PROSPECT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Must possess a valid motorcycle permit or license
- Must be sponsored by a current MVMC member
- Must attend one general meeting to be introduced as a prospect
- Must at all times abide by all rules and policies as outlined in "Motorcycle Ride Rules & Observances"
- Should safely operate a motorcycle in the Prospect Ride following the formal introduction
- Should endeavor to participate in other club rides, including Benefit Run, Gay Pride Parades, Provincetown Weekend, Fall Foliage Run, Prospect Ride and any other "Board sanctioned" rides
- Must pay the non-refundable \$40 prospect fee
