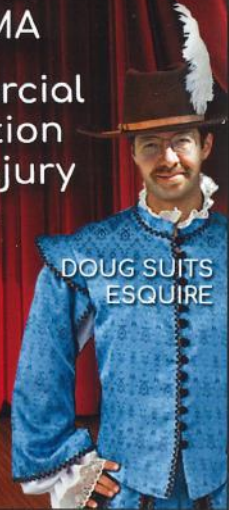
