














Prehospital & Trauma Training

For those employed in high-risk sectors like construction, oil and gas, security, mining, or the fire service, holding a FREC 3, FREC 4, or Immediate Emergency Care (IEC) qualification is highly advantageous. These fields face a greater likelihood of workplace incidents, and having a trained first responder on hand can significantly improve the management and outcome of any emergency scenario.

Throughout the course, you will acquire the competencies outlined in the PHEM skills framework at descriptor level D. Additionally, you will gain practical experience in administering emergency oxygen, managing trauma patients, identifying major illnesses, and other vital competencies.

The Qualsafe First Response Emergency Care (FREC 3) (Level 3 RQF) is a five-day, nationally recognised and regulated qualification ideal for those working or volunteering as first responders. It is particularly relevant for firefighters, industrial fire teams, police officers, and medical personnel operating at events or in high-risk workplaces. This includes roles such as Emergency/Community First Responders, Door Supervisors, Close Protection Operatives, and Security Guards.

It is equally suited to personnel in high-risk environments such as the military, power stations, manufacturing, agriculture, and large-scale industrial or commercial sites.

Optional additional modules are available
- including supraglottic airways, nasal
naloxone, blood glucose monitoring,
Penthrox, and Entonox - but can only
be delivered where there is a genuine
operational need and an appropriate clinical
governance framework in place to support
ongoing competence.

Throughout the FREC 4 course, you will develop advanced skills as outlined in the PHEM skills framework at descriptor level E. This course will enhance your abilities in managing complex trauma patients, advanced airway management, administering emergency medications, and dealing with major illnesses.

The Qualsafe First Response Emergency Care (FREC 4) (Level 4 RQF) is a nationally recognised and regulated qualification for those looking to advance their first responder skills. It is ideal for firefighters, industrial emergency response teams, medical personnel, and security professionals working in high-risk sectors such as oil and gas, power generation, manufacturing, construction, and the military.

Building on the foundations of FREC 3, this course develops the ability to manage complex casualties and incidents in high-pressure environments. Learners achieve the competencies set out in the PHEM skills framework at descriptor level E, including advanced airway management, trauma care, administration of emergency medications, and the management of major illnesses.






