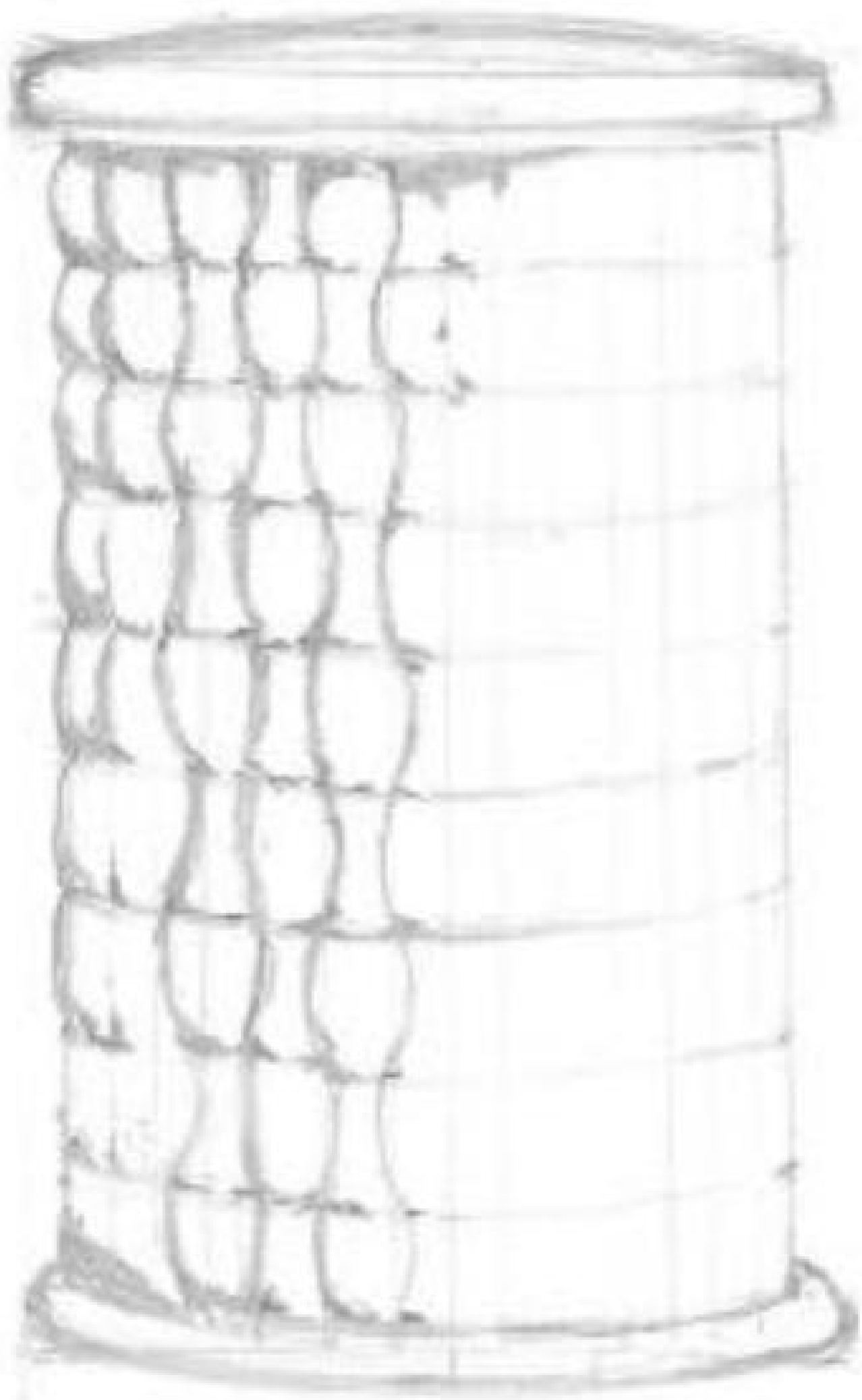
‘Sholapith Art’

An iron-ore-based craft originating from the Bastar region of Chhattisgarh



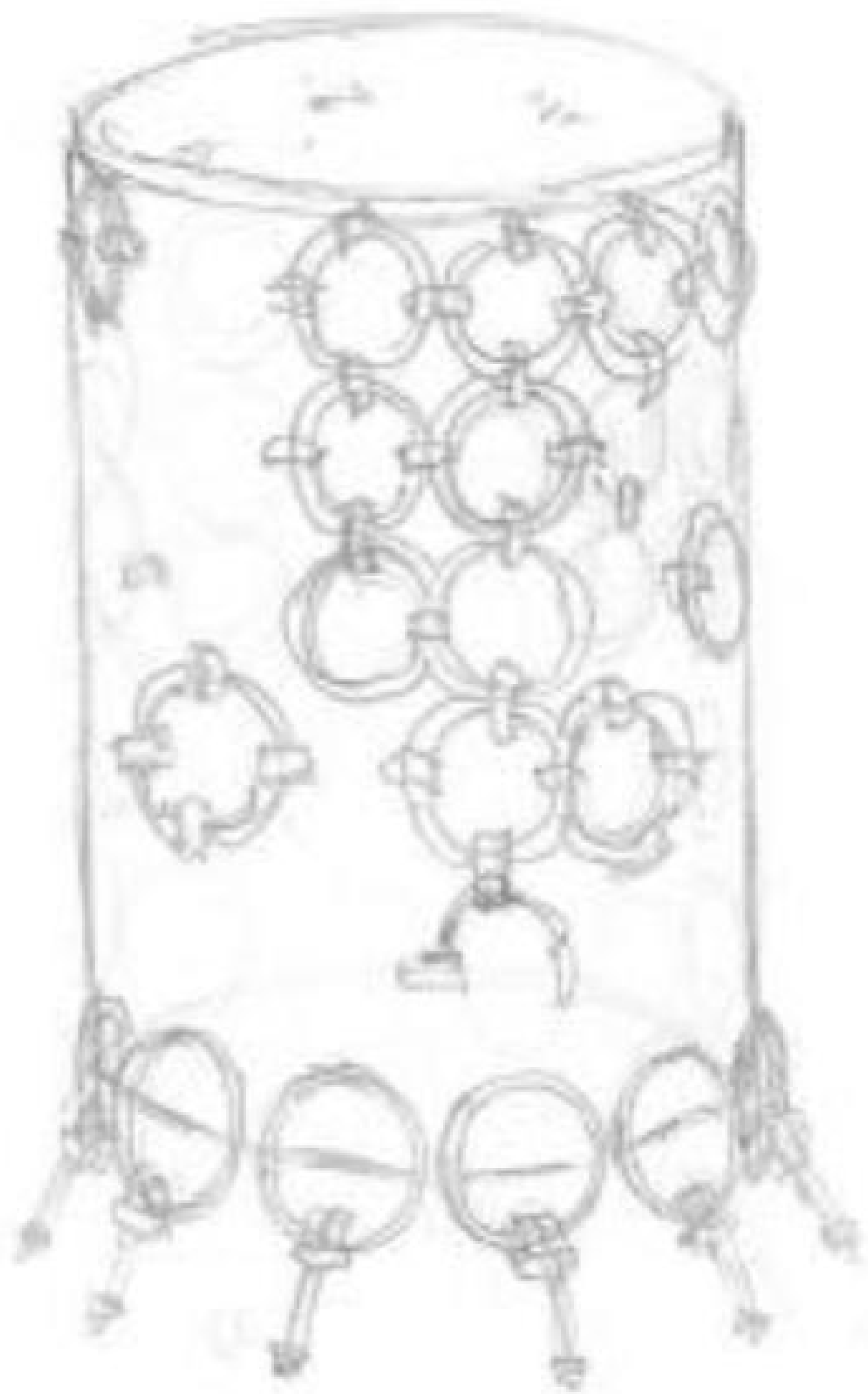
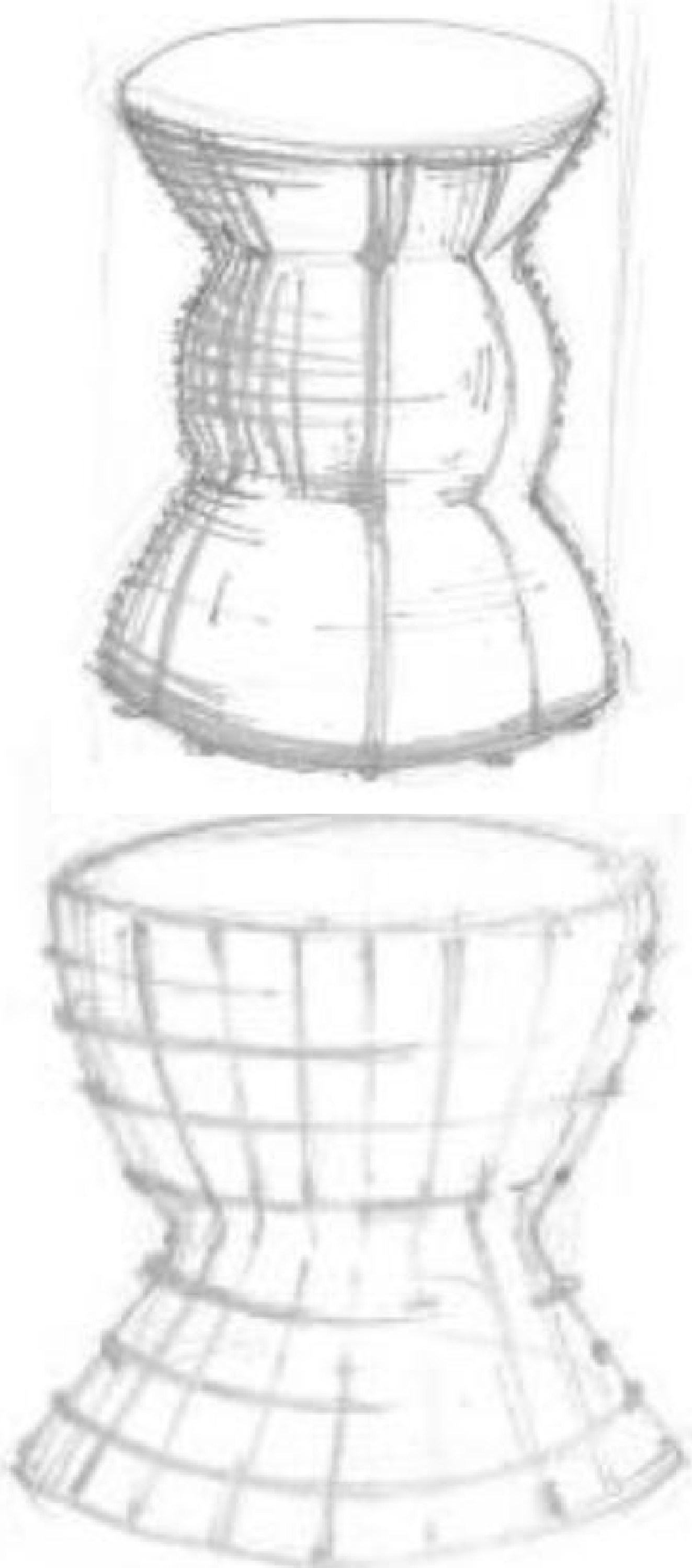
'Gombegala Nagara'

The 'Gombegala Nagara', or simply, Town of Toys, Channapatna is a craft village in the Ramanagara District of Karnataka.



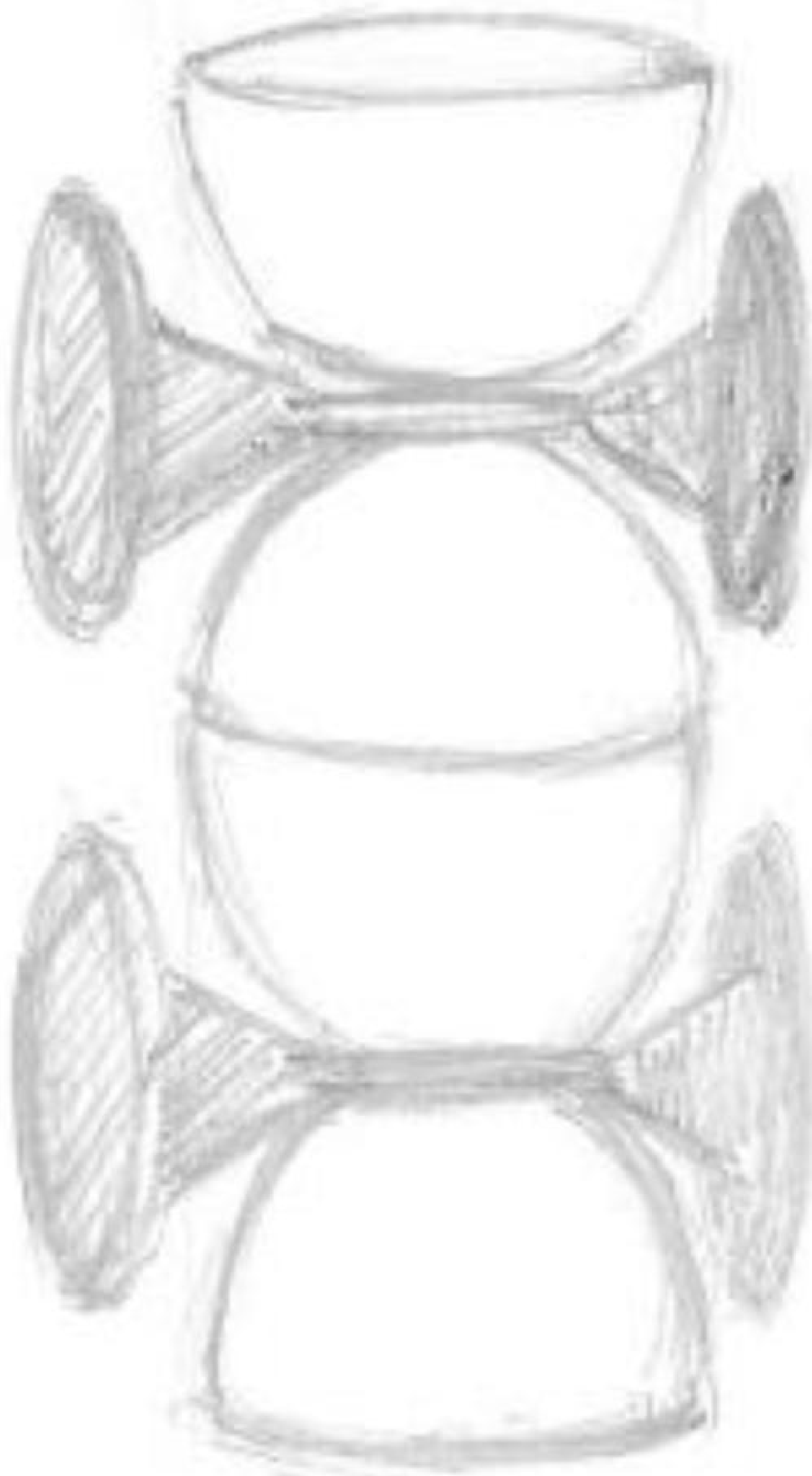
‘Patra’

Fascinated by superheroes I created my own compositions of dynamic poses.

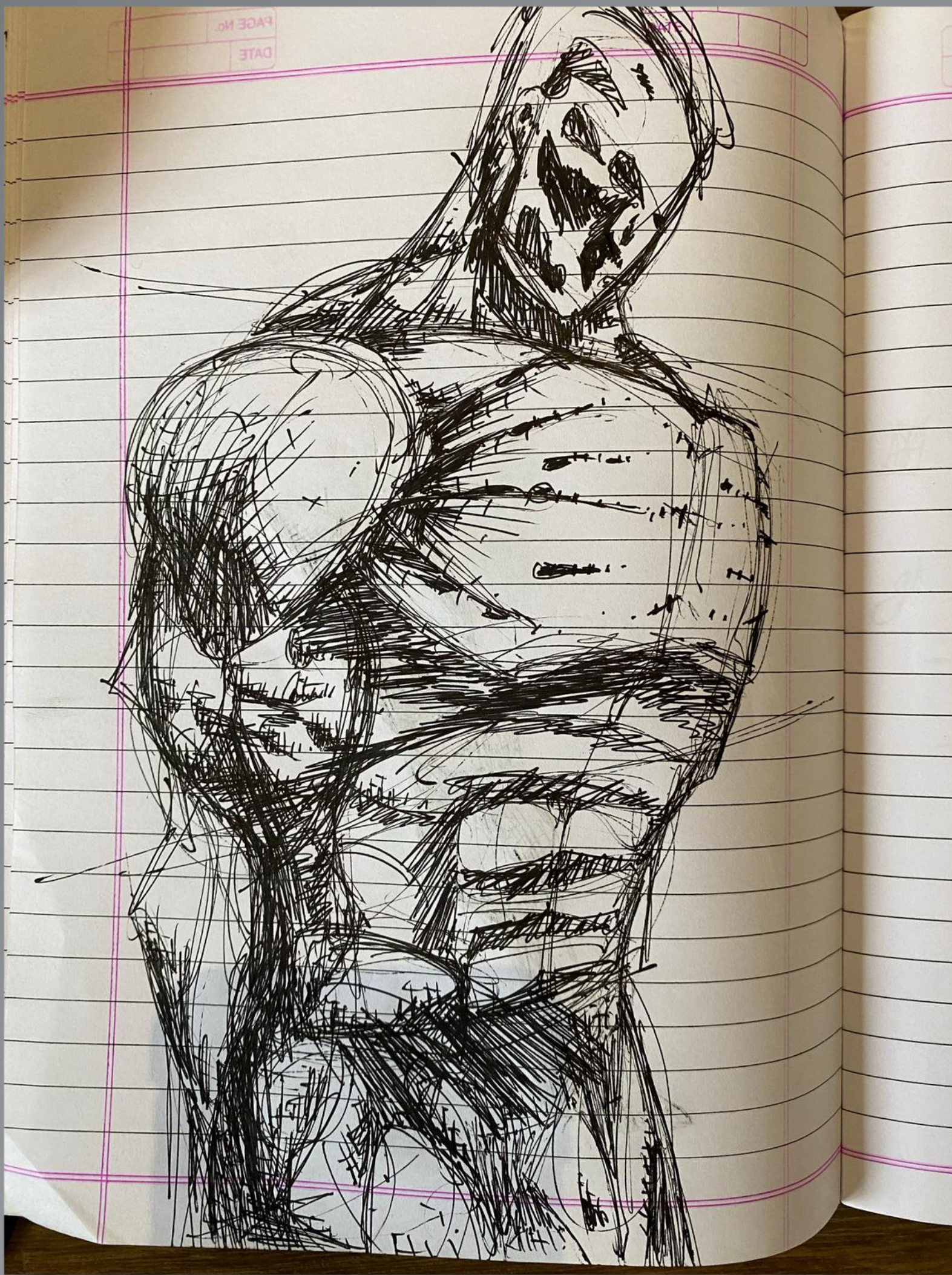

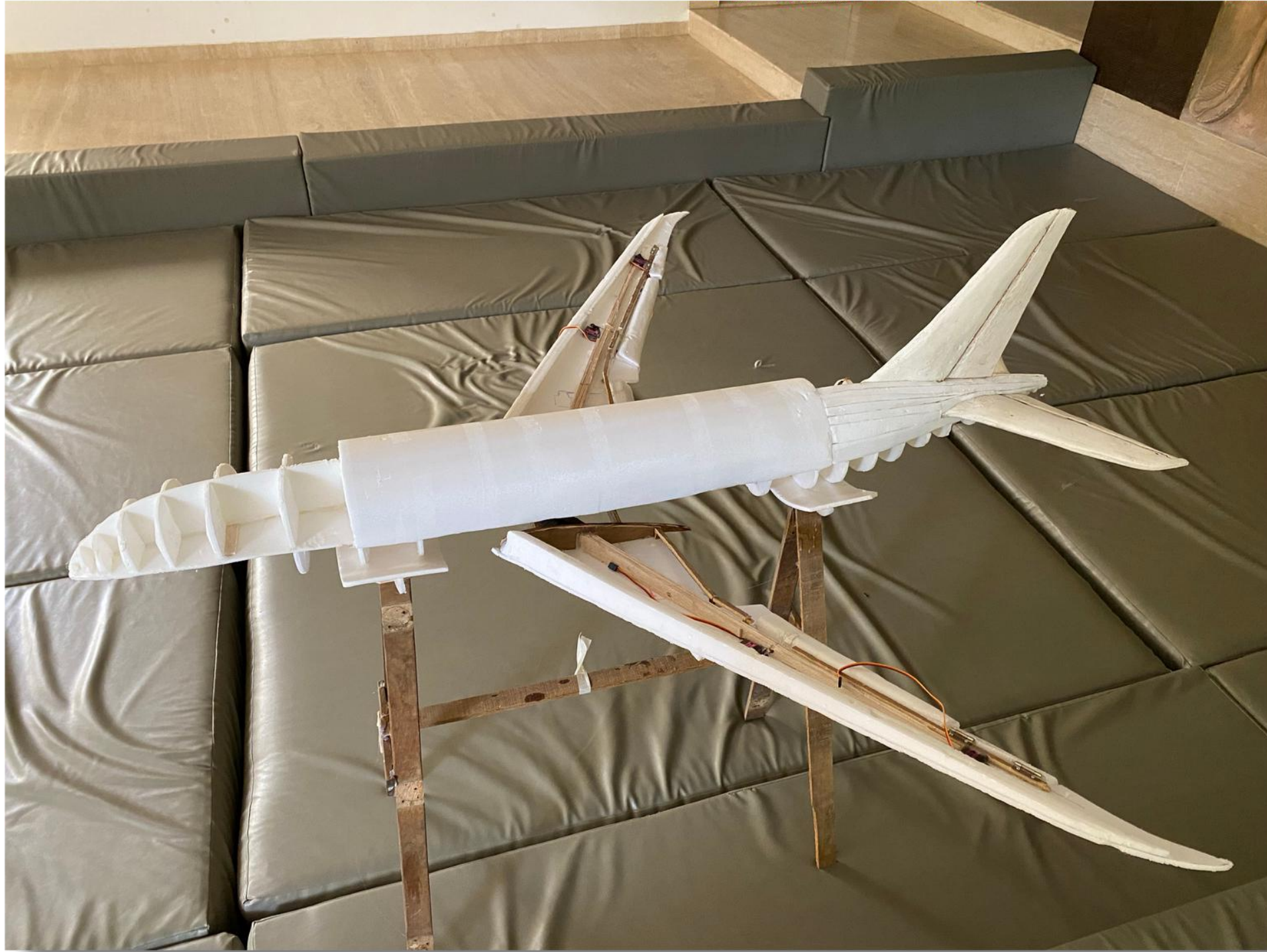
