WORSHIP

COLOURS OF THE SEASONS

Traditionally, the church calendar contains a few seasons, each marked by a specific colour to reflect its mood. This is not dissimilar to the colours of the four seasons of the year, viz. winter, spring, summer and autumn, which are roughly represented by white, green, yellow and orange respectively.

In Hebron, we mark the following seasons with the colours that signify a certain meaning:

Advent purple preparation Christmas iov Epiphany hope green mourning Lent purple Easter purity Pentecost red fire, passion **Ordinary Time** green life

The colour is reflected by the stole that is draped upon the crosses in each of our sanctuaries.

THE MOVEMENTS IN THE HEBRON WORSHIP SERVICE

In Hebron, we worship God in four movements, viz.

Gather to Worship Alert to God's Word Align to God's Word Go Do God's Work

These movements help us return for corporate worship after a week in the world and be spiritually recharged before returning to witness for Christ in the world once more.

SOME OF OUR WORSHIP SERVICE PRACTICES

Standing to read Scripture is our way of demonstrating reverence for God's Word.

Kneeling for prayer expresses a submissive attitude towards God. But you may remain seated for prayer if kneeling is physically challenging.

Offering is a time for Christians to express worship to God by a freewill giving of money towards his work through the church. If you are not a Christian, you need not give.


Benediction and Threefold Amen

The pastor proclaims a blessing from God to the congregation at the end of the worship service and the congregation affirms all that was heard and received by singing the amen.

Water baptism by sprinkling or pouring of water is practised in Hebron, since we follow the Reformed system of faith (see Westminster Confession of Faith, 28.3). Baptism is a sign and seal of God's covenant promise to his people. All believers are commanded to receive it (see Matthew 28:19) to signify their membership in the covenant.

Infant baptism is practised in Hebron. The infant children of one or both believing parents are entitled to receive the sign and seal of God's covenant promise (see Acts 2:38-39). In Hebron, such children become non-communicant members.

The Lord's Supper is observed monthly in Hebron. Its communicant members and baptised communicants of other Bible-believing churches who worship with us are welcome to partake of it. It reminds us of our covenant membership in Christ and its benefits present and future. Non-Christians, unbaptised Christians and non-communicant members of Hebron shall abstain.
