2 DAY FLYING SAFARI

Uganda is home to half the world's Mountain Gorilla population and the only country with tree climbing lions. Seeing these animals up close in their natural habitat is one of the most impressive wildlife encounters in Africa. Visiting the gorillas directly supports conservation efforts and livelihood of the host communities.

DAY 1:

- After an early breakfast, transfer to

- Transfer by road for about half an hour to sanctuary Gorilla Camp.
- Check in at the camp and enjoy a delicious lunch.
- In the afternoon, you have the opportunity to relax and prepare for the big day, if you are feeling active, you can head out on some community visits around the camp.
- Overnight: Sanctuary Gorilla Camp
- Meals: Lunch, Dinner


DAY 2:

GORILLA TREKKING

IN BWINDI NATIONAL PARK

- The Big Day arrives!
- Wake up early for a nourishing breakfast
- Head to the national park offices where you will be allocated a gorilla tracking guide.
- After a pre-tracking briefing on the ecology and history of the gorillas, as well as appropriate safety precautions
- Embark on an unforgettable gorilla trekking adventure, hiking through the dense forest in search of a habituated gorilla family.
- Spend up to one hour observing and photographing the gorillas in their natural habitat.
- After the trek, return to the lodge and have lunch.
- Transfer by road to Kiharu for the scheduled light aircraft flight to Entebbe International Airport.
- Activities depends on your International flight departure time



THE EXPERIENCE

This bucket-list experience takes you deep into the rain forest for an eye-opening encounter with highly endangered mountain gorillas. Expect to walk between 2 and 8 hours in steep and sometimes muddy conditions, with showers often appearing. The trek can be tough and requires a degree of (average) fitness. When contact is made with the gorillas, you will be able to spend up to one hour with them. Watch them feed, move, play and wrestle.

ACCOMMODATION

BEST TIME TO VISIT



DRY SEASONS: JANUARY & FEBRUARY & JUNE TO SEPTEMBER

Although it's regarded as a year-round activity, the best time to visit Uganda for gorilla trekking is during the country's two dry seasons: January and February and from June to September. Game viewing in Uganda's savannah parks is best at the end of the dry seasons - February and March and September/early October - when wildlife is concentrated around water sources.

WET SEASONS: MARCH TO MAY

March, April and May see the heaviest rainfall in Uganda, with shorter rains in October to November. This doesn't affect your chances of spotting gorillas, although be prepared for a soggy, slippery trek! Waterproofs, and waterproof boots, are essential. It's also believed that the gorillas linger on the warmer, lower slopes during wetter weather, so your trek may be shorter.
