FOREVER YOUNG INITIATIVES

Forever Young Zones

Thousands of children continue to be impacted each year in Forever Young Zones throughout the United States and Ghana, Africa. Individually designed for specific community needs, every Zone carries the theme "Be Your Own Hero." Children need role models to pattern their lives after, but ultimately we want to equip and empower them with the ability and desire to go out and become their own heroes. Forever Young Zones are created to inspire young minds and motivate active lifestyles, whether they be playrooms in children's hospitals, athletic facilities, or technology spaces in youth community centers.

8 to 80 Zones

Our 8 to 80 and Creators Zones—a collaboration between Steve Young, Jerry Rice, and Meta—equip our young innovators with the skills to pursue and navigate careers in technology, esports, gaming, and mass media in our digital world.

The new 8 to 80 Zone at the NFL YET Academy in Phoenix provides imaginative and technologically advanced learning methods to students. They have implemented a pilot training program accessing virtual reality technology using Meta Quest II systems, thus preparing students for exciting job advancement opportunities in the future.

Similarly, our Zone in Atlanta is to be commended for its creativity in offering mentoring and learning opportunities to youth from all backgrounds, as well as providing ongoing adult education to the community through worldwide programing.



INNOVATING



Nonprofit Institute

Forever Young Foundation partners with the Arbinger Institute, a leader in management training and team building, to provide a year-long training for nonprofit professionals. With a mission to inspire excellence in nonprofit leaders, this forum centers efforts on providing nonprofit leaders with the most effective tools to operate at a high level of efficiency and accountability.

Through underwriting from Forever Young Foundation, private donors, and corporations, this training is offered at minimal cost to leaders seeking to ensure the sustainability of their organizations for generations to come.

We made great strides in 2023 to grow funding and the number of trainings offered. By year's end, we more than doubled the number of FYI events compared to the previous year—training over 35 organizations and more than 130 executives and board members. Since its inception in 2010, over a thousand nonprofit leaders have participated in the Institute.

Engage Now Africa

Forever Young's charitable efforts in Africa are administered through the African NGO, Engage Now Africa. Created by Lynette and Bob Gay in 2002, Engage Now's purpose is to "heal, rescue, and lift" by serving those living in the communities they support. Engage Now Africa is committed to providing programs with sustainable self-help solutions and fighting poverty, illiteracy, and disease through the funding and building of schools, microcredit loans, and humanitarian assistance. Forever Young and Engage Now Africa are empowering Africans to address their challenges with sustainable solutions.

Sophie's Place

Sophie's Place was established in loving memory of singer, songwriter, and friend, Sophie Barton. These dedicated spaces are music therapy rooms built in children's hospitals that treat young people suffering from pain, chronic illness, and serious injury. They provide an integrative medical approach to prescriptive medicine—assisting physical therapy through body movement, alleviating pain and supporting cognitive health by rewiring the brain synapses.

While most people know music has an extraordinary power to bring comfort and peace to the soul, clinical studies have proven that music therapy offers an evidence-based, integrative medical approach in treating young hospital patients.





We express gratitude to our generous donors and sponsors who continue to facilitate this progress.














