HIGHLIGHTS OF THE LABOR FORCE APRIL 2024

THE BORDERPLEX REGION

- THE LABOR FORCE DECREASED BY 653 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS INCREASED BY 1,638 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS DECREASED BY 2,291 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH

EL PASO, TX MSA

- EL PASO, TX MSA UNEMPLOYMENT WAS AT 3.9% WITH A TOTAL OF 14,944 UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS
- EL PASO, TX MSA ADDED 7,500 NONFARM JOBS SINCE APRIL 2023
- EL PASO, TX MSA ADDED 900 NONFARM JOBS FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH

RURAL COUNTIES (BREWSTER, CULBERSON, JEFF DAVIS, HUDSPETH, AND PRESIDIO COUNTIES)

- THE LABOR FORCE INCREASED BY 203 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS INCREASED BY 256 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH
- THE NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS DECREASED BY 53 FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH



The three Super Sectors with the least employment for the El Paso MSA in April 2024 were:


- 1. Financial Activities








UNEMPLOYMENT in April 2024






















Across the nation, the state, and El Paso County, there has been an improvement in getting more educational opportunities to women, but there is still some work to do.
