

While studying architecture, she continued to pursue her passion for sculpture, attending art classes alongside her academic work.

In the summer of 2024, she opened her own studio in Barcelona, marking an exciting new chapter in her career. With growing recognition and an everevolving practice, Sofia is now exploring materials beyond ceramics, including aluminum and natural stone.













The 'Nomad' project refers to the theme of home and adaptation. Living organisms emerge into the world from various enclosed, chamber-like spaces like seeds, eggs, a womb, and then adapt to new habitats, new homes. The body of a living organism is inherently felt as both a vessel and a home.

The sculptural forms refer to the theme of home, a safe and private space in which semi-darkness lurks or is illuminated by light.
