Inspired by the season of spring, each page is alive with colour and life. Hope you enjoy leafing through the pages of this edition. Happy Reading!

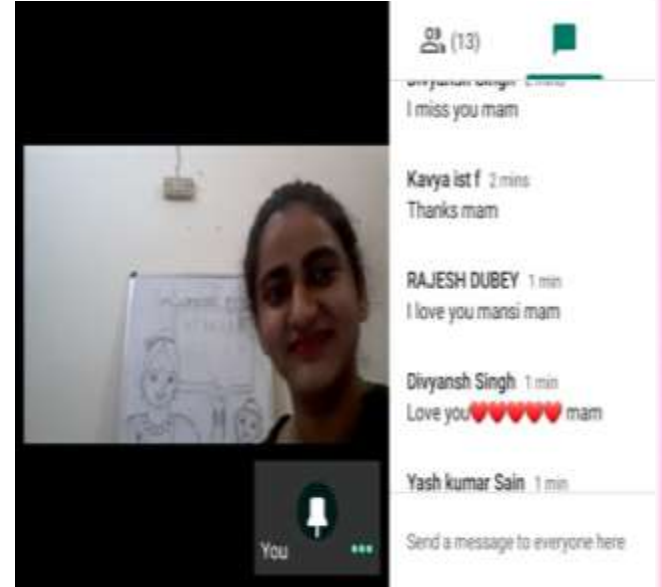
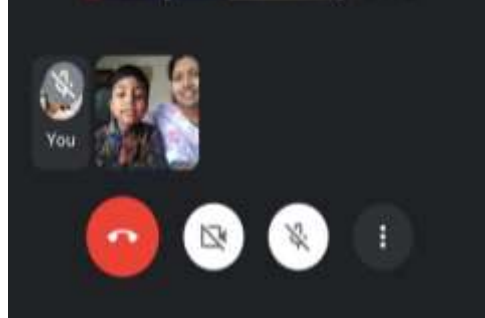
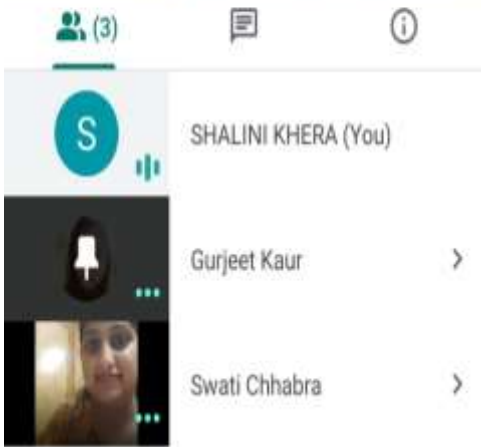

Students of Pre-School explored their surroundings through art and origami in this paper-folding soirée.

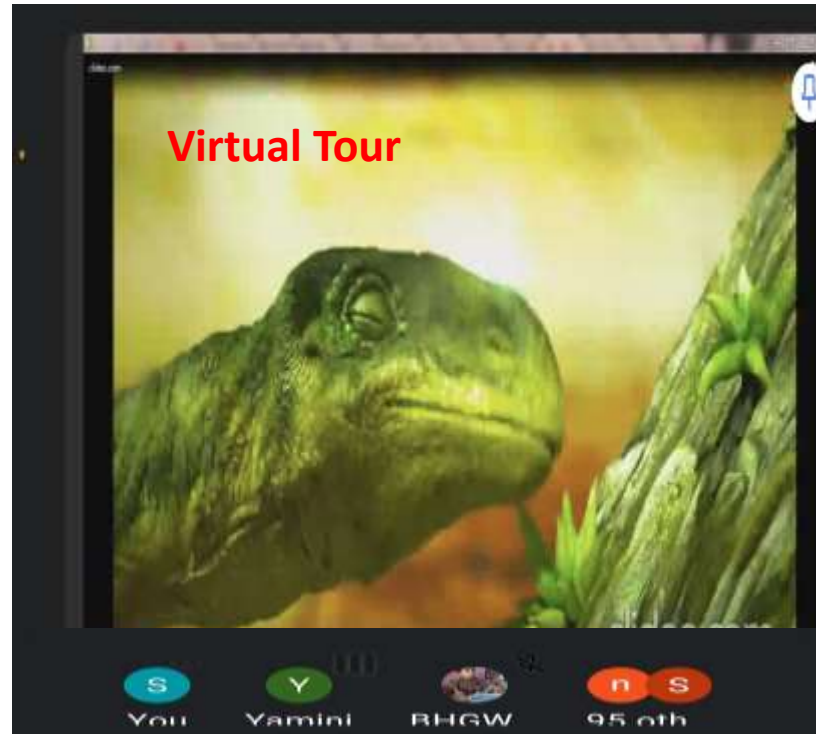
THE CURIOUS EXPLORERS OF KINDERGARTEN

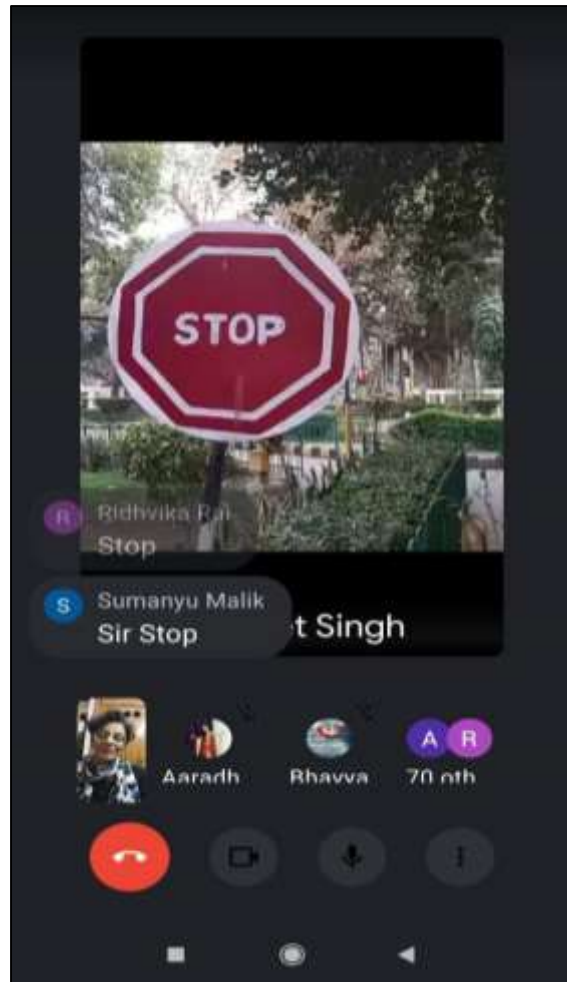

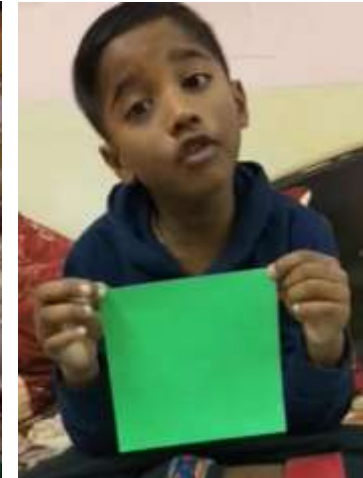
GOLD MEDAL AND BRONZE MEDAL

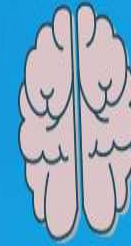

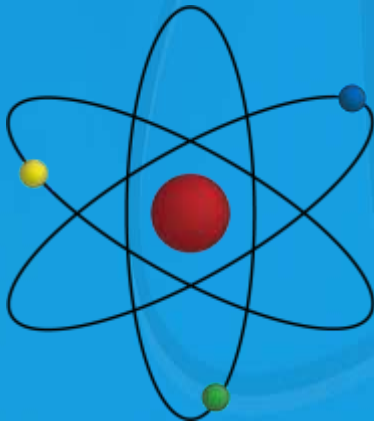
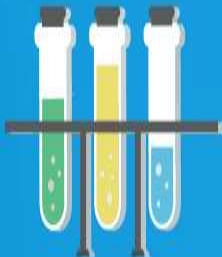
