THE BORDERPLEX REGION

- THE LABOR FORCE DECREASED BY 1,590 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS DECREASED BY 122 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS DECREASED BY 1,468 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH

- EL PASO, TX MSA UNEMPLOYMENT WAS AT 4.5% WITH A TOTAL OF 17,222 UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS
- EL PASO, TX MSA ADDED 7,900 NONFARM JOBS SINCE MARCH 2023
- EL PASO, TX MSA LOST 900 NONFARM JOBS FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH



The three Super Sectors with the least employment for the El Paso MSA in March 2024 were:


- 1. Financial Activities















