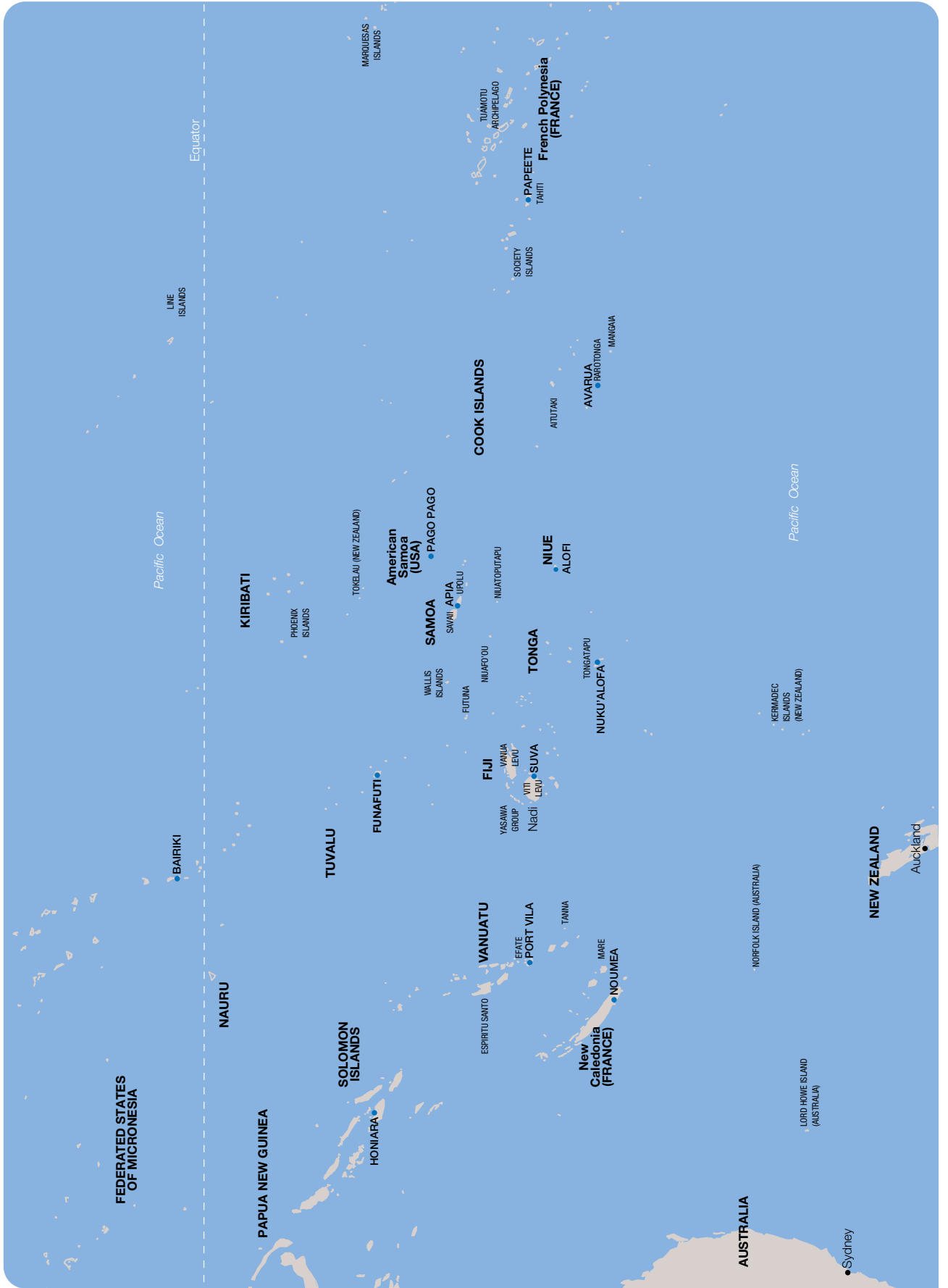

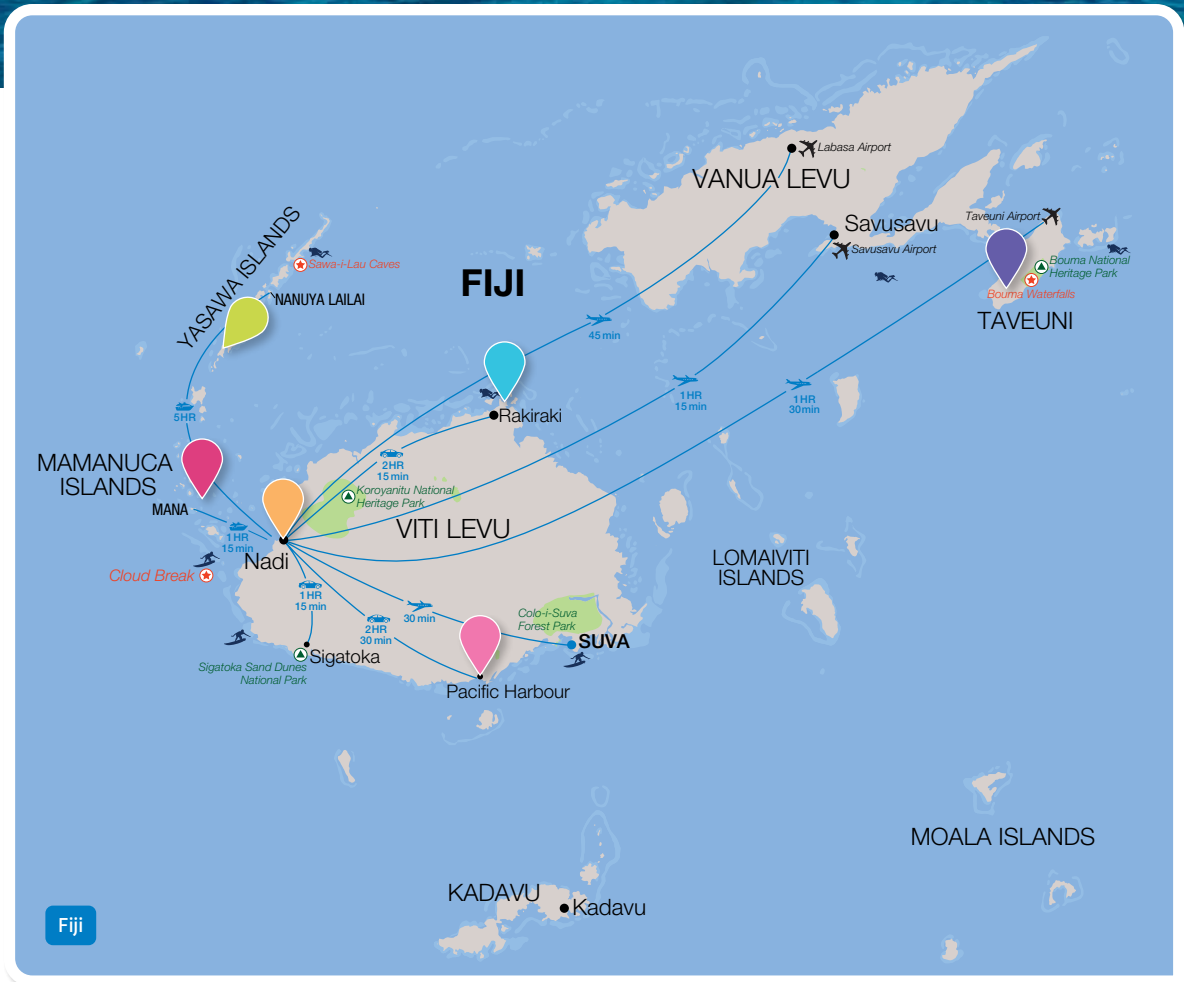
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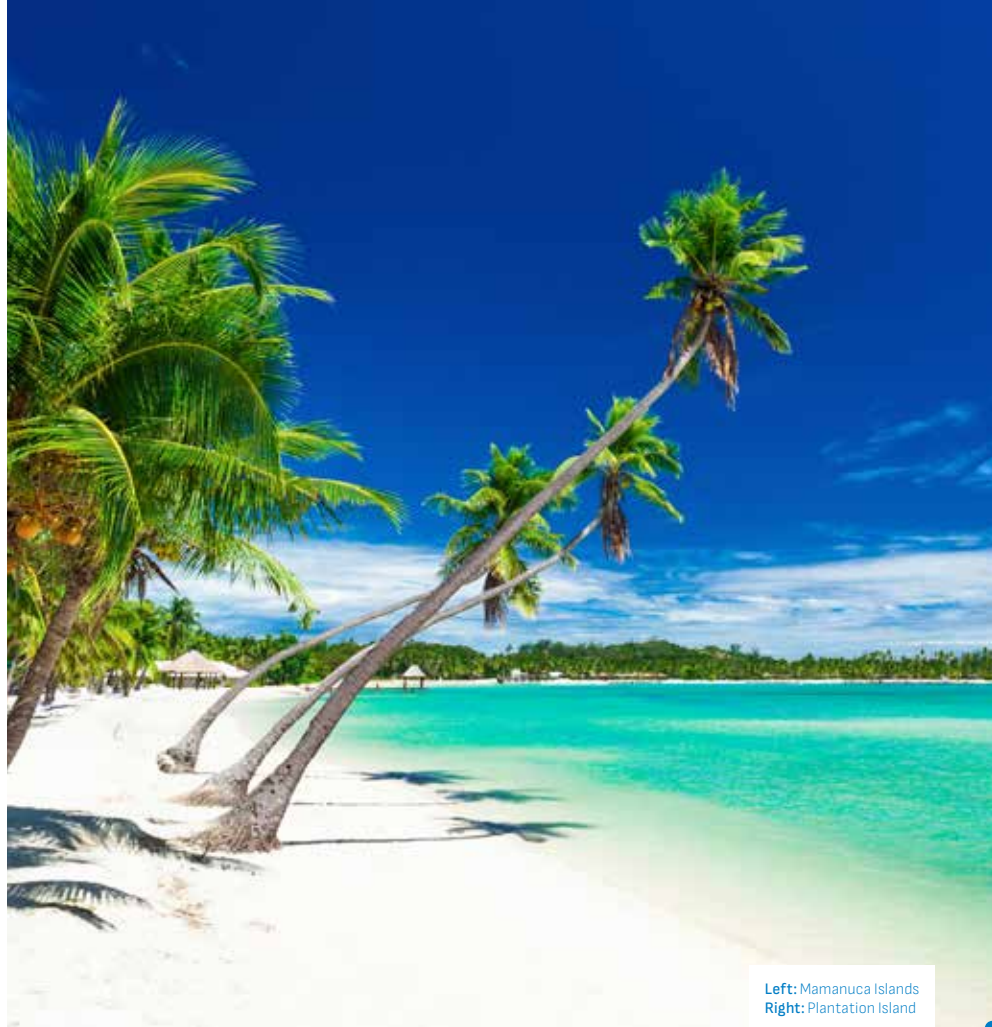

WHEN TO GO

Sitting firmly in the tropics, you can expect warm weather all year round. The wet season is from November through to April, and if you don't mind the odd afternoon thunderstorm, this is also the best-value time to travel. Most resorts in Fiji cater to families, so school holidays are the busiest time to travel.

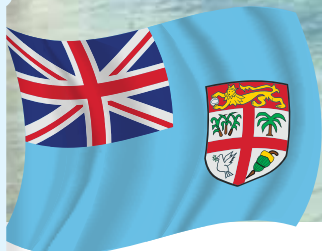

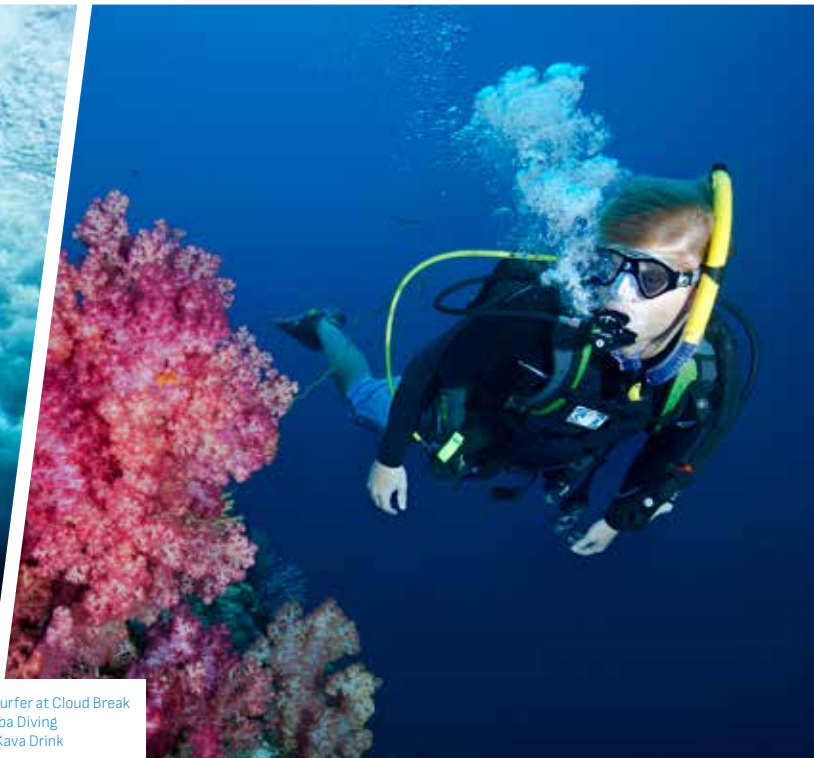

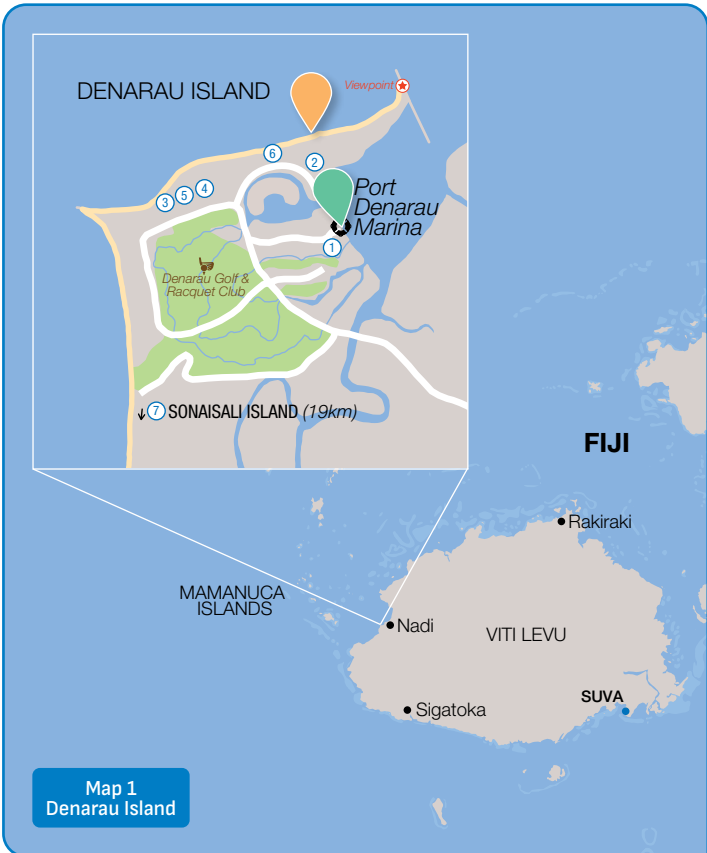
Off Road Cave Safari

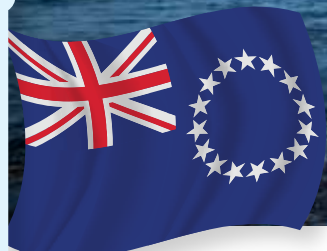

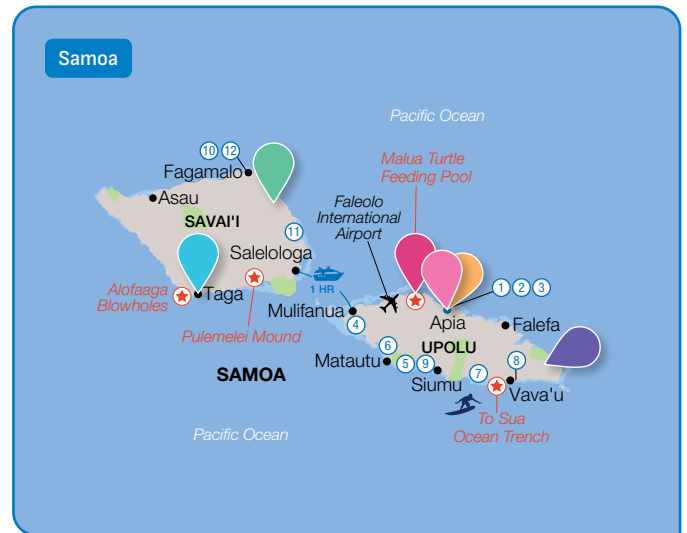

The year-round temperatures in Samoa only vary slightly, with the big seasonal difference being the rainfall. Samoa's wet weather changes the most, with a very wet season from October to March. Travel times between the months of April and September are usually a sure bet of good weather.

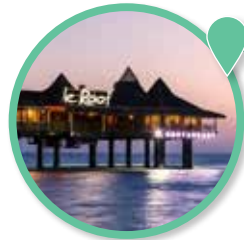
